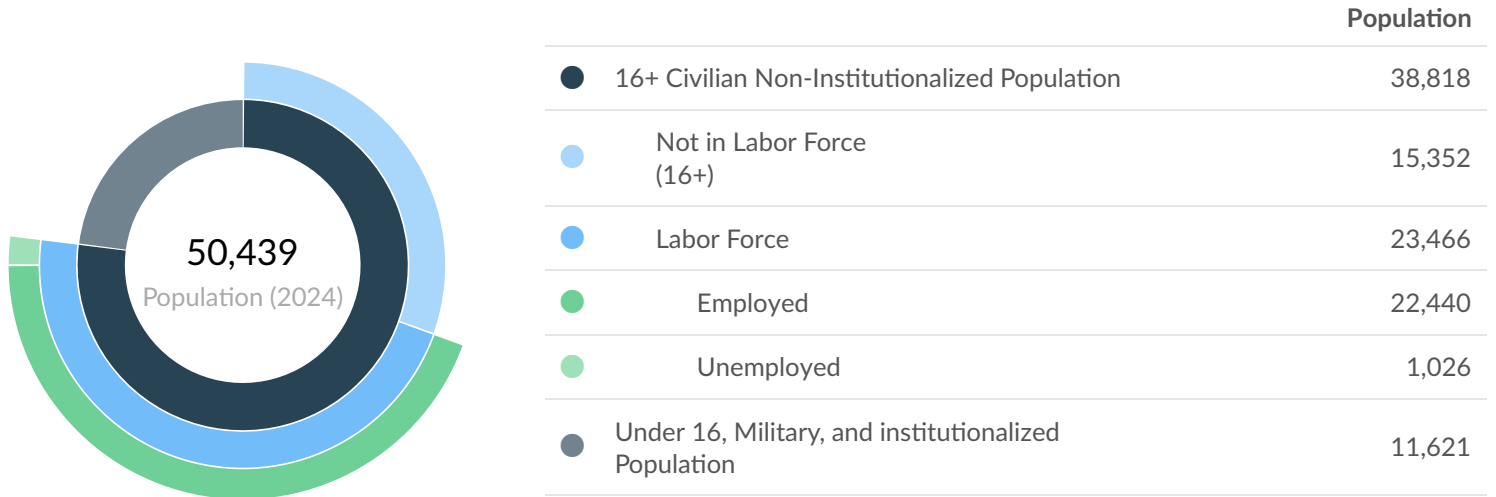
Median household income is **\$7.7K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 5.8%** in Atascosa County, TX from 15,834 to **16,749**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 1.9%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 55.5% to 60.0% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.5% of Atascosa County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **5.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Support Activities for Mining, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

