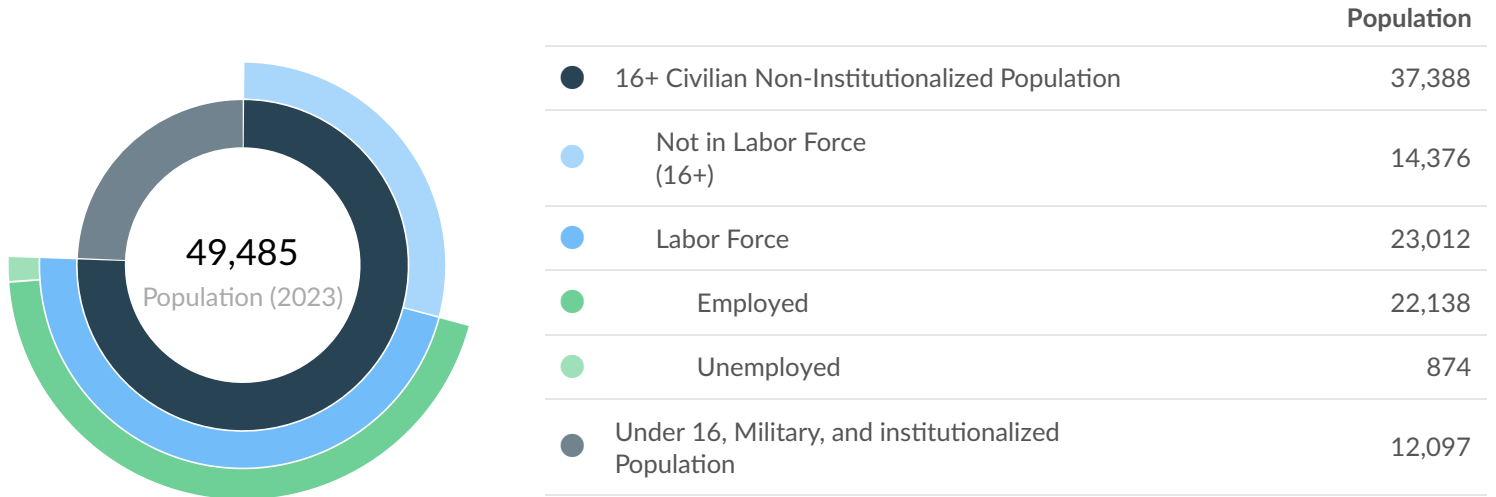
Median household income is **\$5.6K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

## Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 1.3%** since 2017, growing by 659. Population is expected to **decrease by 2.4%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 1,176.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **increased by 8.6%** in Atascosa County, TX from 14,867 to **16,144**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 4.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 56.2% to 59.9% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Atascosa County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **5.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Support Activities for Mining, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

