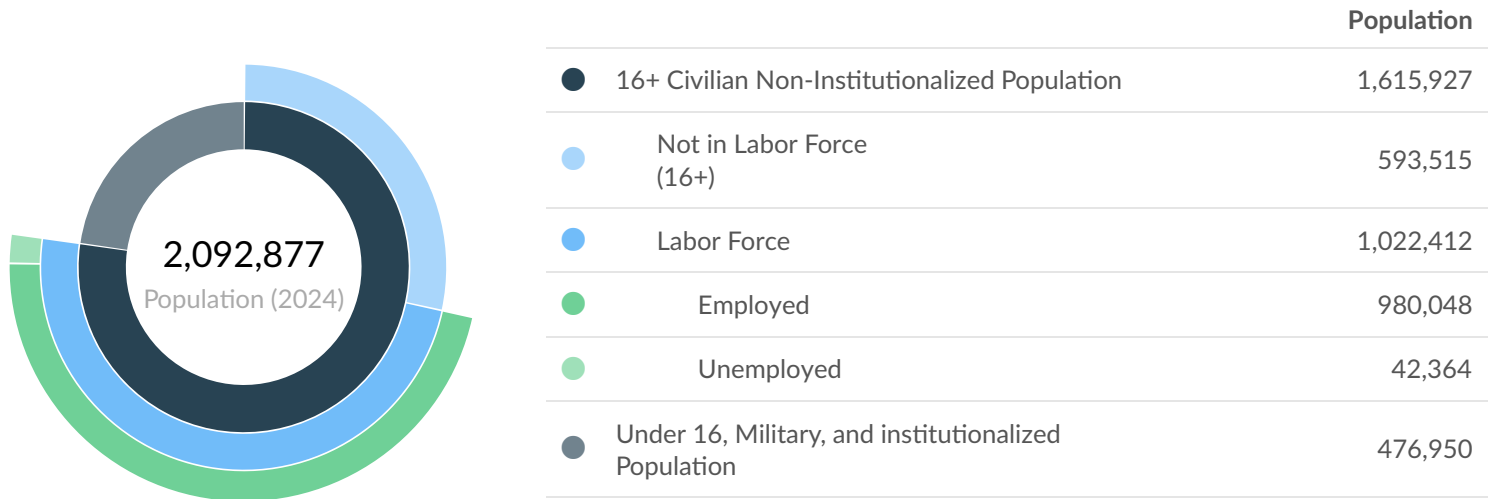

## Takeaways

- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 5.1%** in Bexar County, TX from 1,005,895 to **1,057,669**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 1.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 61.1% to 63.6% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.8% of Bexar County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Federal Government, Military.