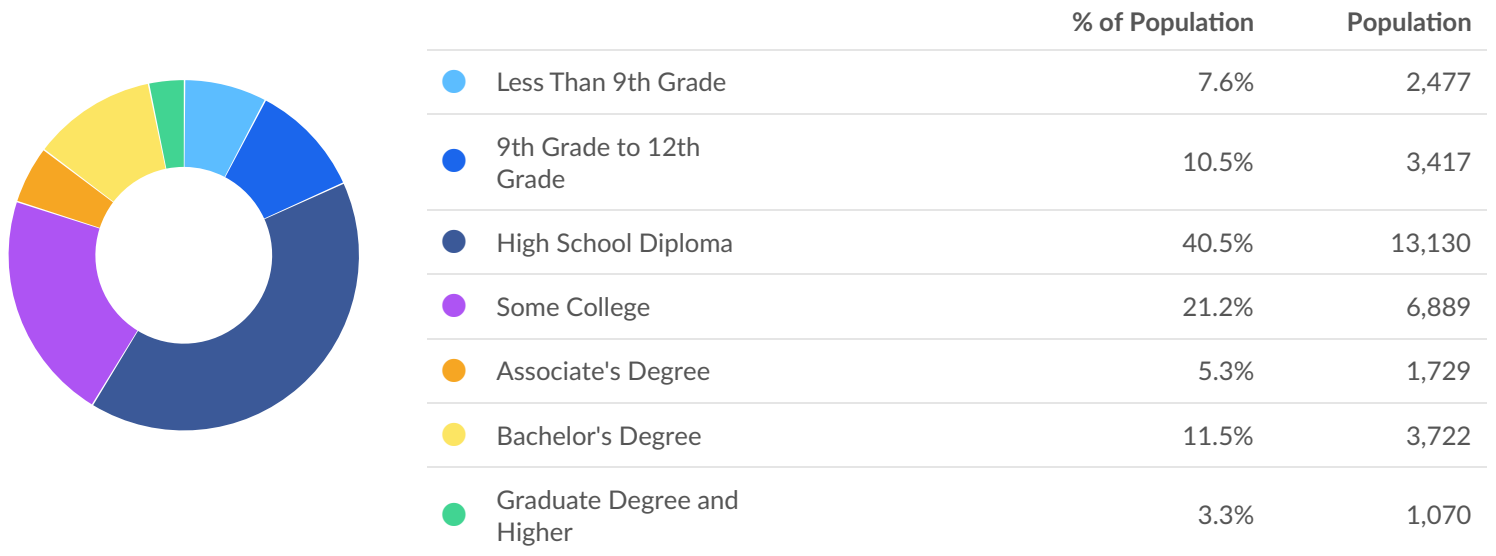

Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



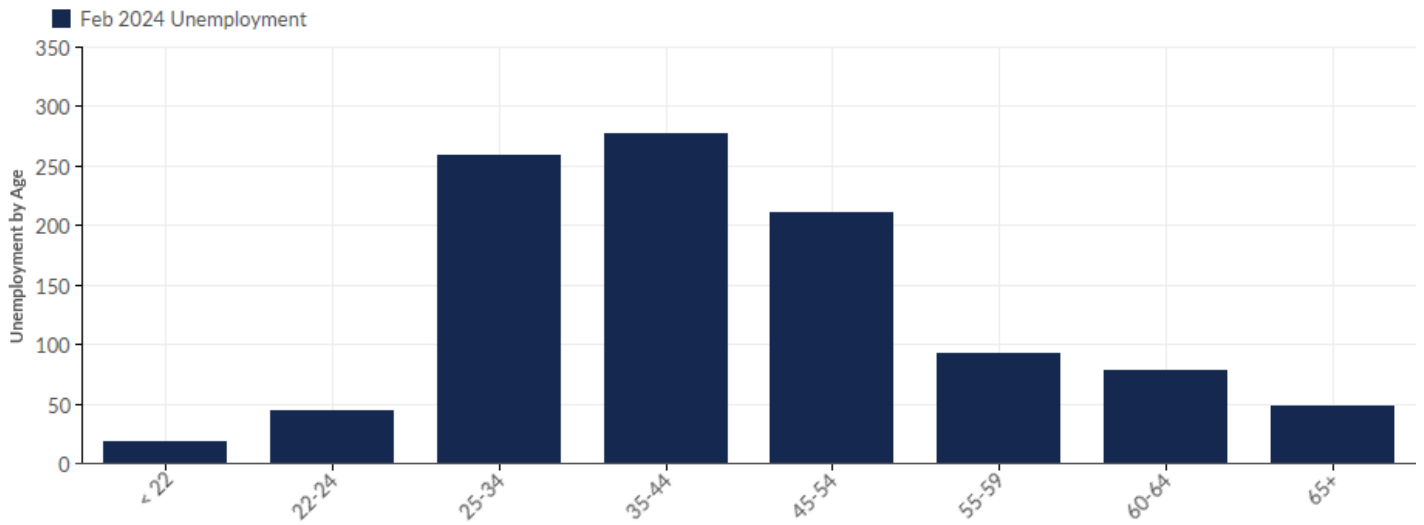
Educational Attainment

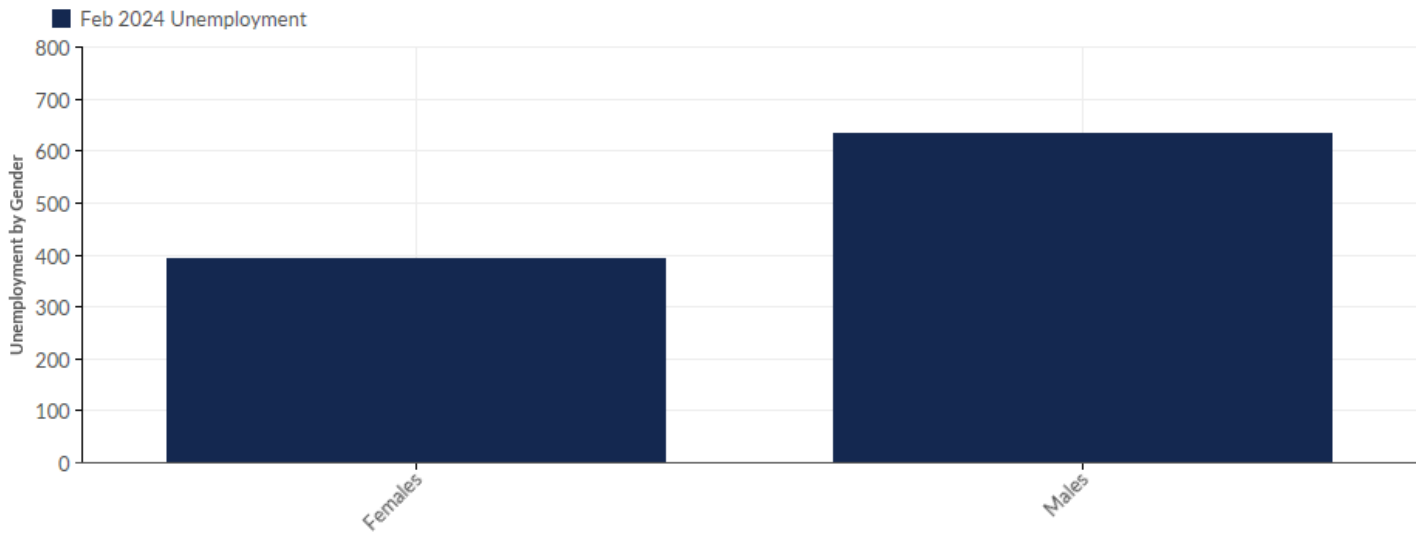

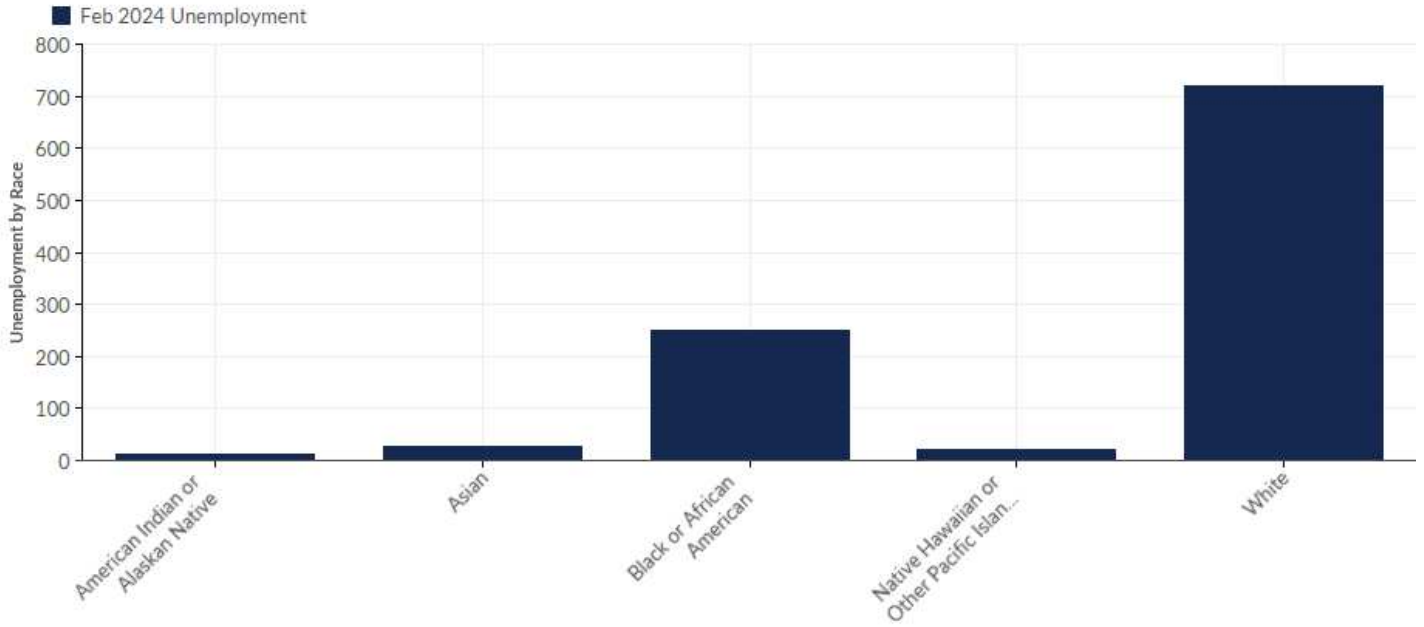

Unemployment by Gender



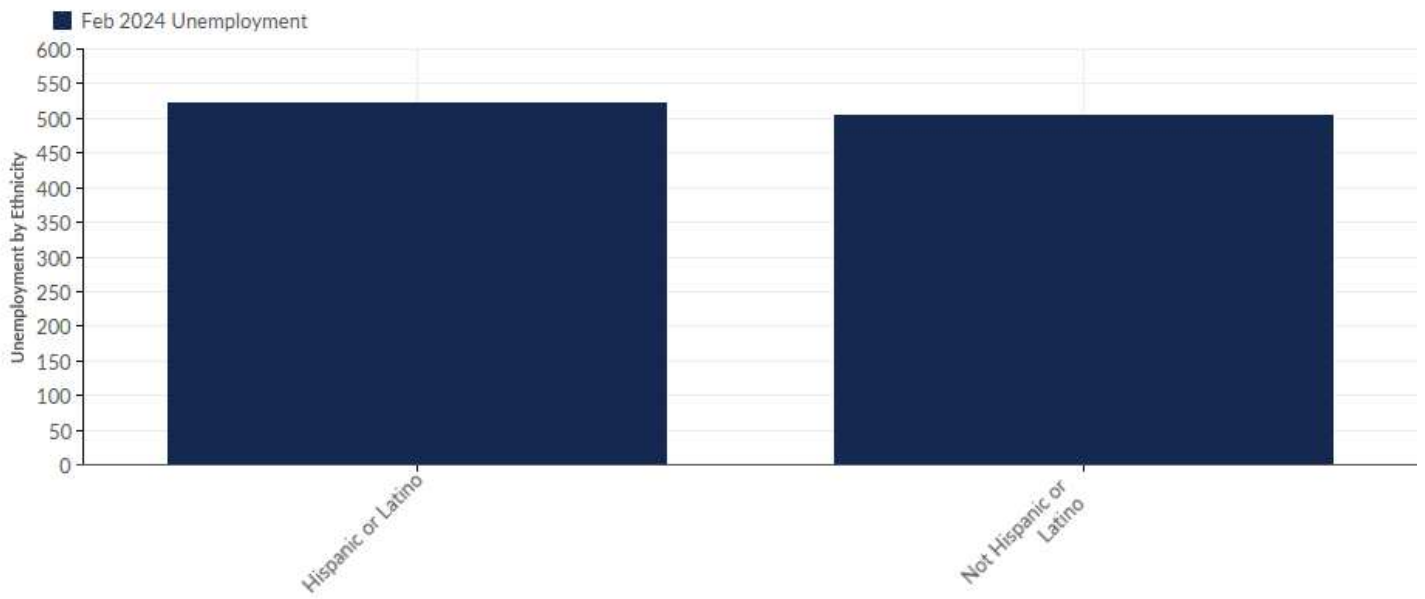

Unemployment by Ethnicity

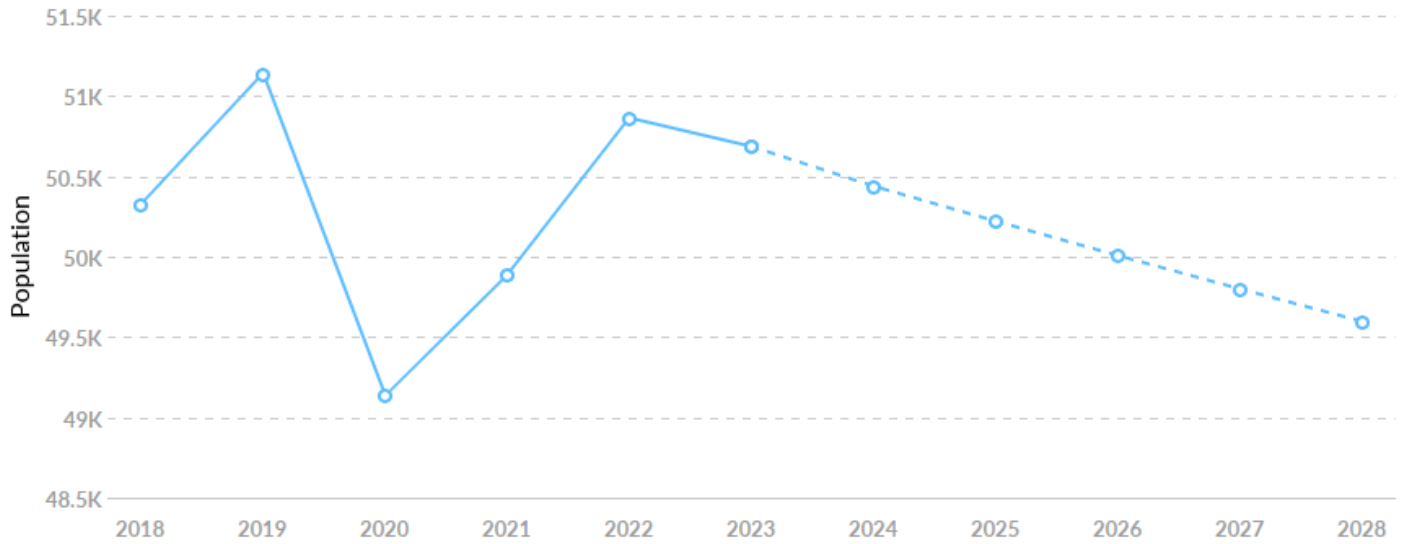

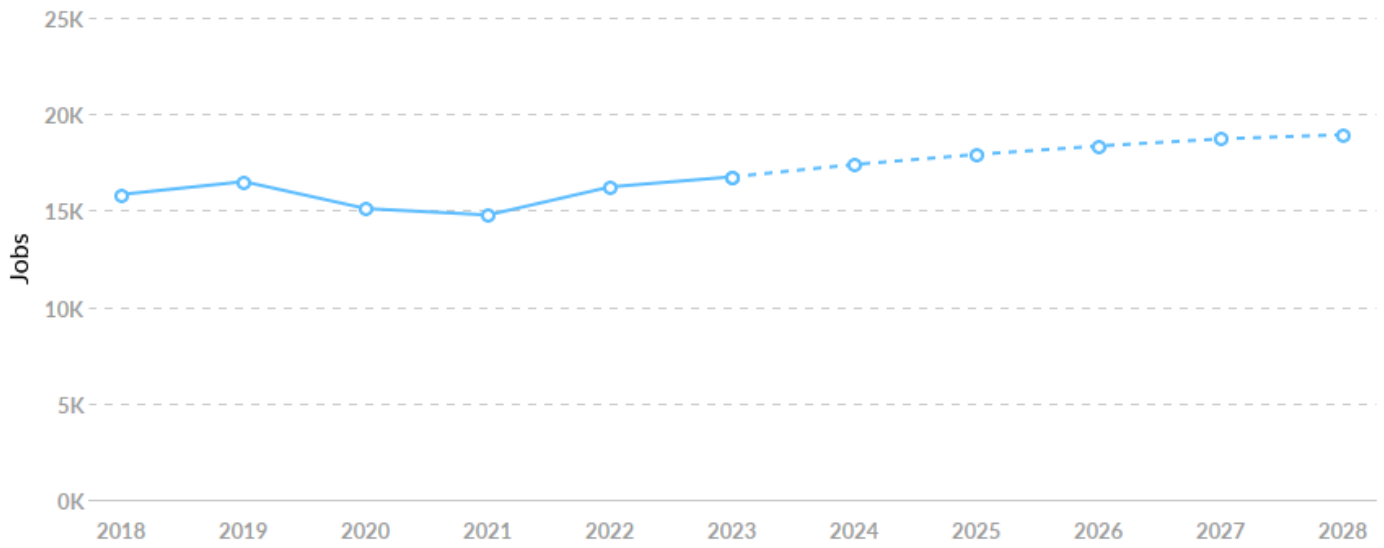

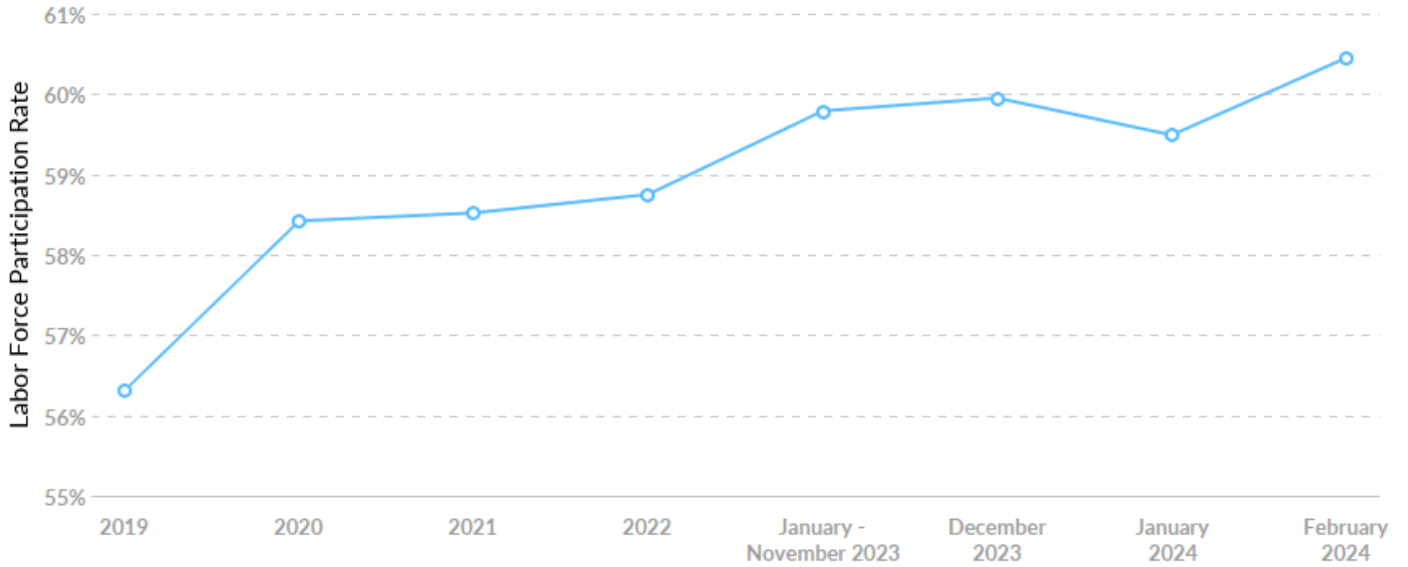