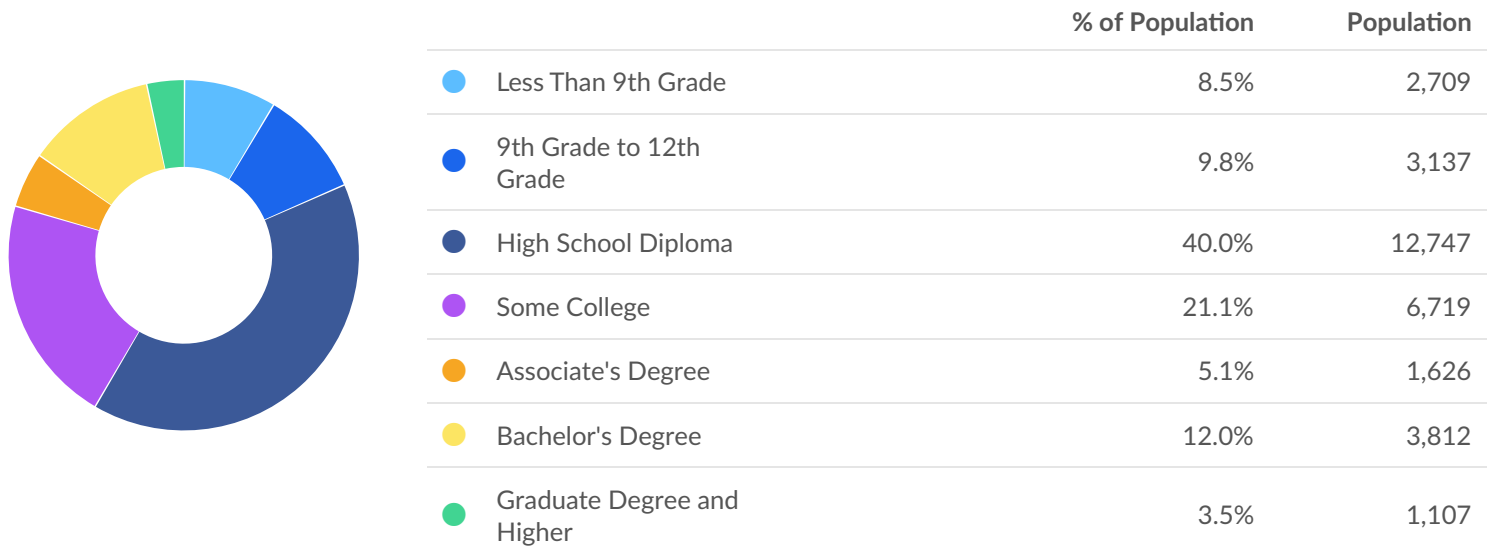

## Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



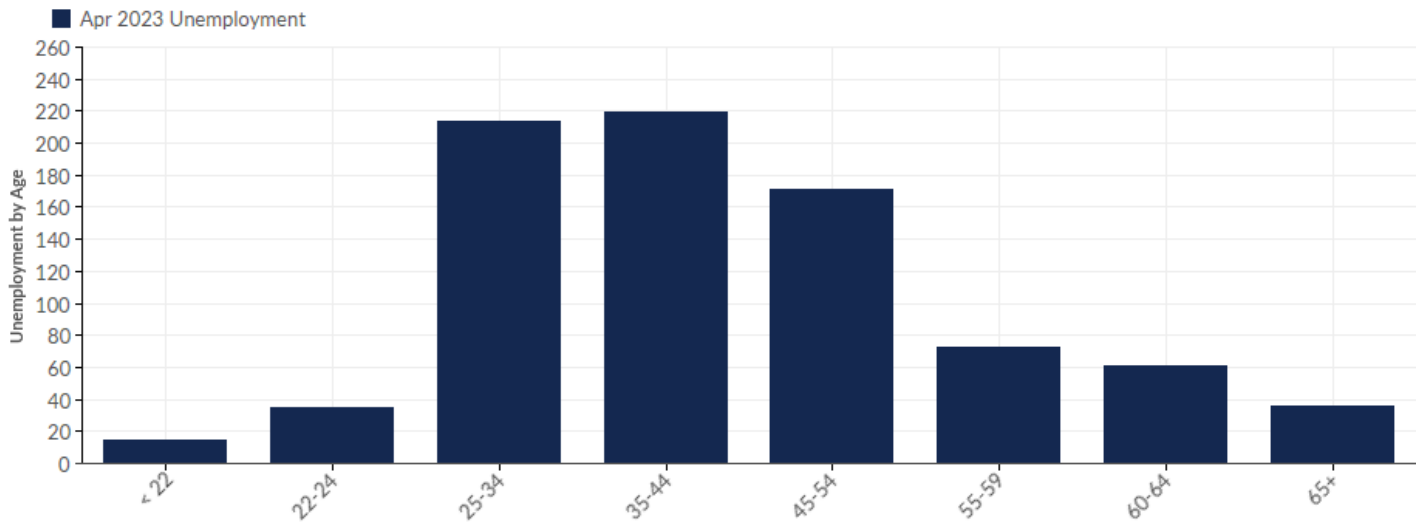
## Educational Attainment

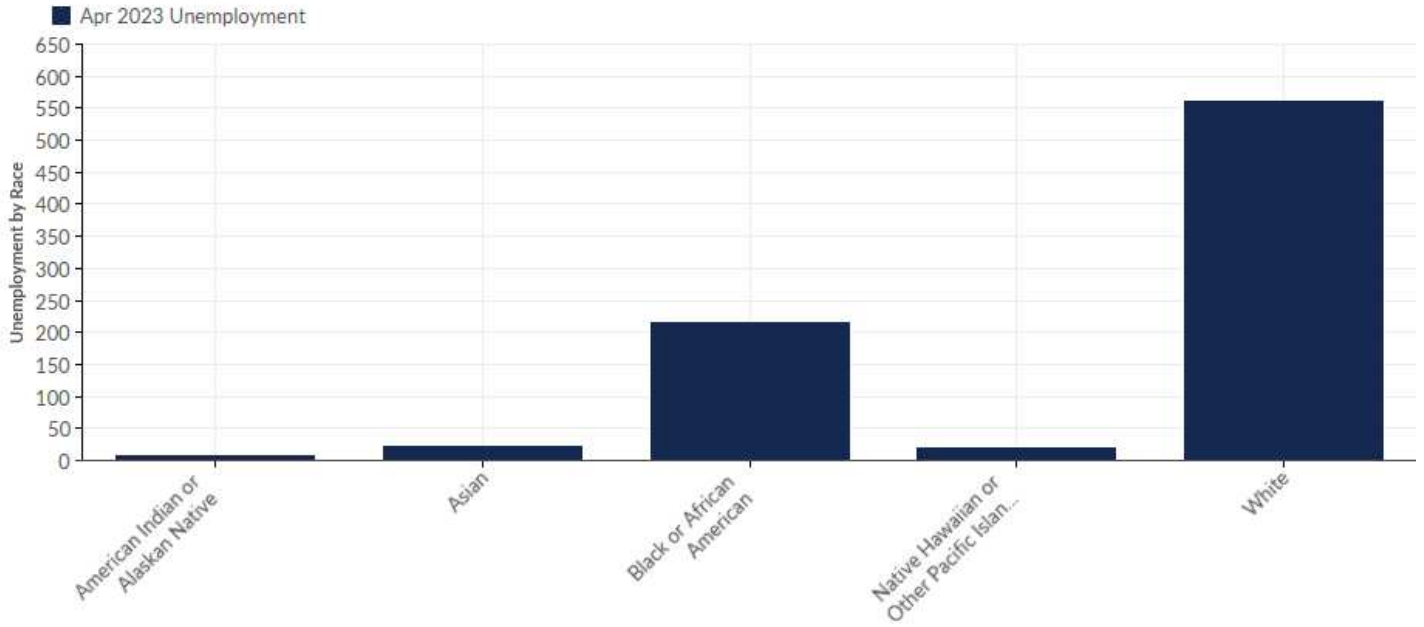

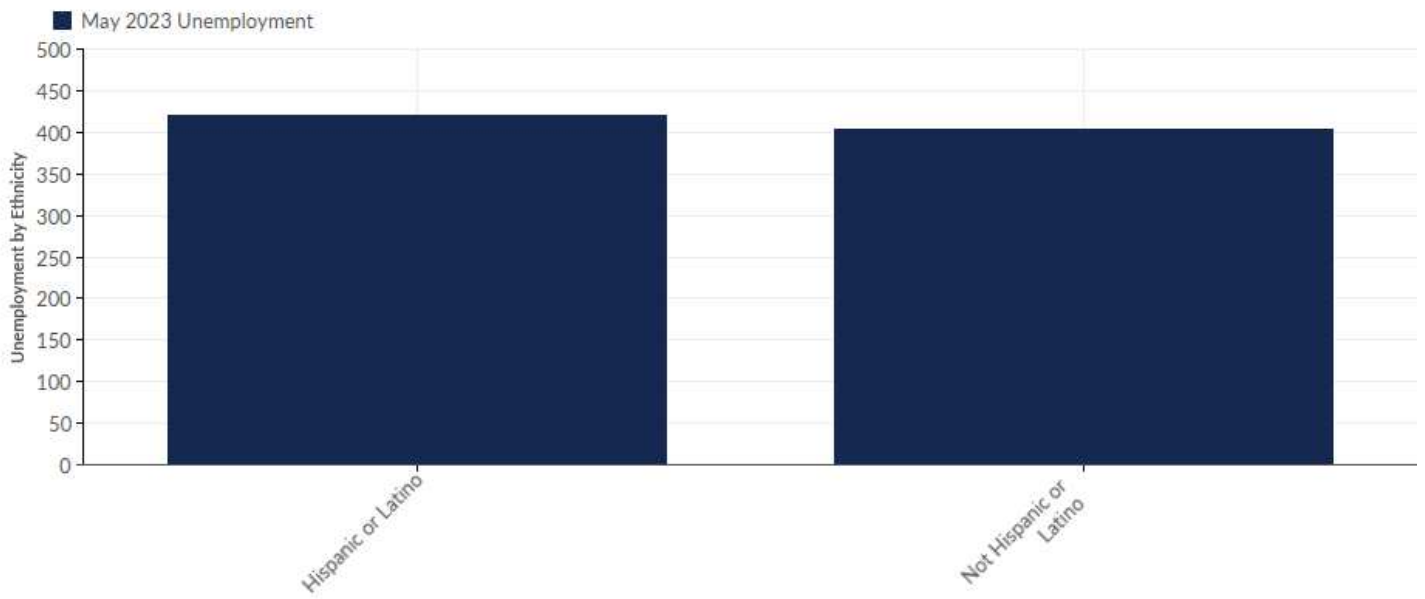

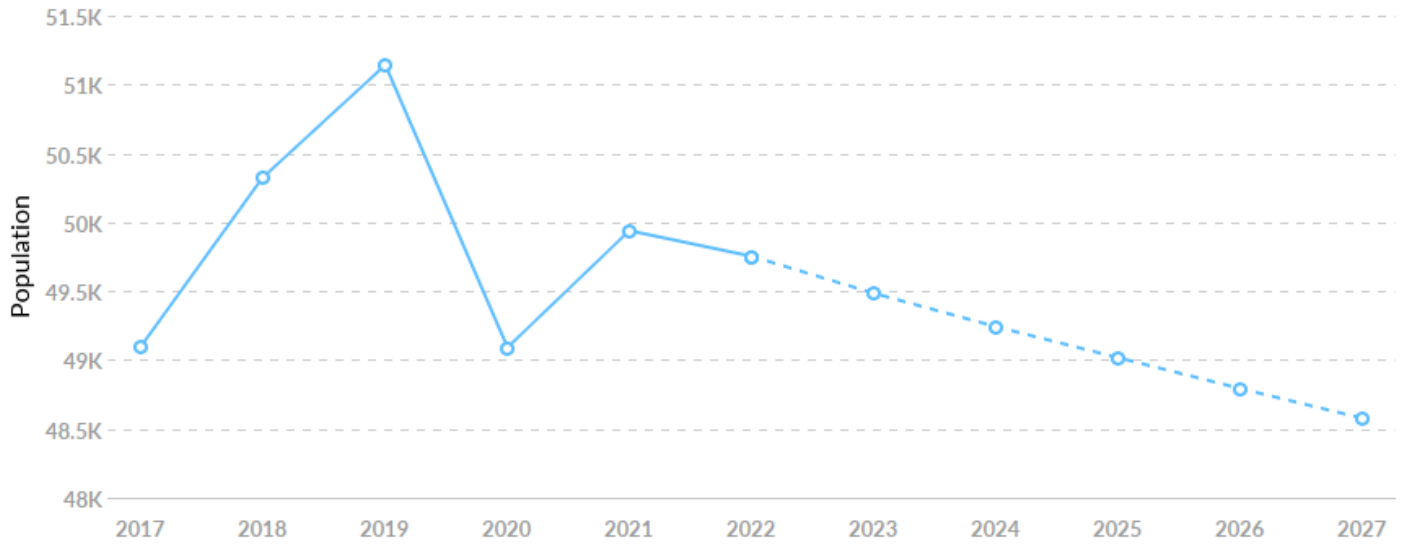