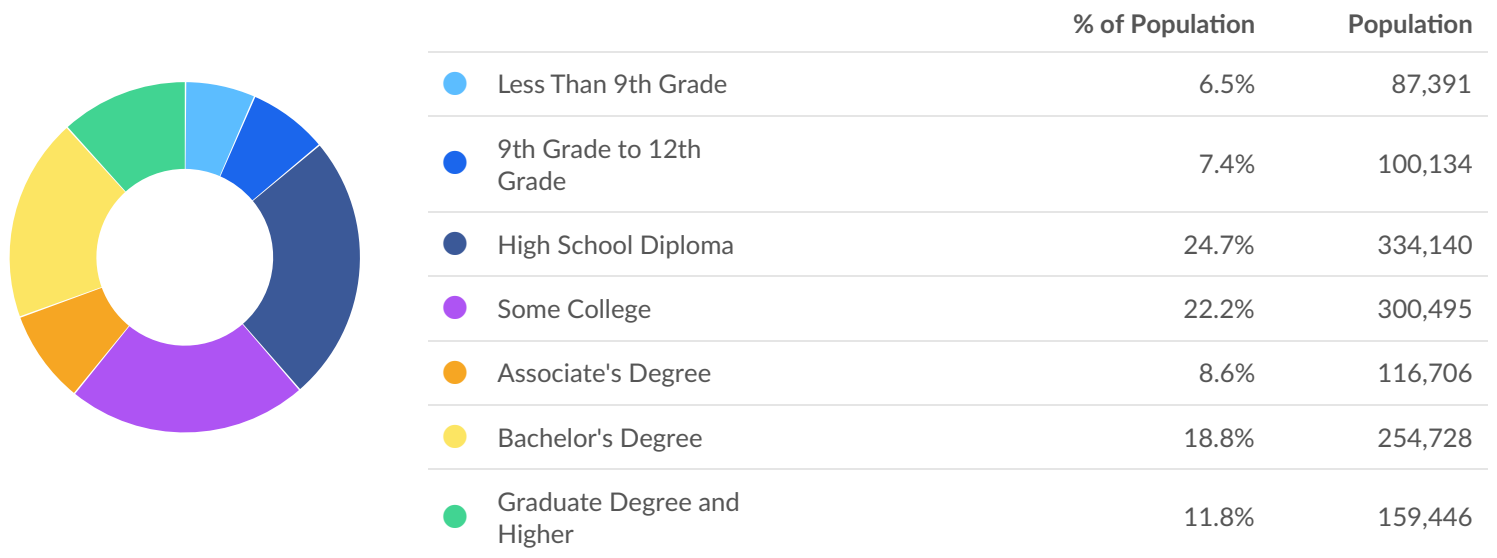

## Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



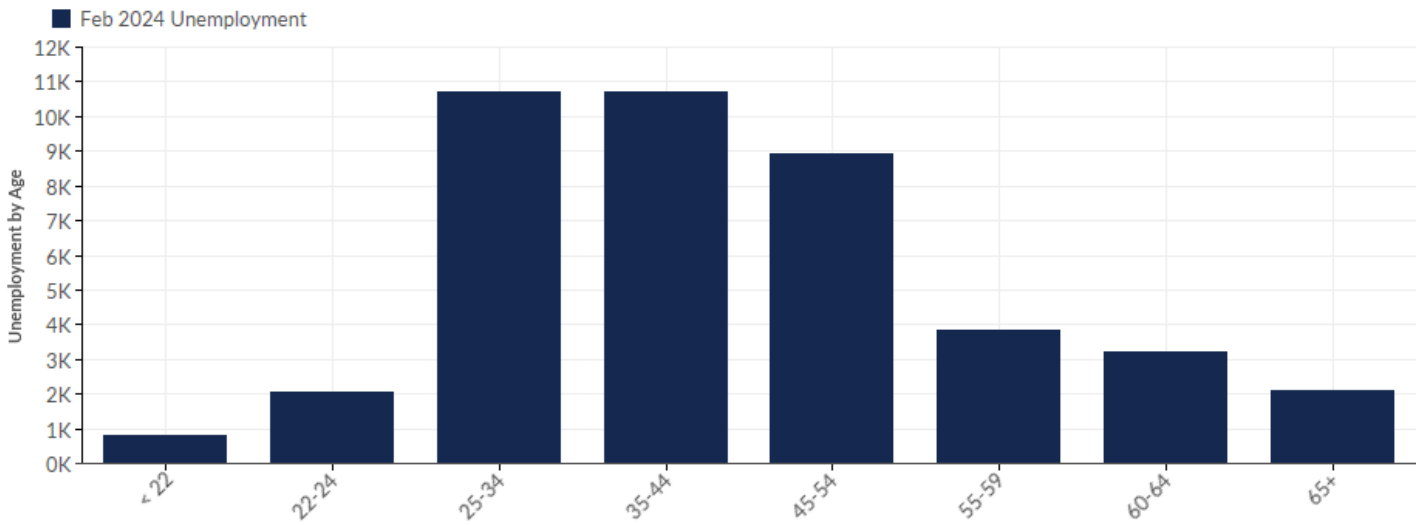
## Educational Attainment

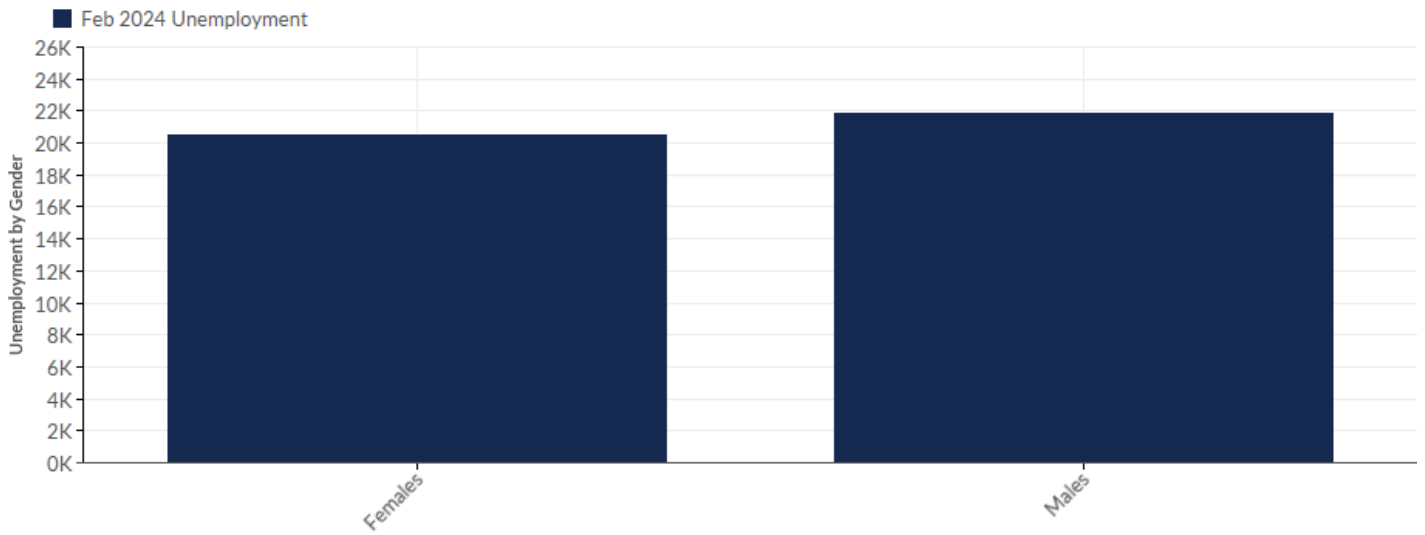

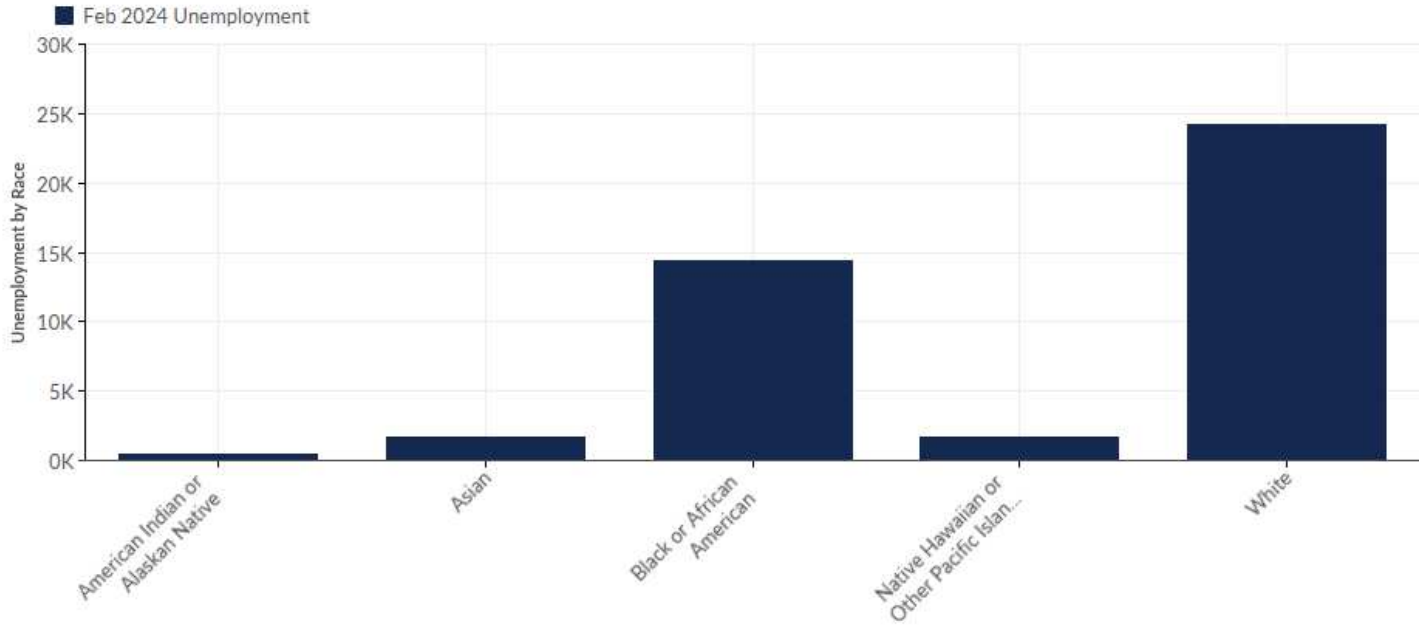

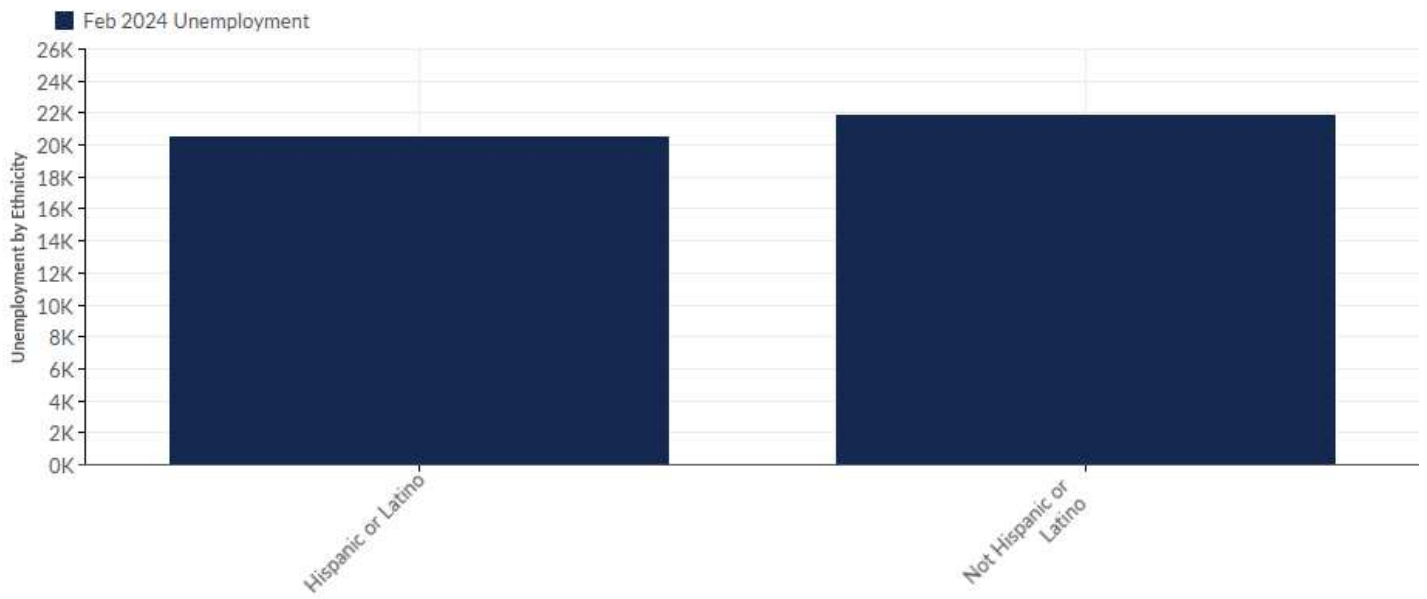

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

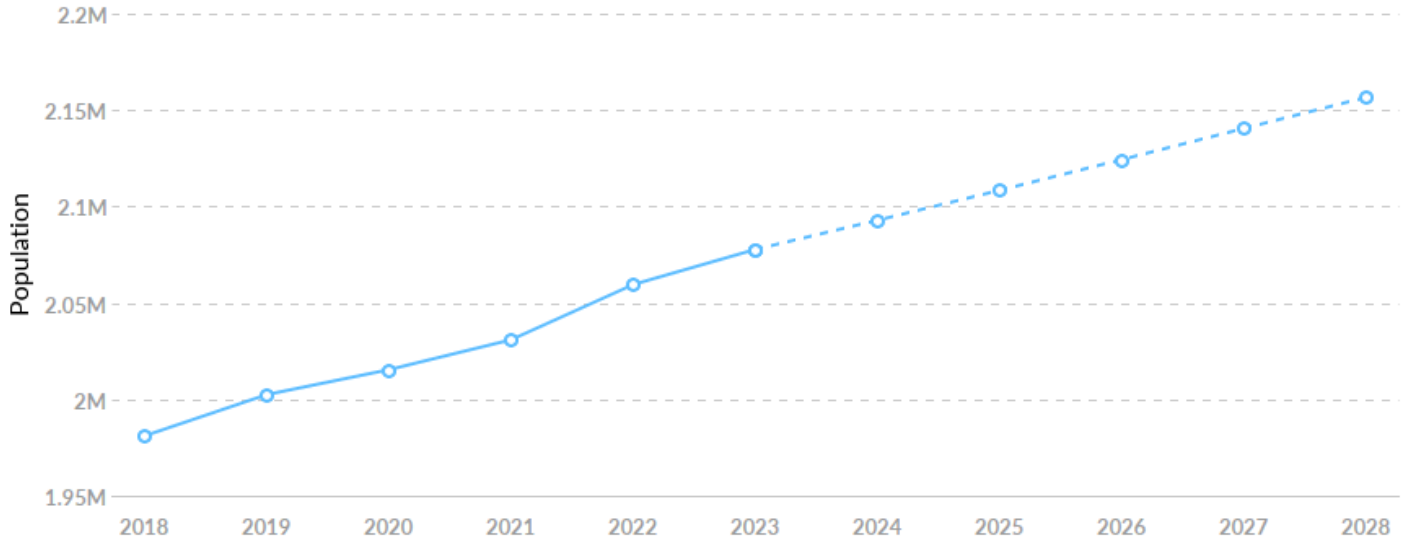

## Population Trends

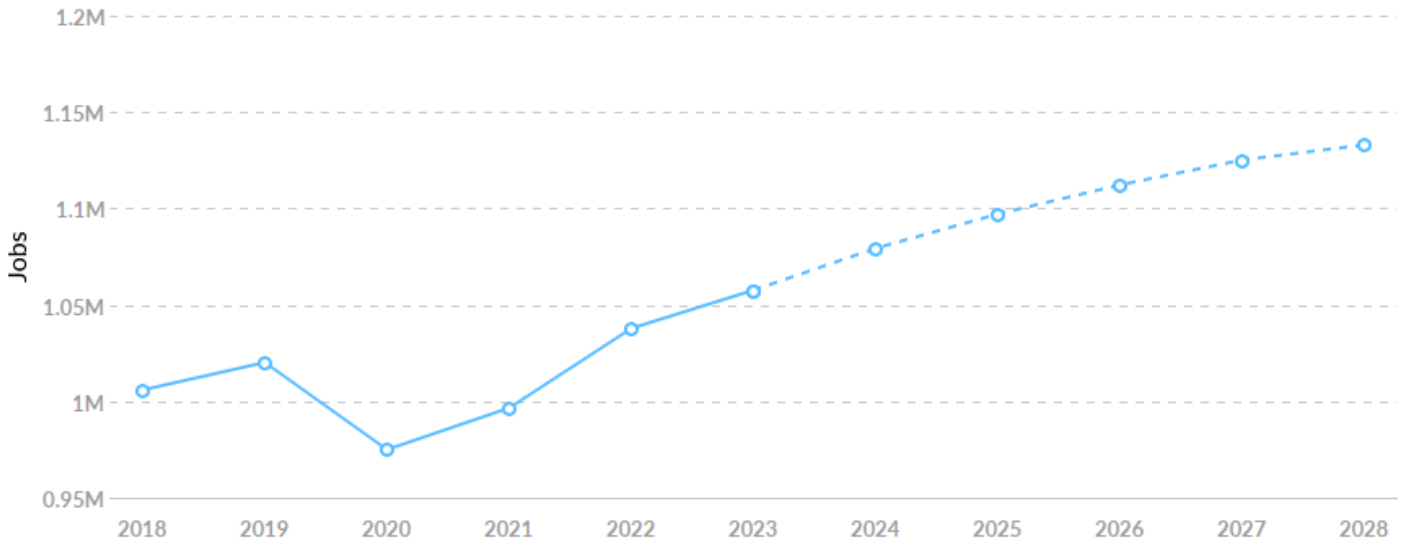