Job Trends

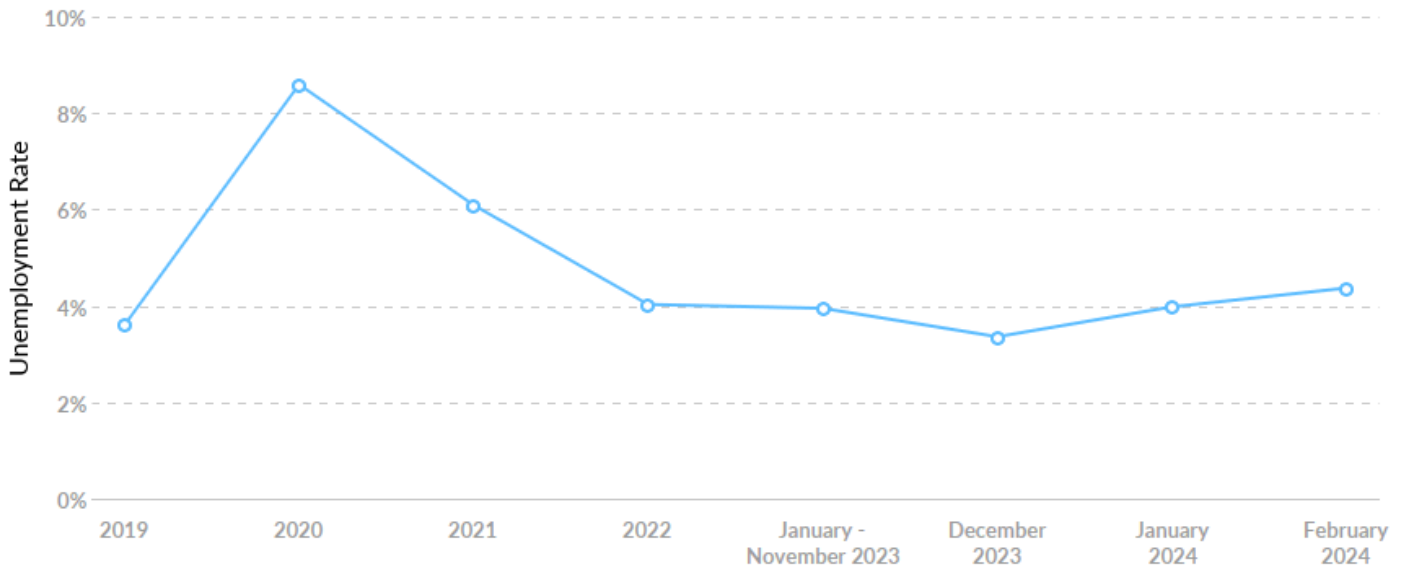

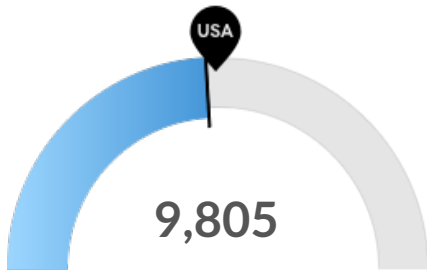
Unemployment Rate Trends

Atascosa County, TX had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 4.37%, **increasing from 3.60% 5 years before.**



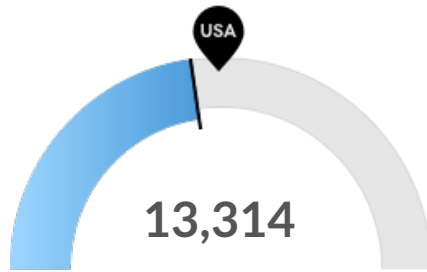

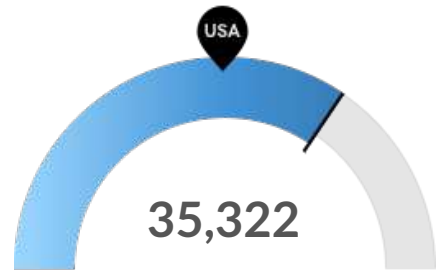
Millennials

Atascosa County, TX has 9,805 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,342.