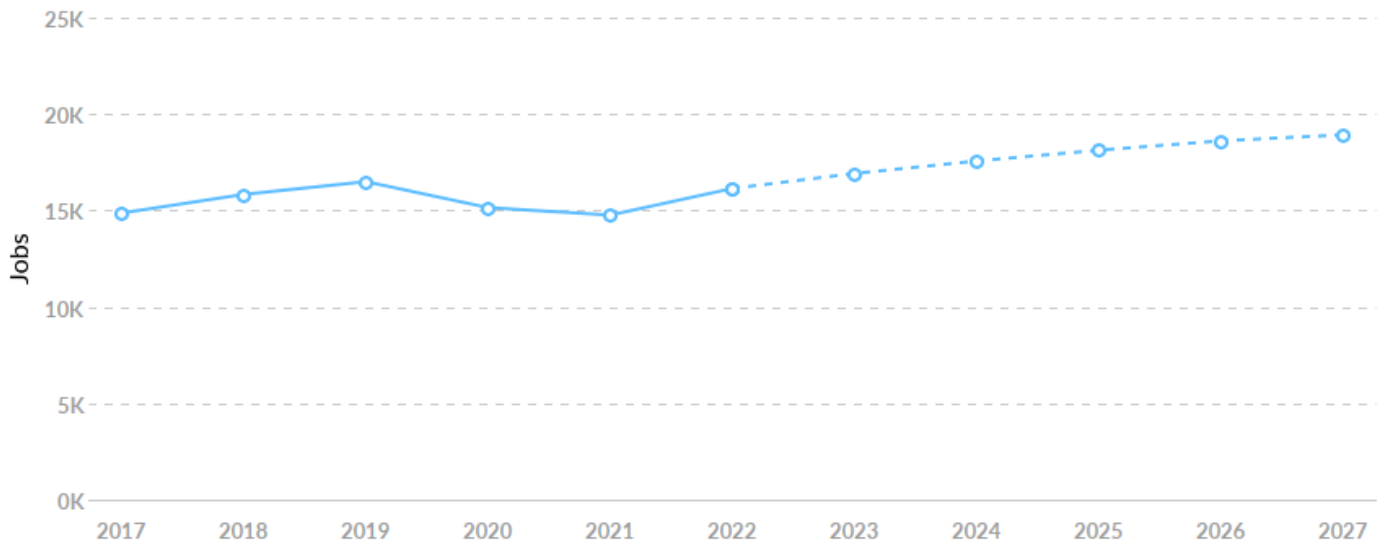

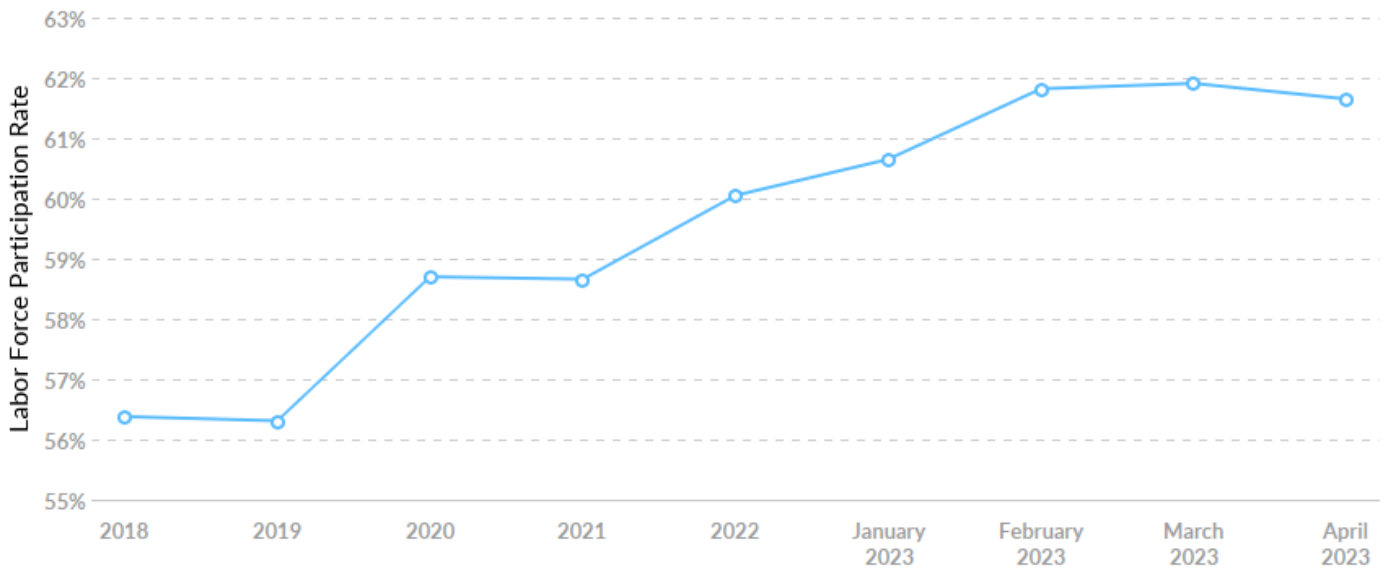
## Job Trends

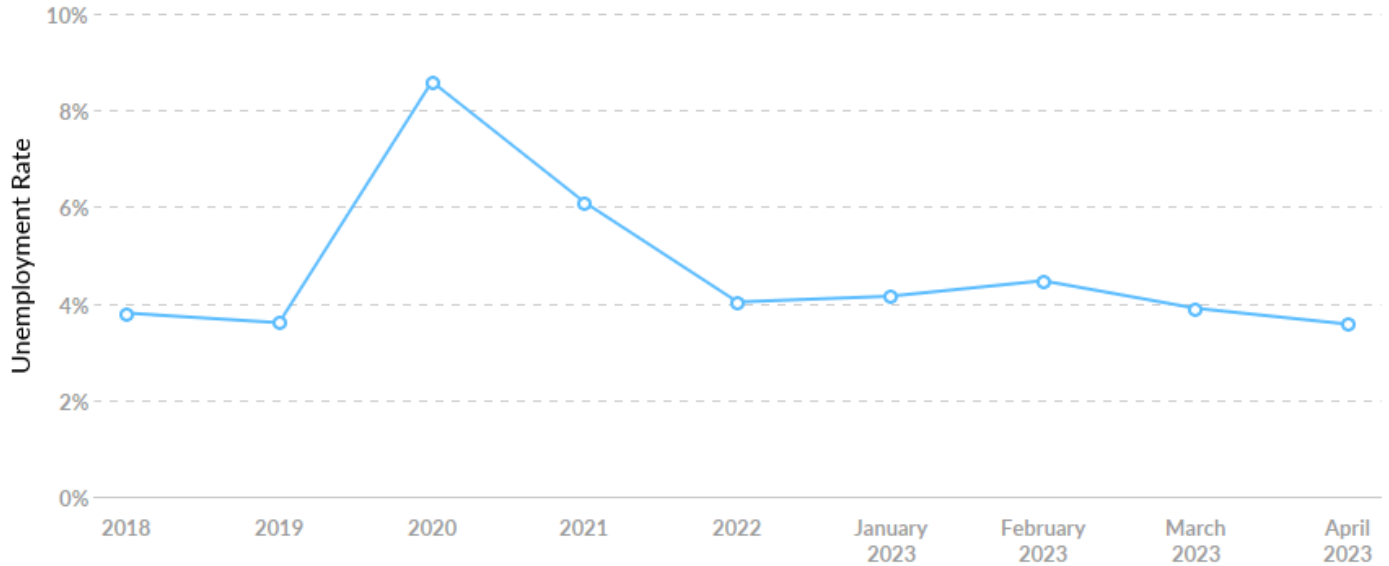

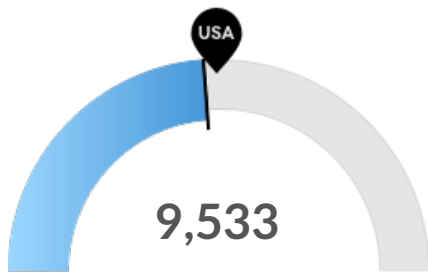
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Atascosa