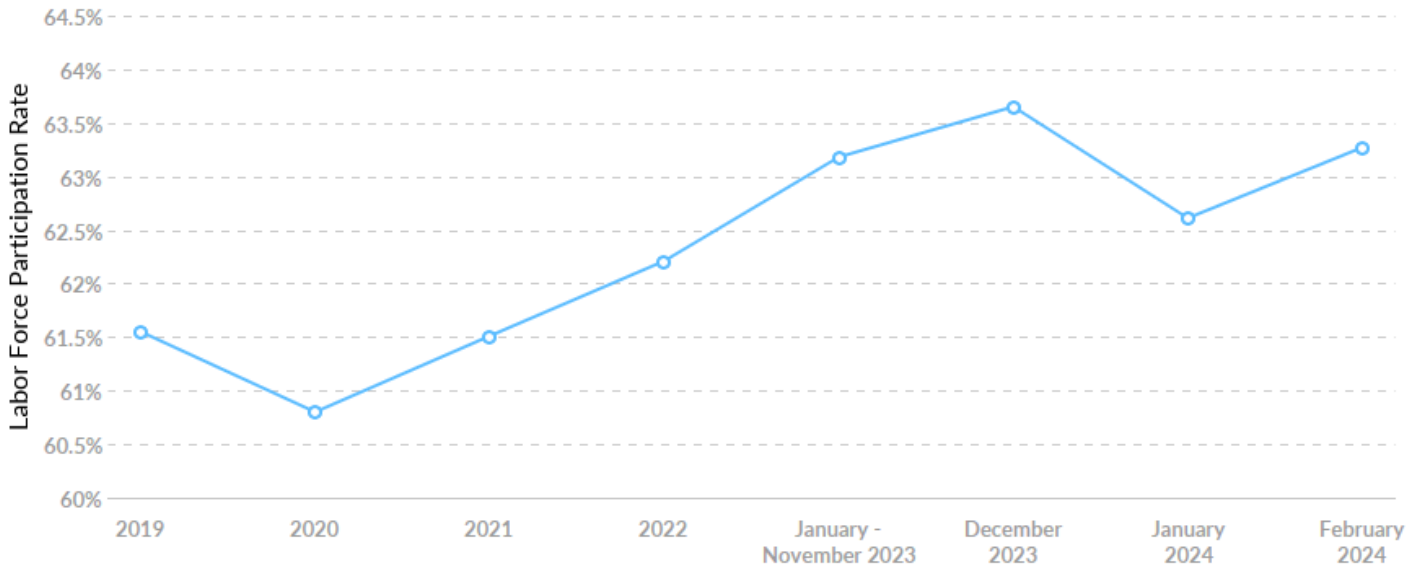
## Job Trends

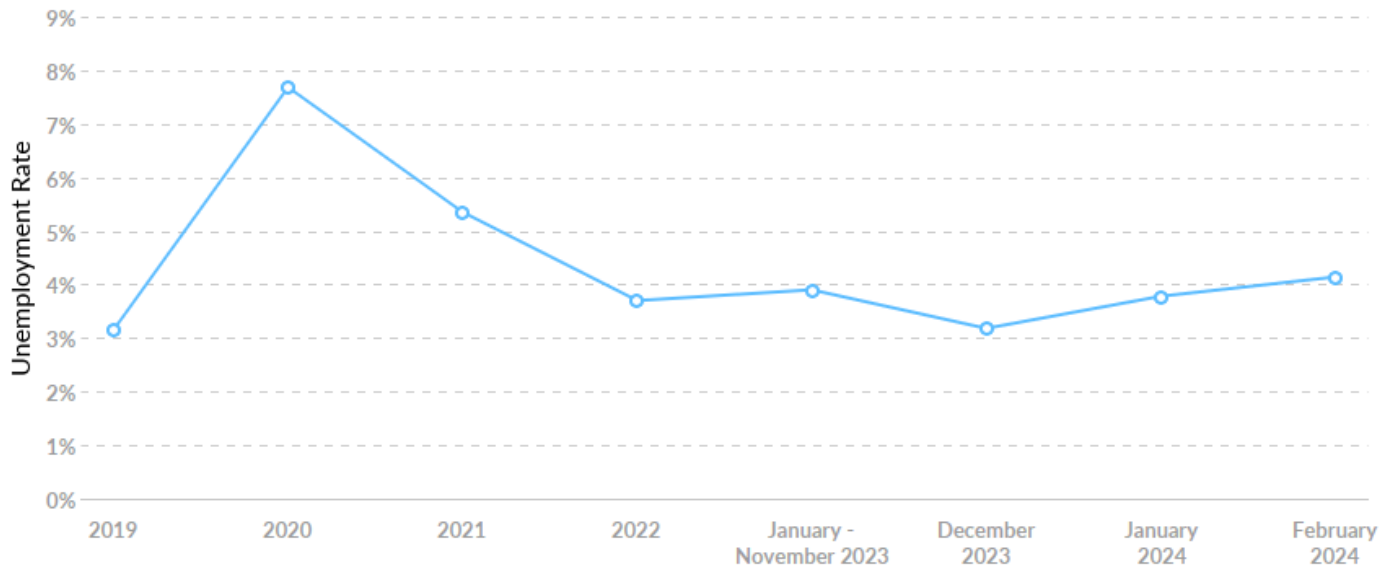

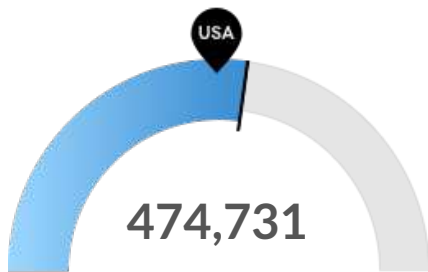
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Bexar County, TX had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 4.14%, **increasing from 3.15% 5 years before.**



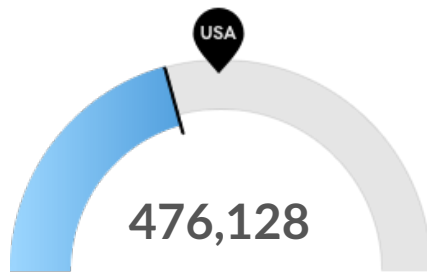

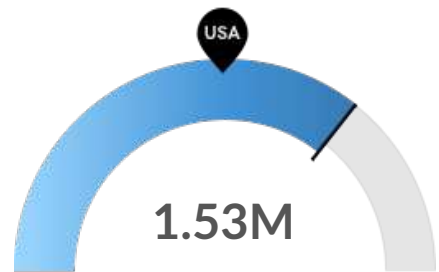
Millennials

Bexar County, TX has 474,731 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 418,776.



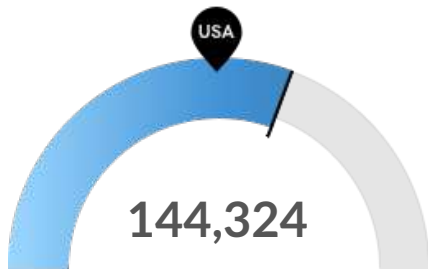
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Bexar County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 617,204 people 55 or older, while there are 476,128 here.



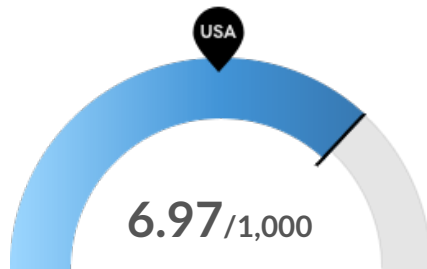
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Bexar County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 846,964 racially diverse people, while there are 1,527,050 here.