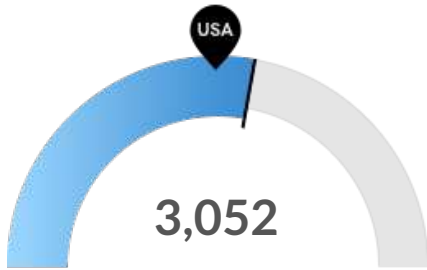
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 15,243 people 55 or older, while there are 13,314 here.



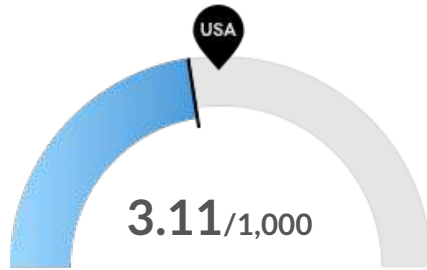
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 20,917 racially diverse people, while there are 35,322 here.



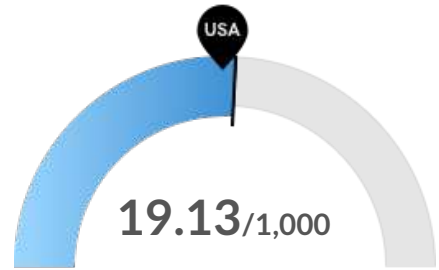
Veterans

Atascosa County, TX has 3.11 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