County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.57%, **decreasing from 3.80%** 5 years before.



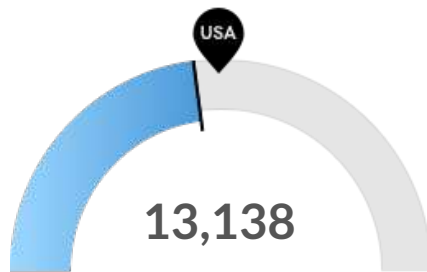

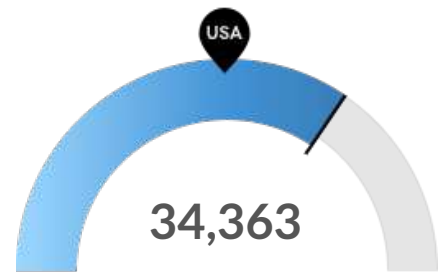
**Millennials**

Atascosa County, TX has 9,533 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,201.



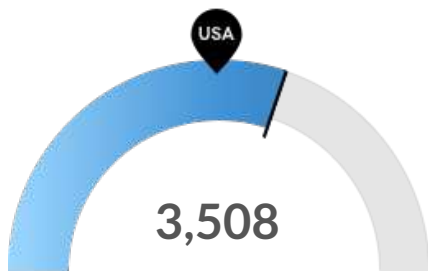
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is low in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 14,844 people 55 or older, while there are 13,138 here.



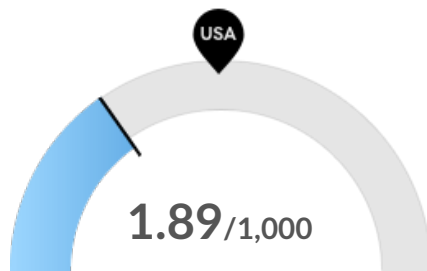
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is high in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 20,322 racially diverse people, while there are 34,363 here.



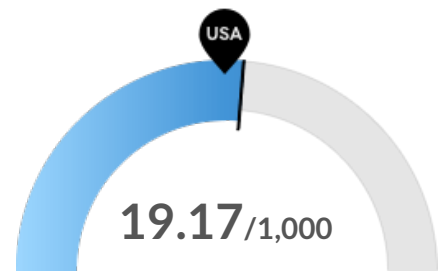
**Veterans**

Atascosa County, TX has 1.89 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

