- The region's greenfield, build-to-suit, & industrial buildings meet the needs of manufacturers large & small.
- There is more than 167 million square feet of Industrial space and 8.5 million square feet in the pipeline, providing a plethora of options.
- San Antonio is at the heart of highway connectivity – 160 miles to Mexico, approximately 1,200 miles to both the East & West coasts.

Incentives and Special Trade Areas

- State-level incentives like the Texas Enterprise Fund, Enterprise Zones, and the Skills Development Fund, and Property Tax Relief from local municipalities help make the San Antonio region competitive for capital-intensive projects.
- Bexar County is a Foreign Trade Zone, which can result in reduced fees and duties.