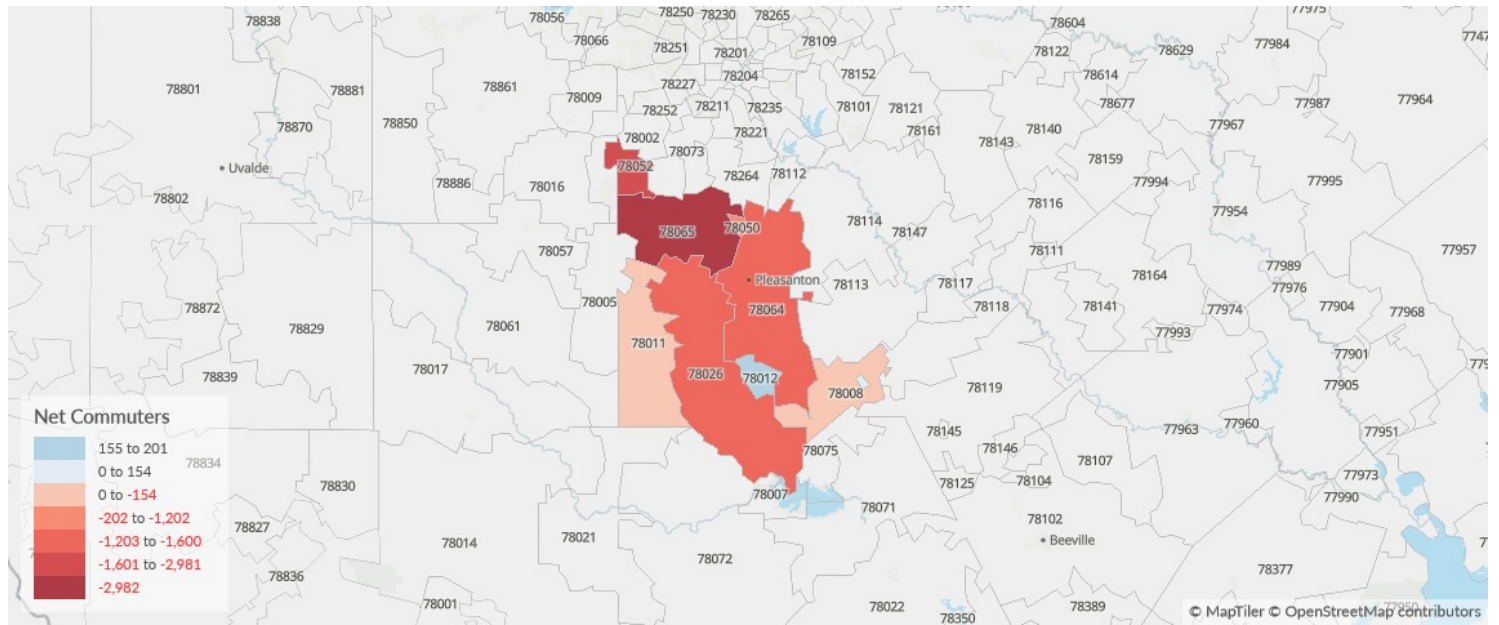


Property Crime

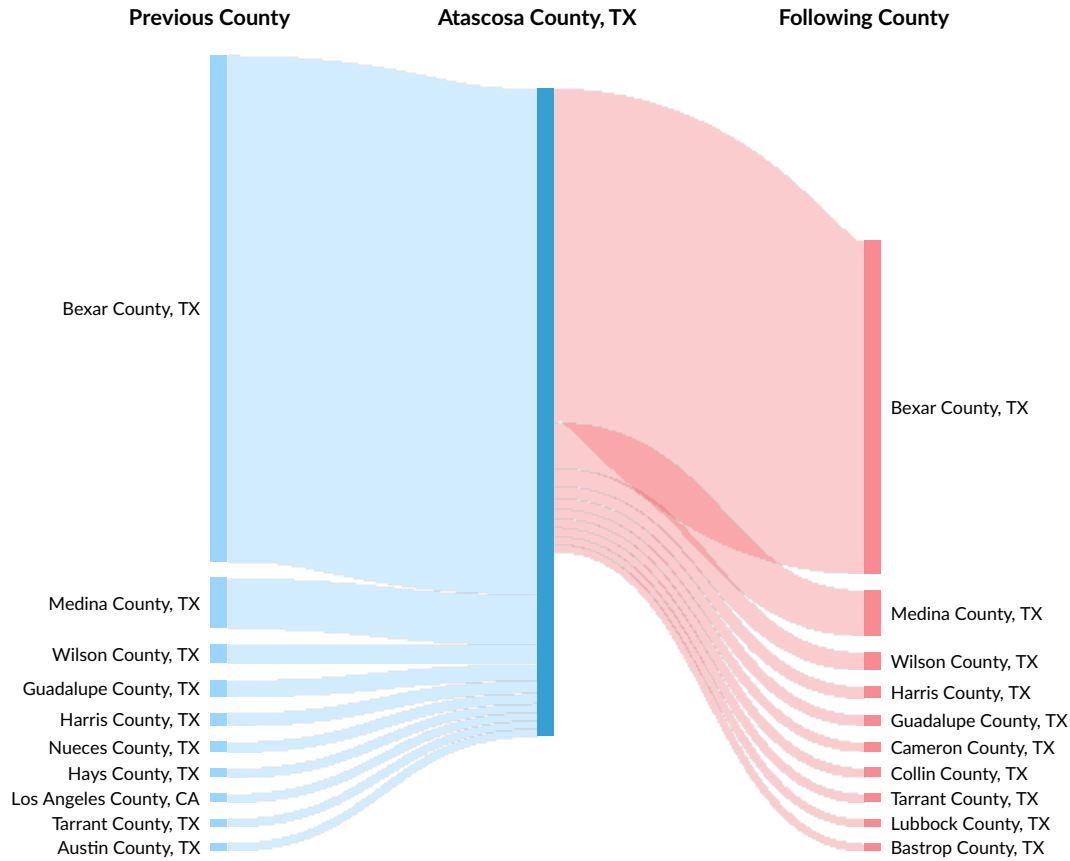

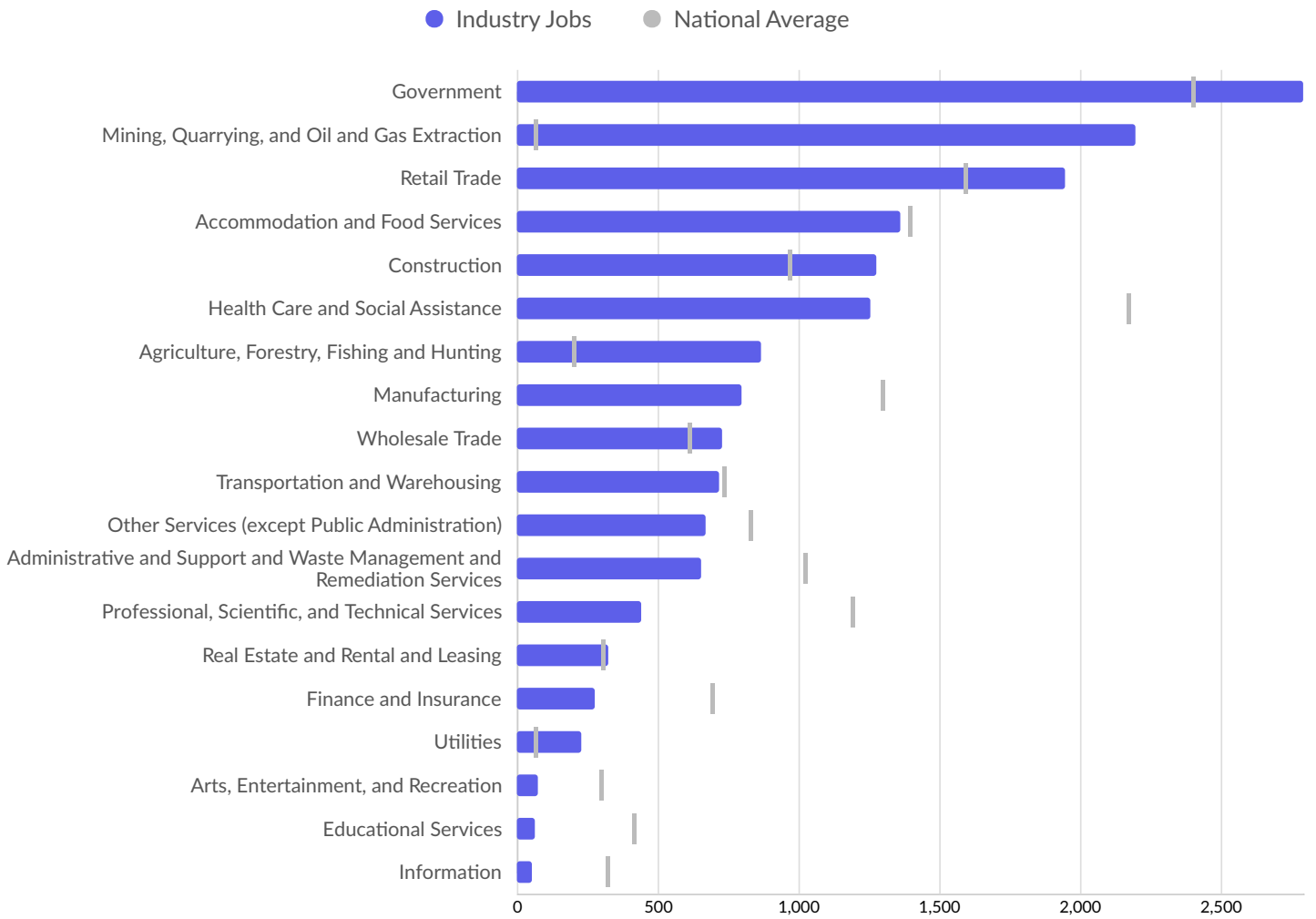