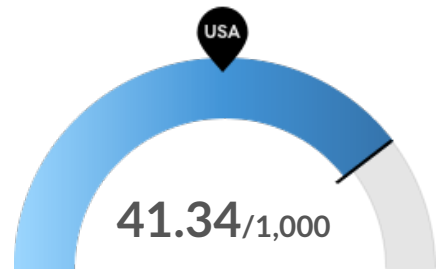
Veterans

Bexar County, TX has 6.97 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

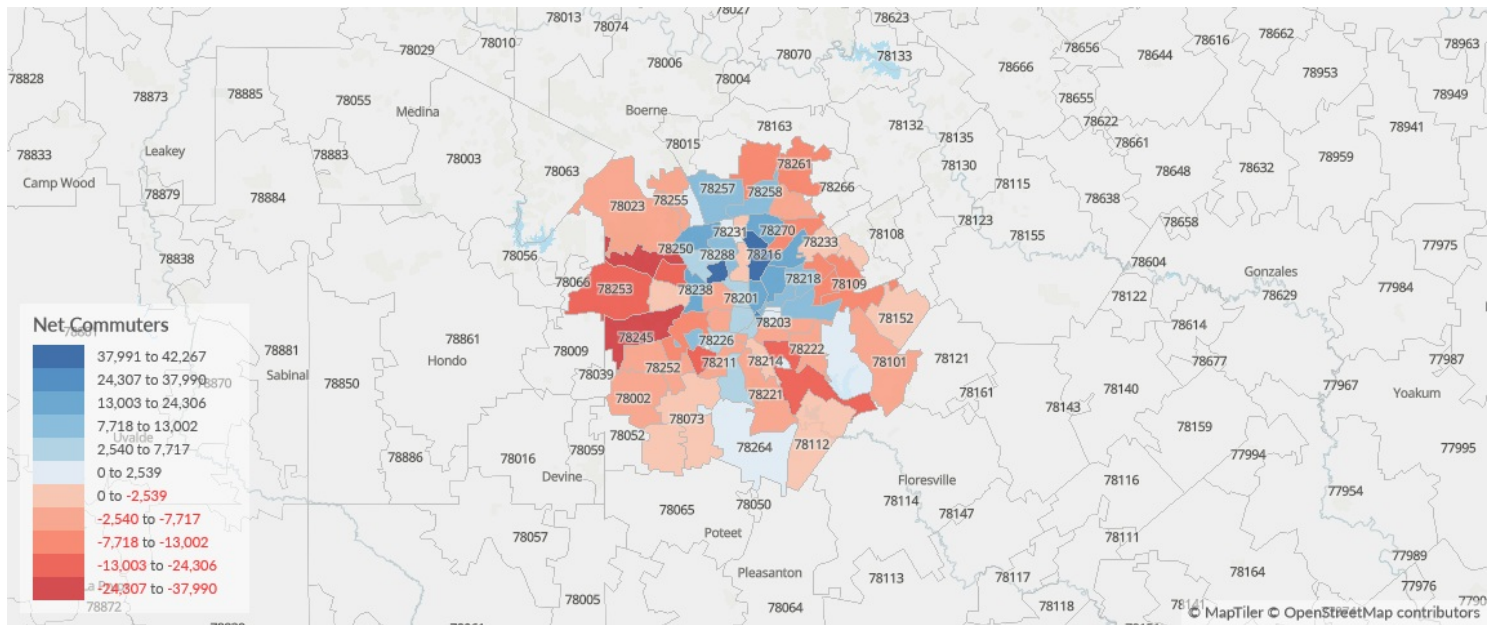


Property Crime

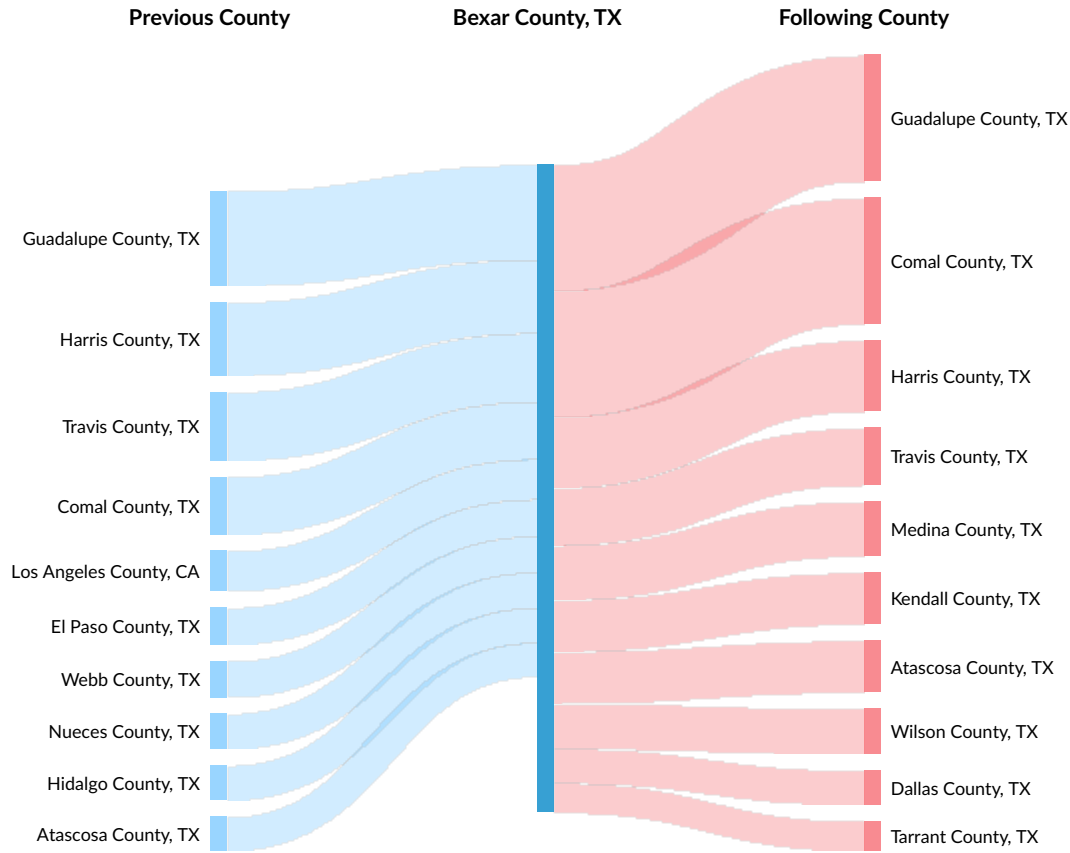

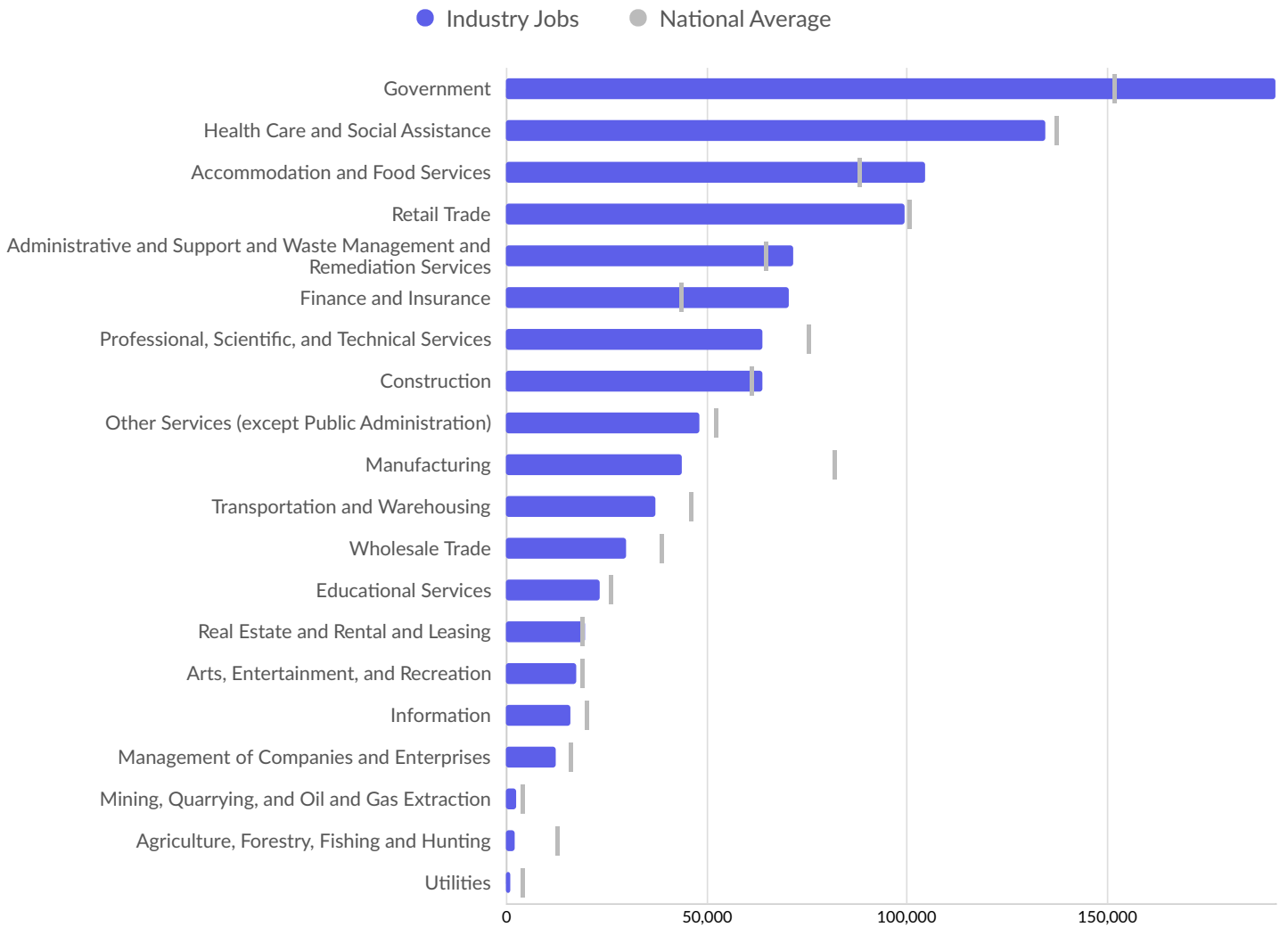

