Top Security Clearance

- San Antonio has more than 10,000 certified cyber professionals, almost as many as there are in the entire state of Colorado or North Carolina, and three times as many as the Austin area.
- The National Security Agency (NSA) TX is one of only four NSA Cryptological Centers conducting worldwide signals intelligence, cyberspace operations, and cybersecurity operations to ensure the integrity and availability of mission and computer systems.

Top Notch Talent Pipeline

- San Antonio boasts six NSA and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Centers of Academic Excellence (CAE) designated universities, the most designations in the nation.
- The Cyber Innovation Research Consortium (CIRC) brings together 10 area universities and colleges to integrate and amplify their collective capabilities as high-powered cybersecurity institutions.

Incentives and Special Trade Areas

- State-level incentives like the Texas Enterprise Fund, Enterprise Zones, and the Skills Development Fund, and Property Tax Relief from local municipalities help make the San Antonio region competitive for capital-intensive projects.
- Bexar County is a Foreign Trade Zone, which can result in reduced fees and duties.