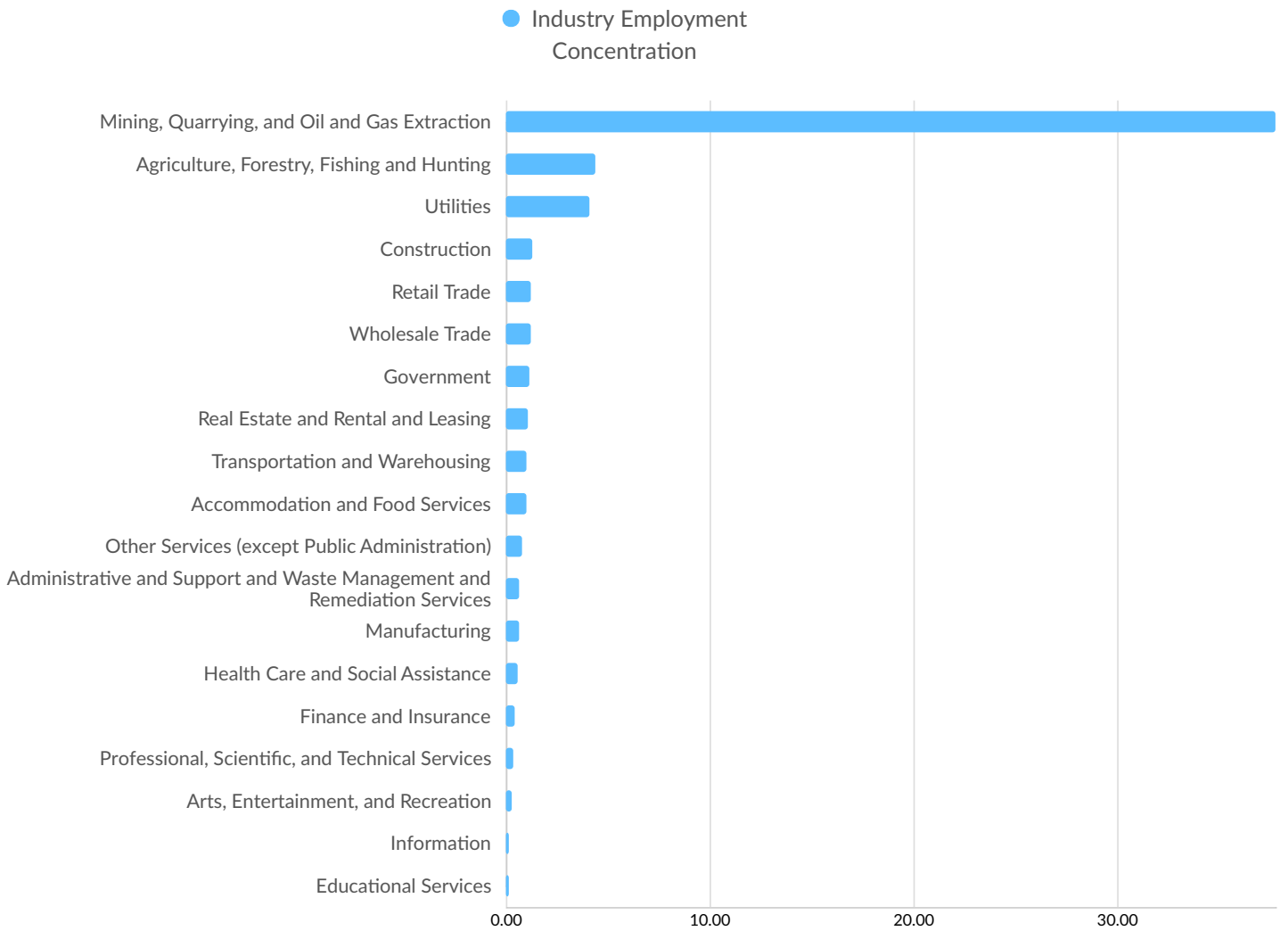

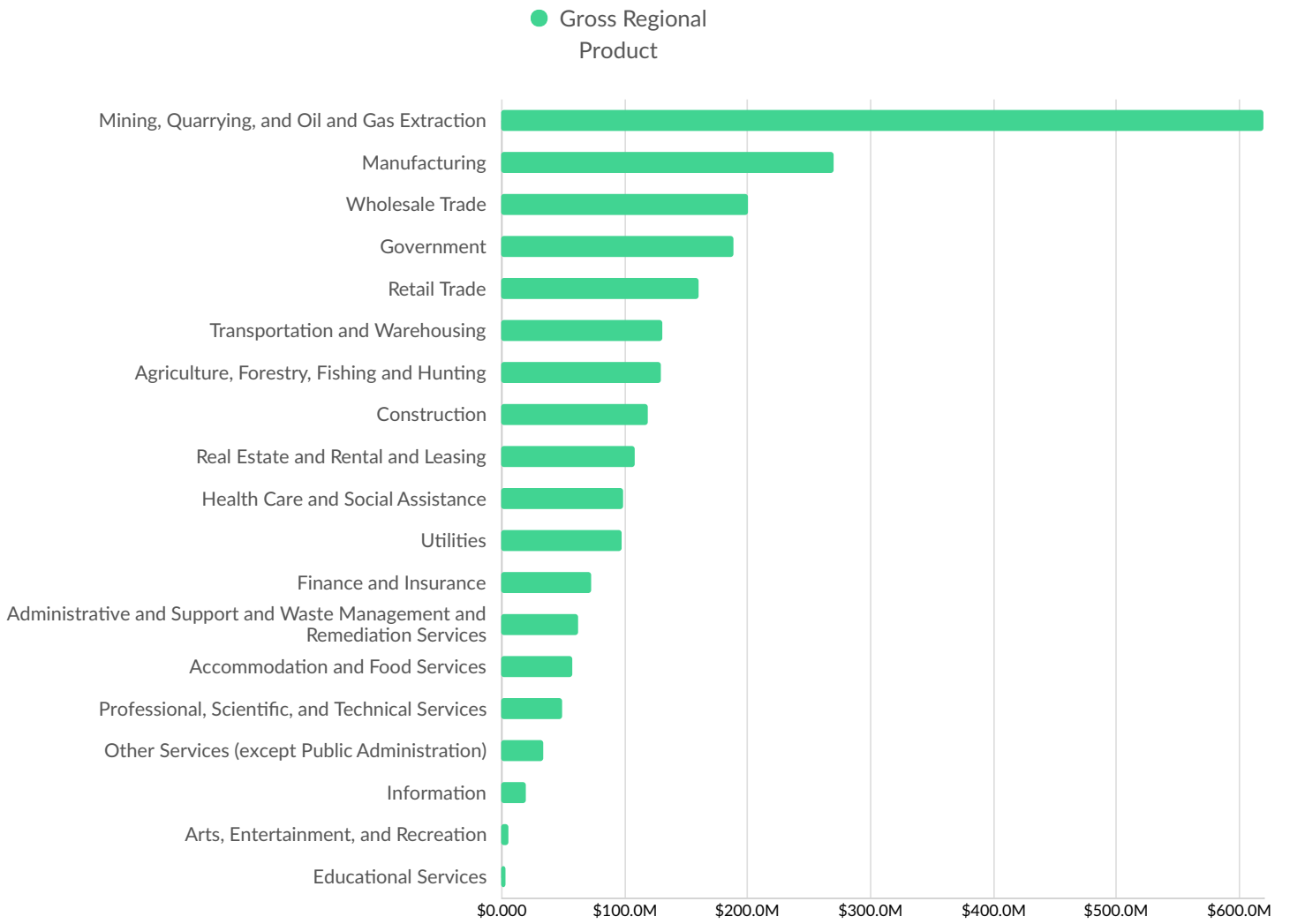
Top Growing Industries