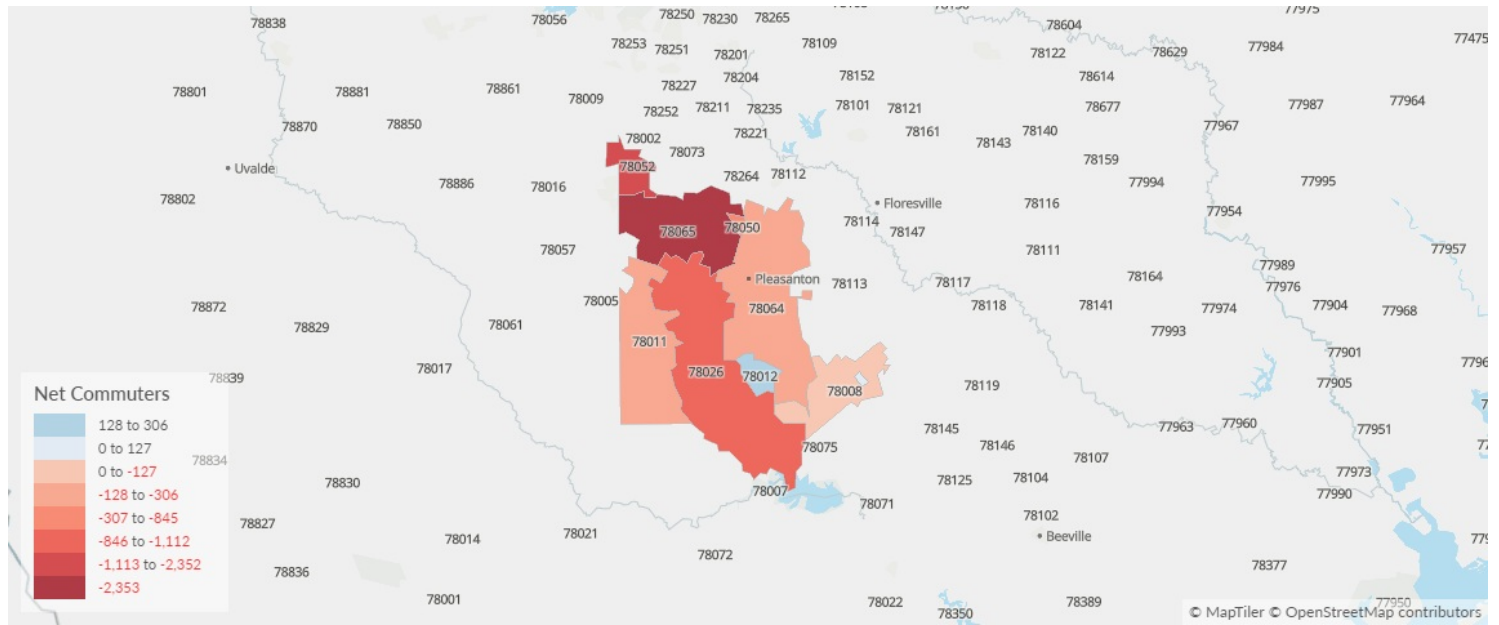


**Property Crime**