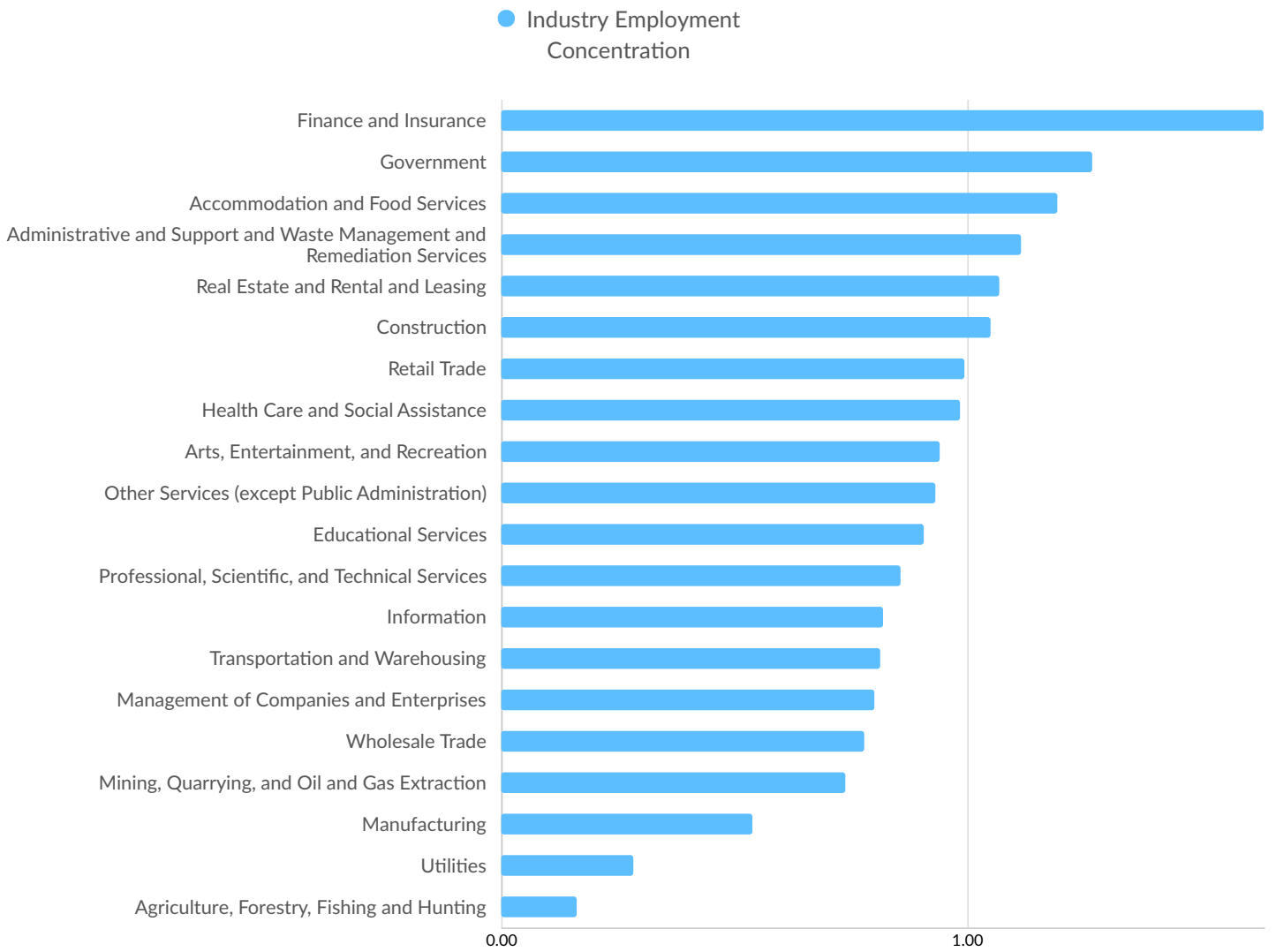

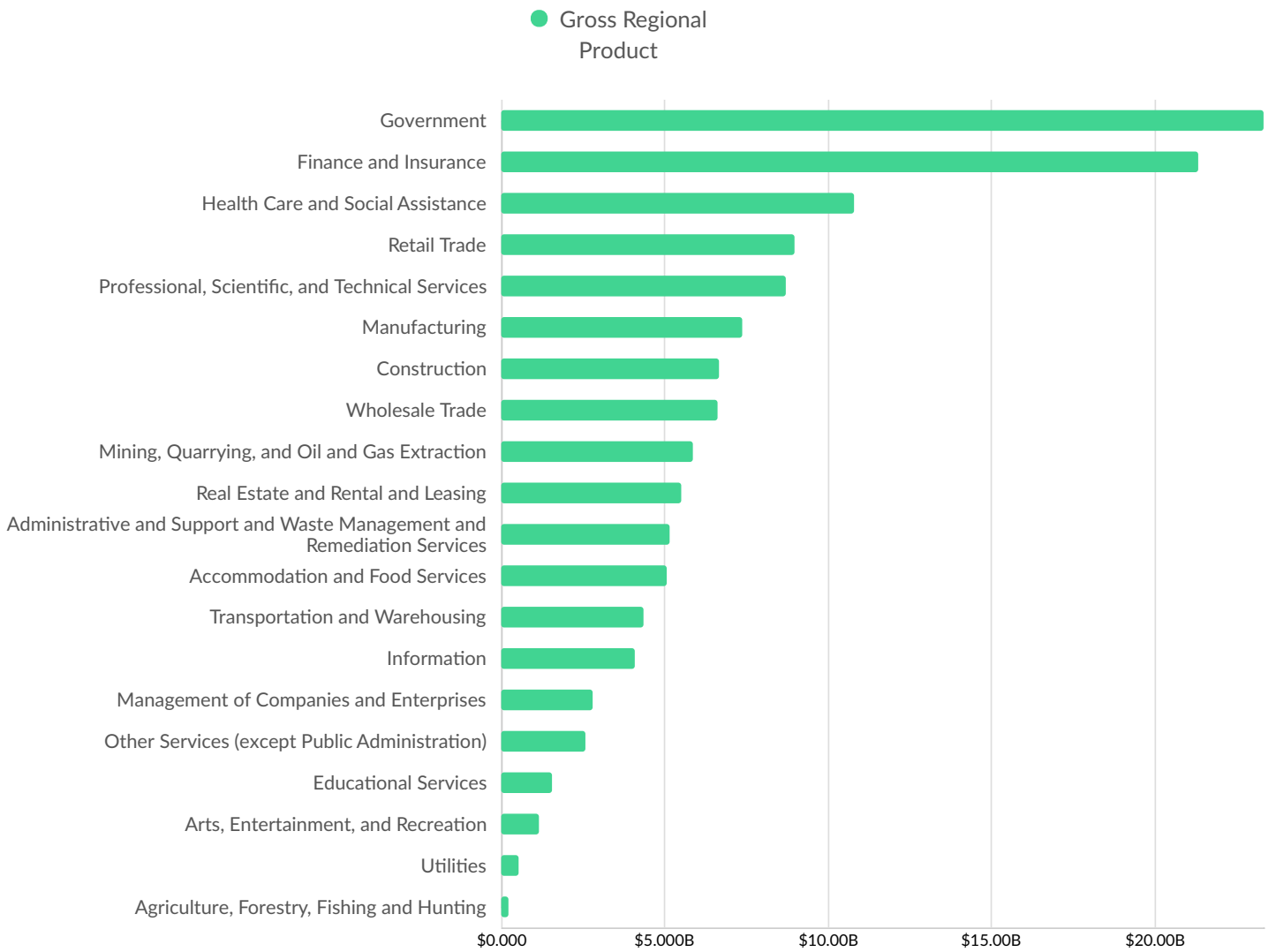

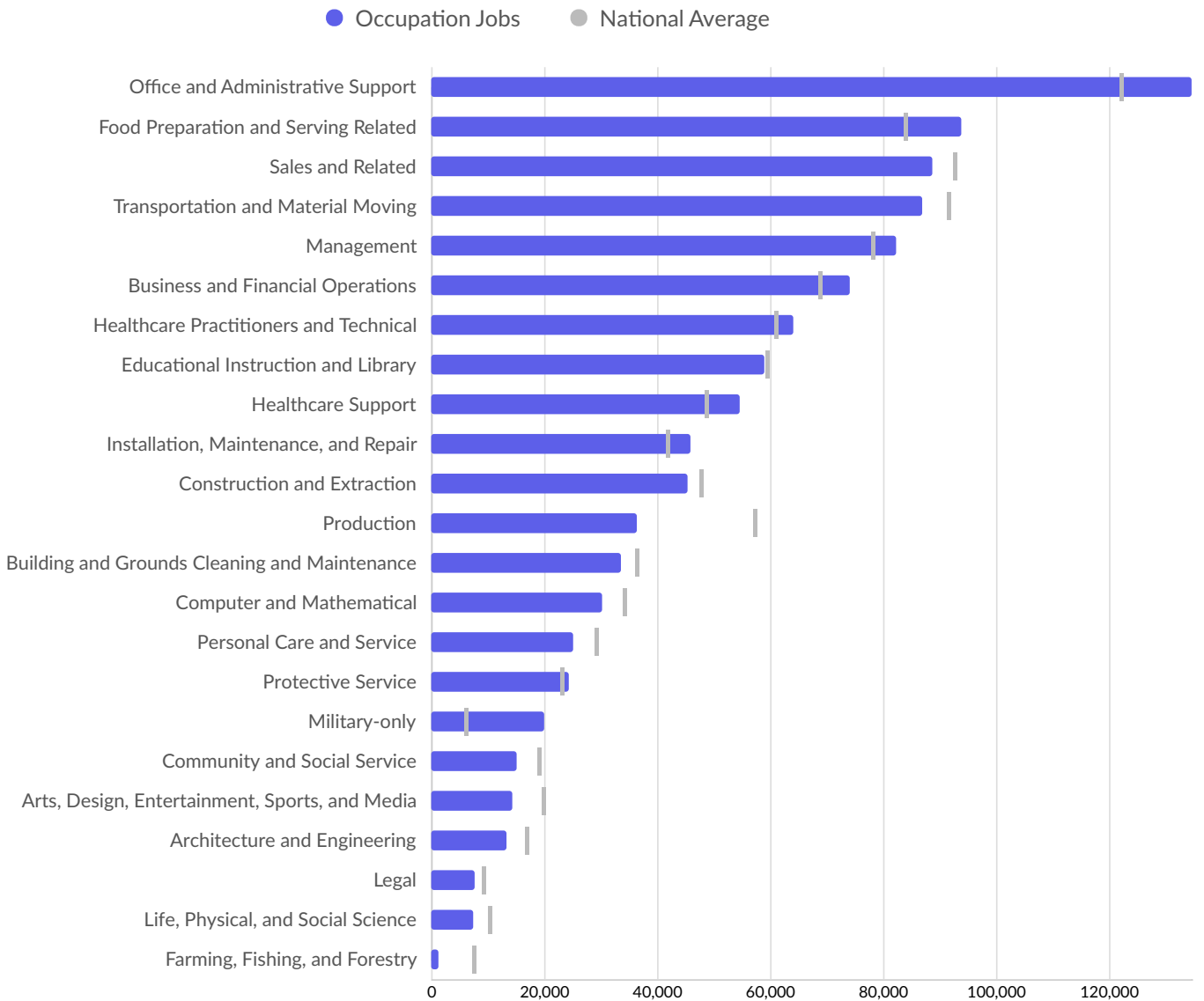

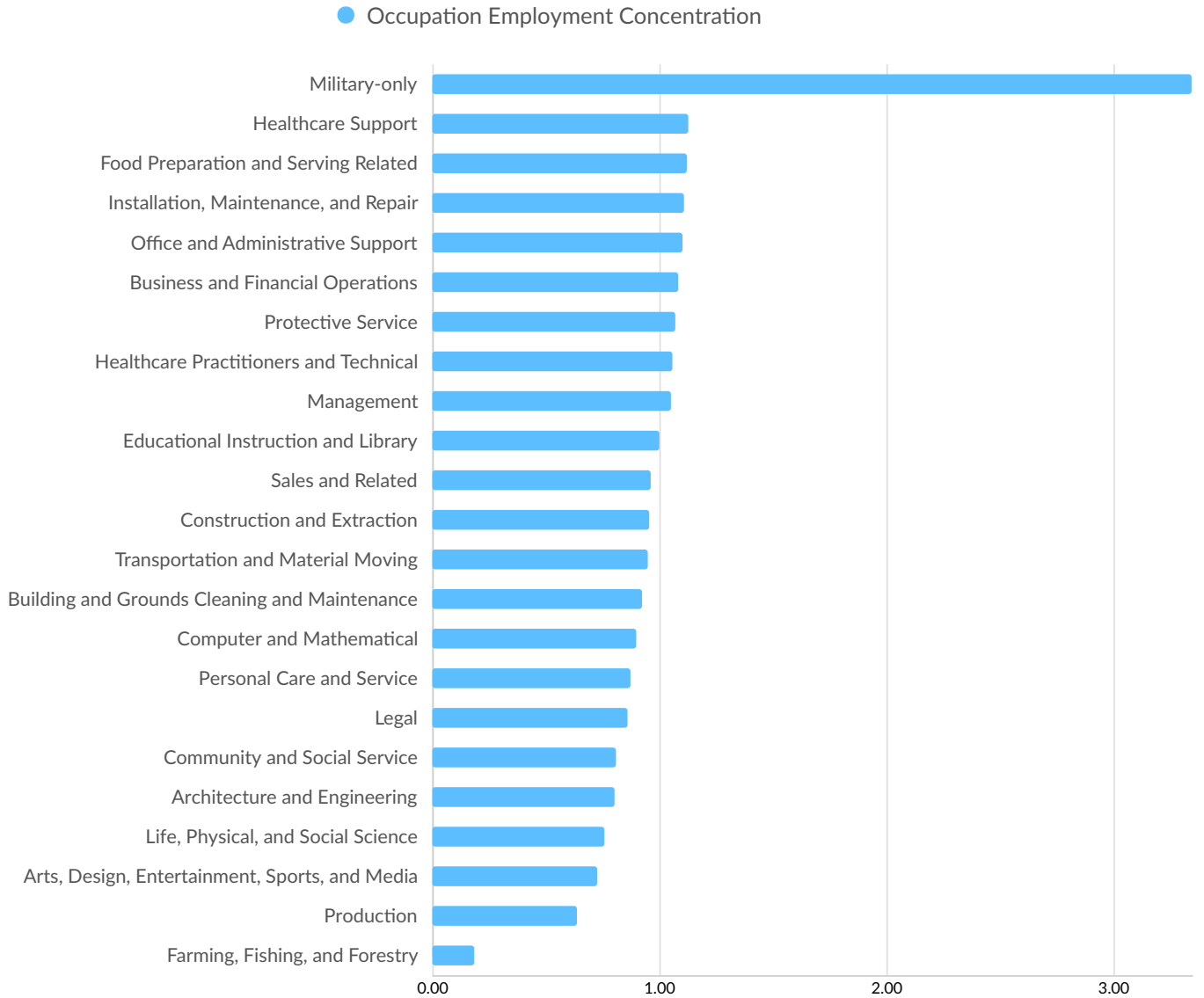