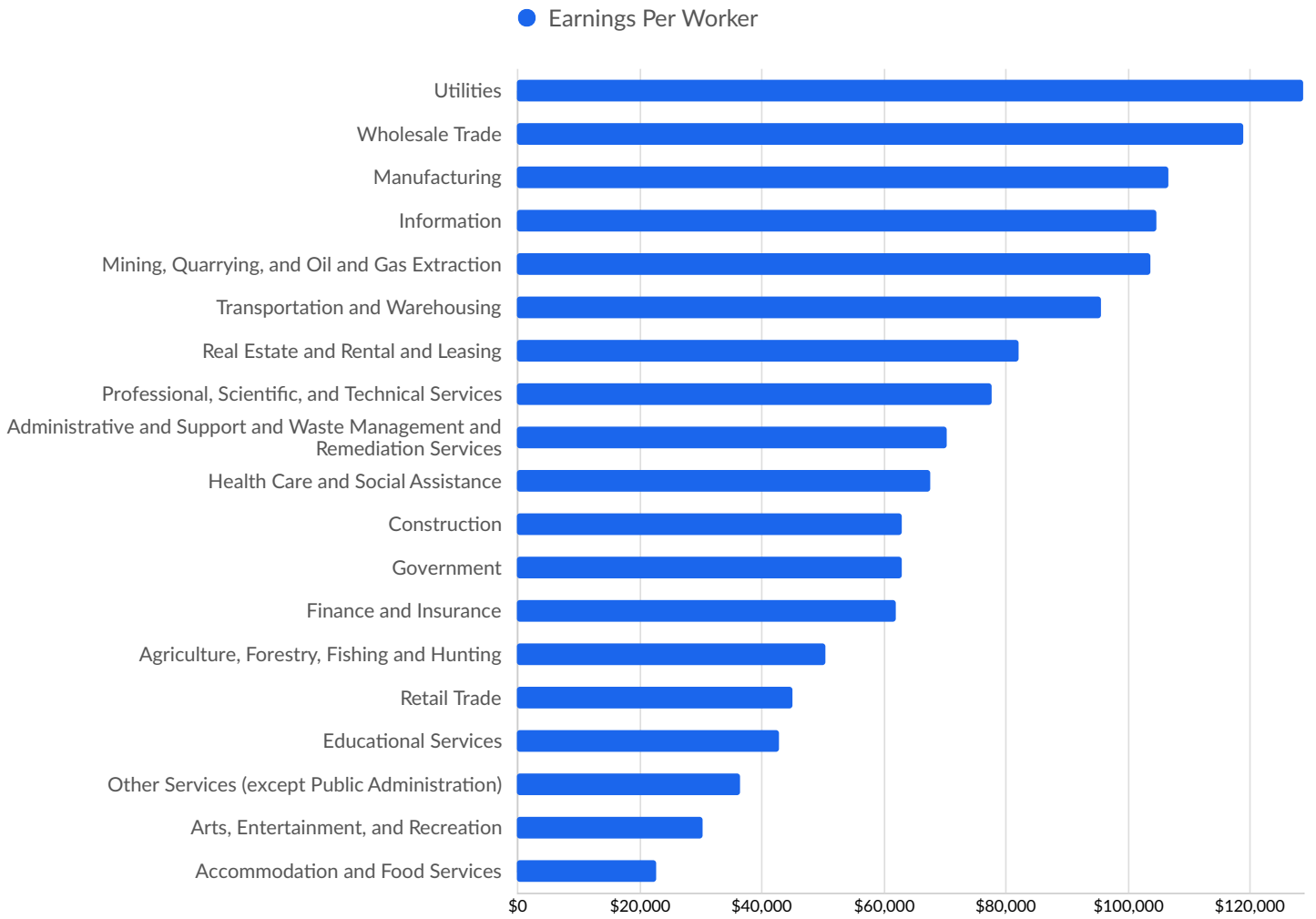
Top Industry Employment Concentration

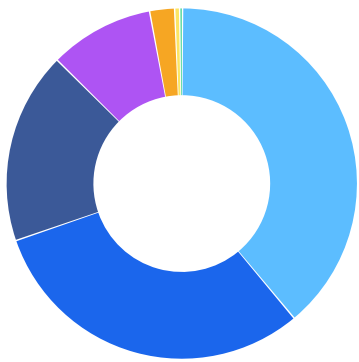

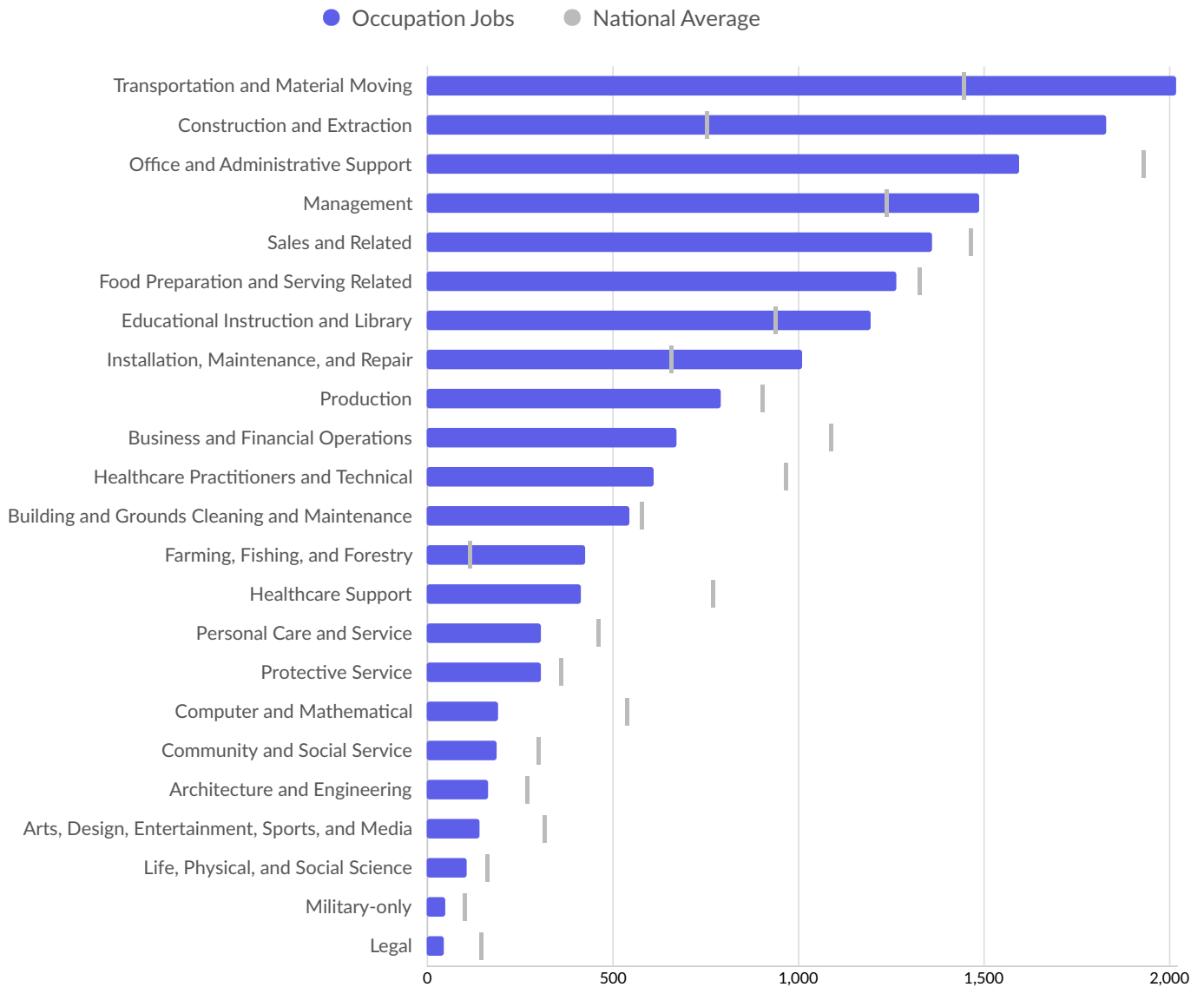

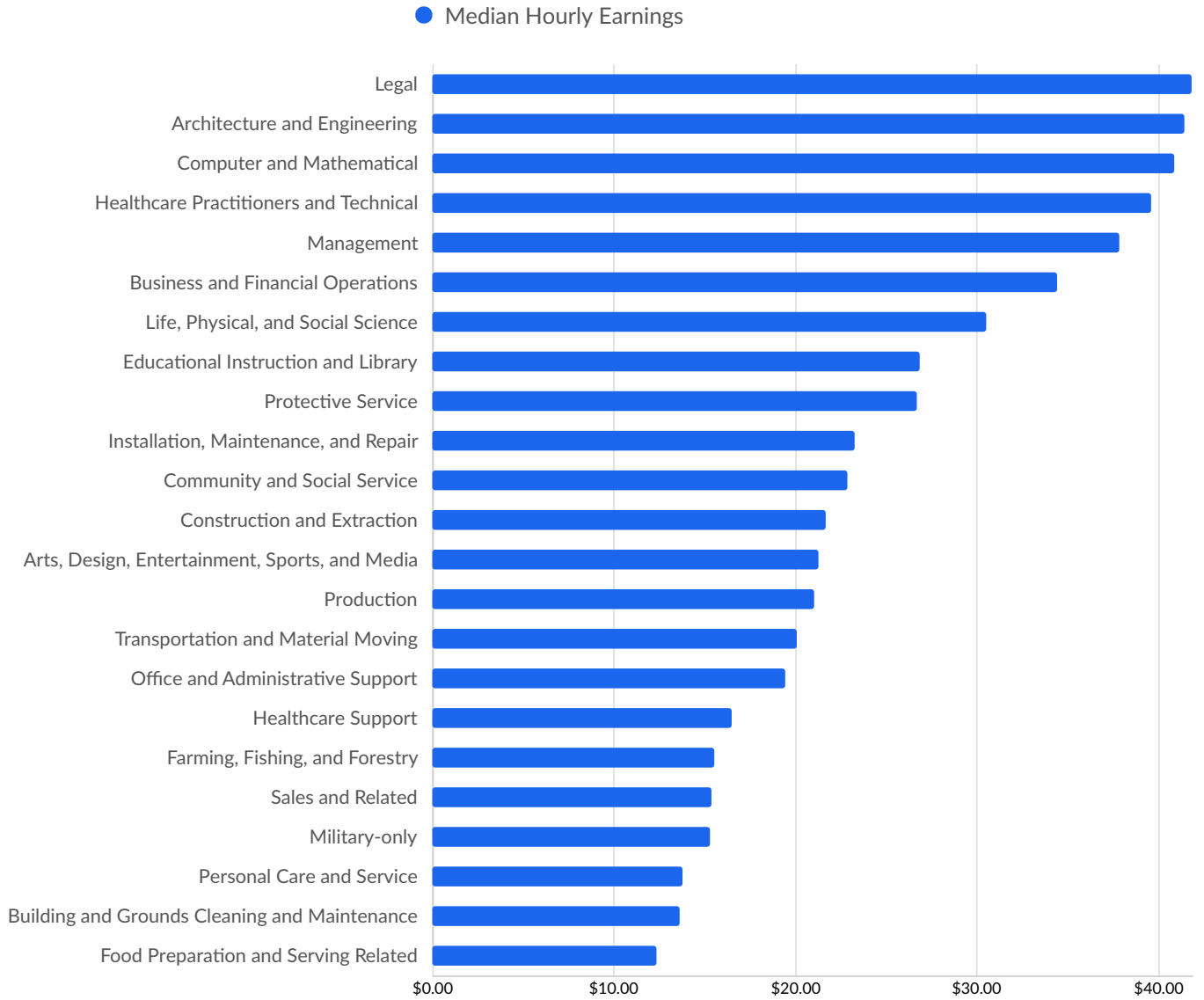


Top Occupation Employment Concentration

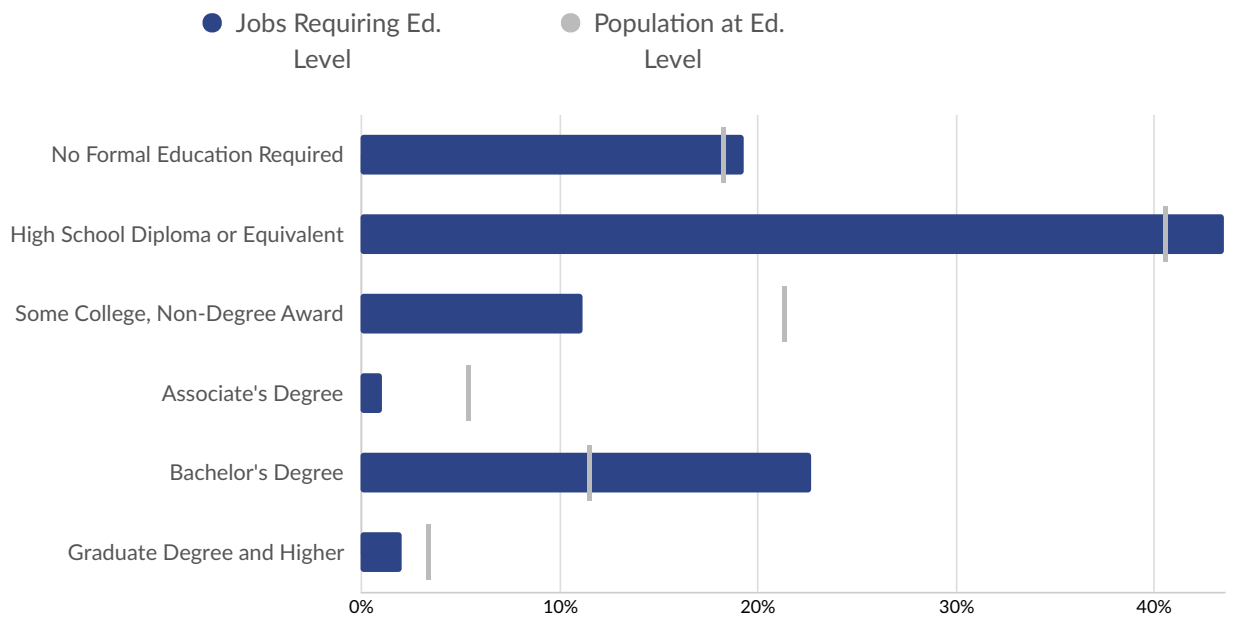