## Largest Occupations



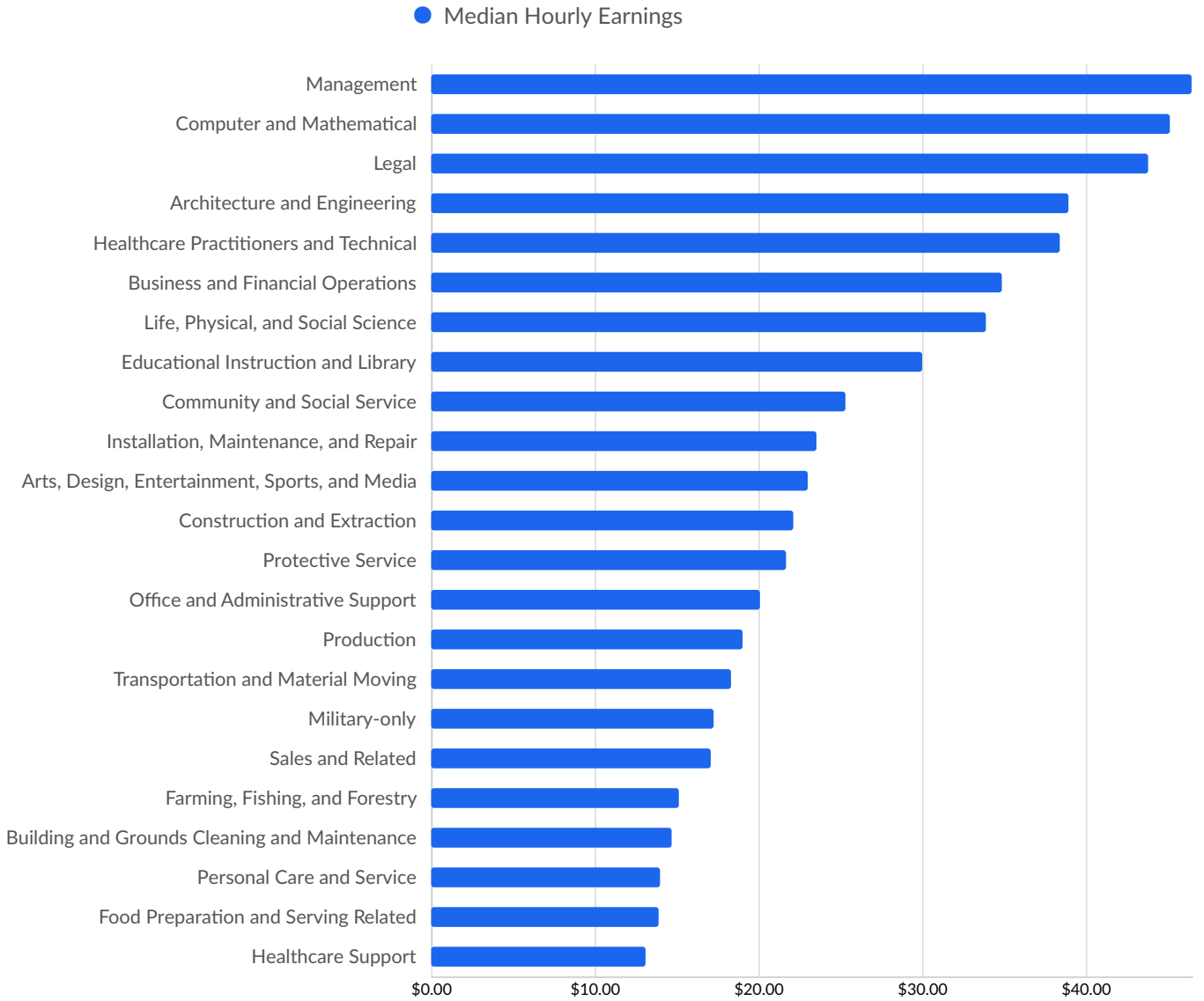
## Top Growing Occupations

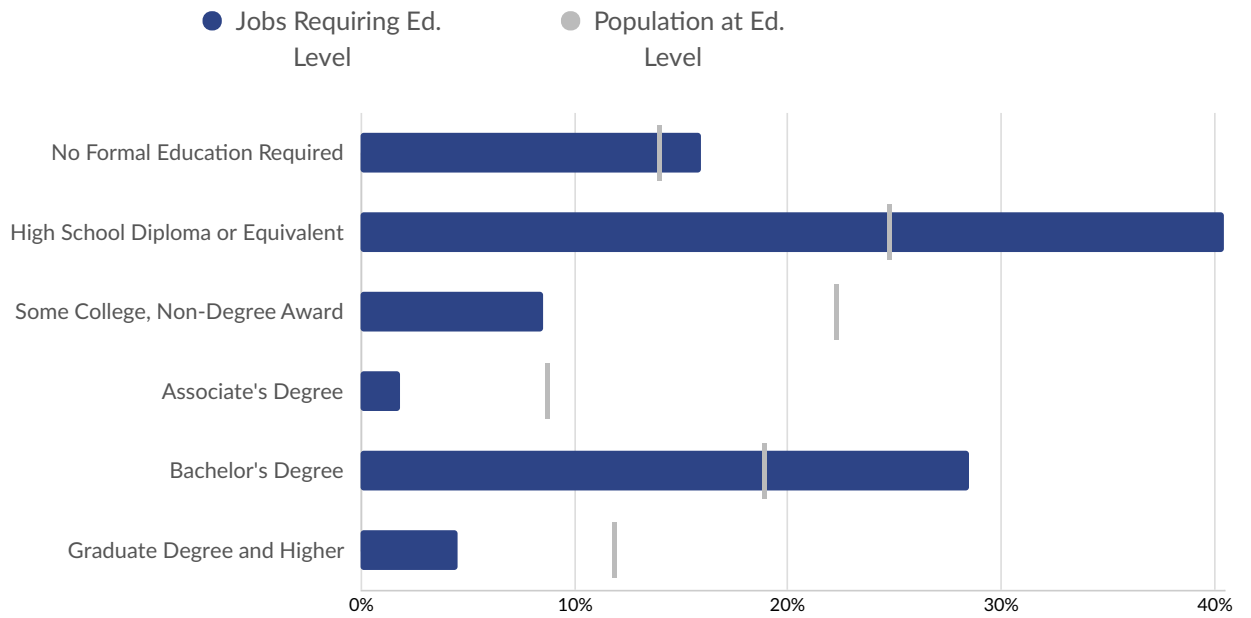