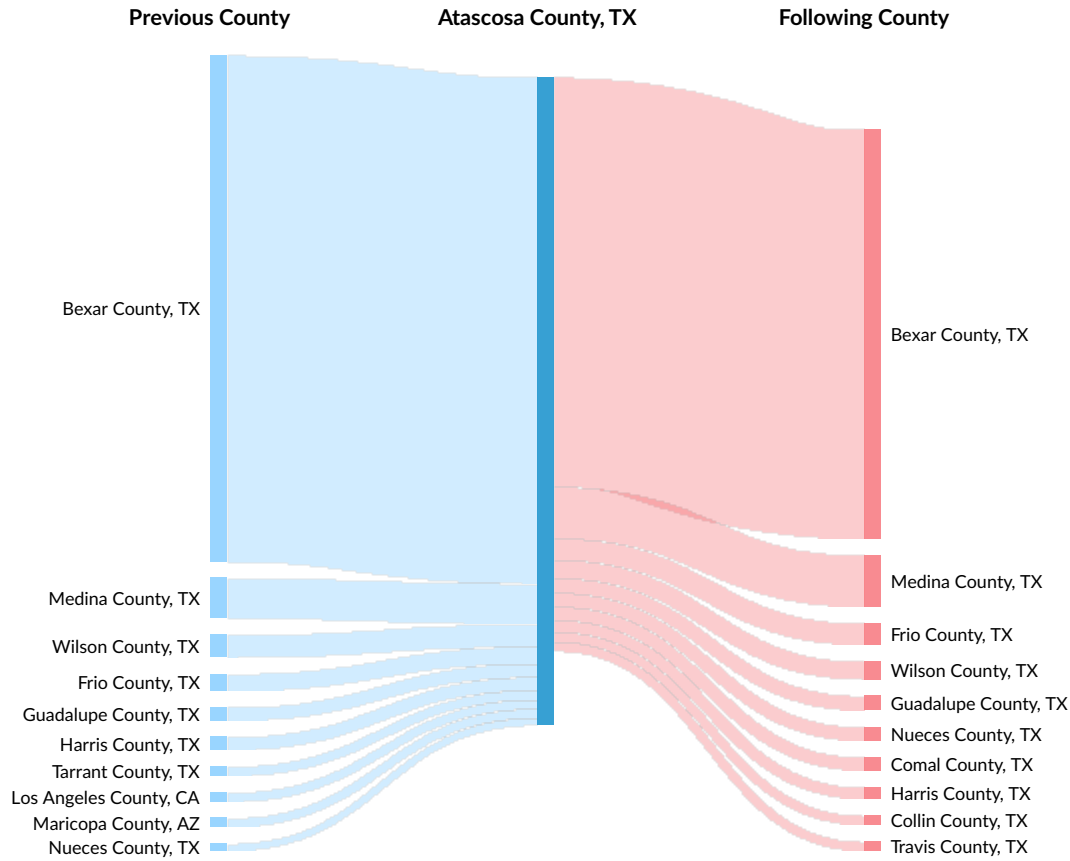

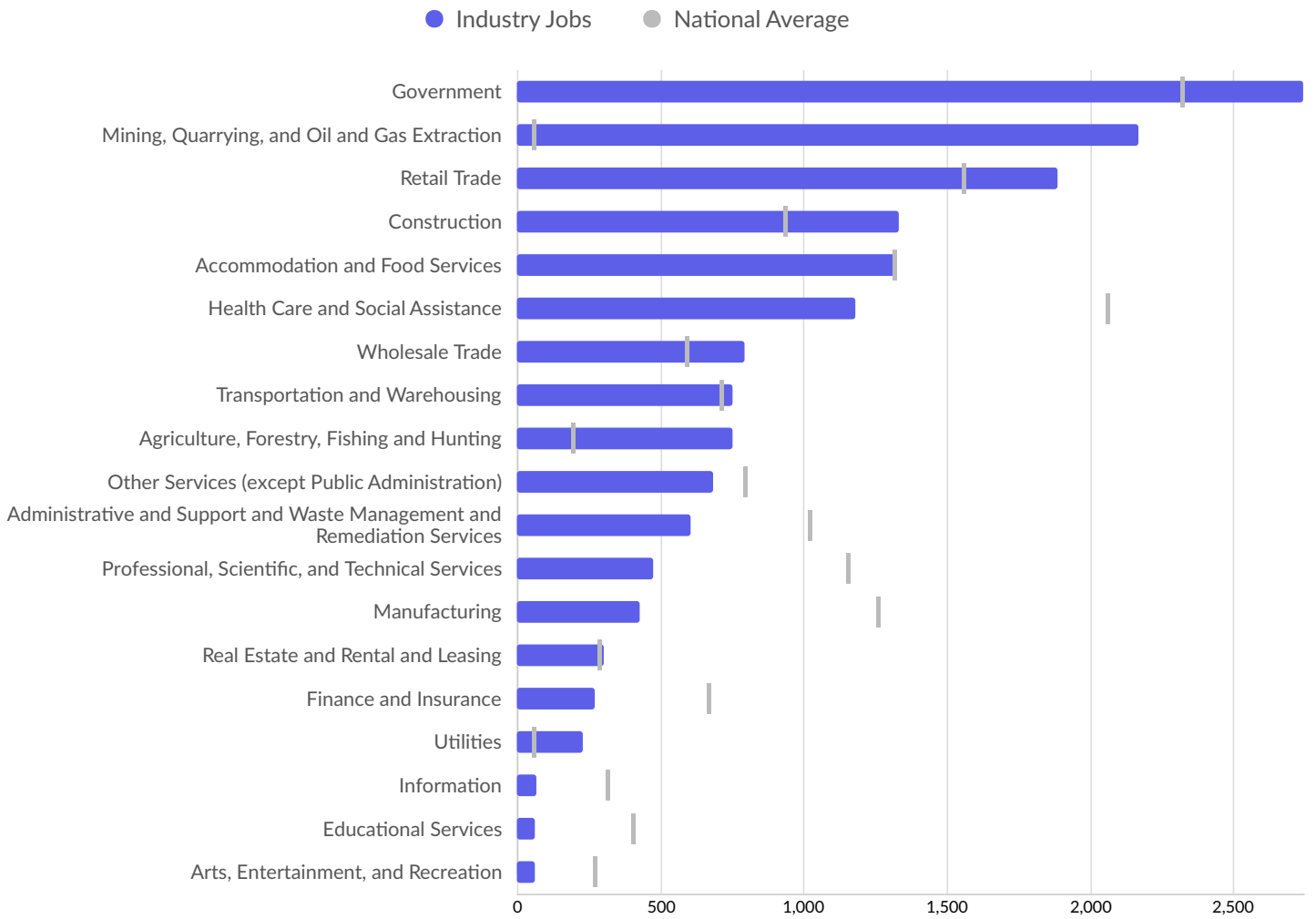

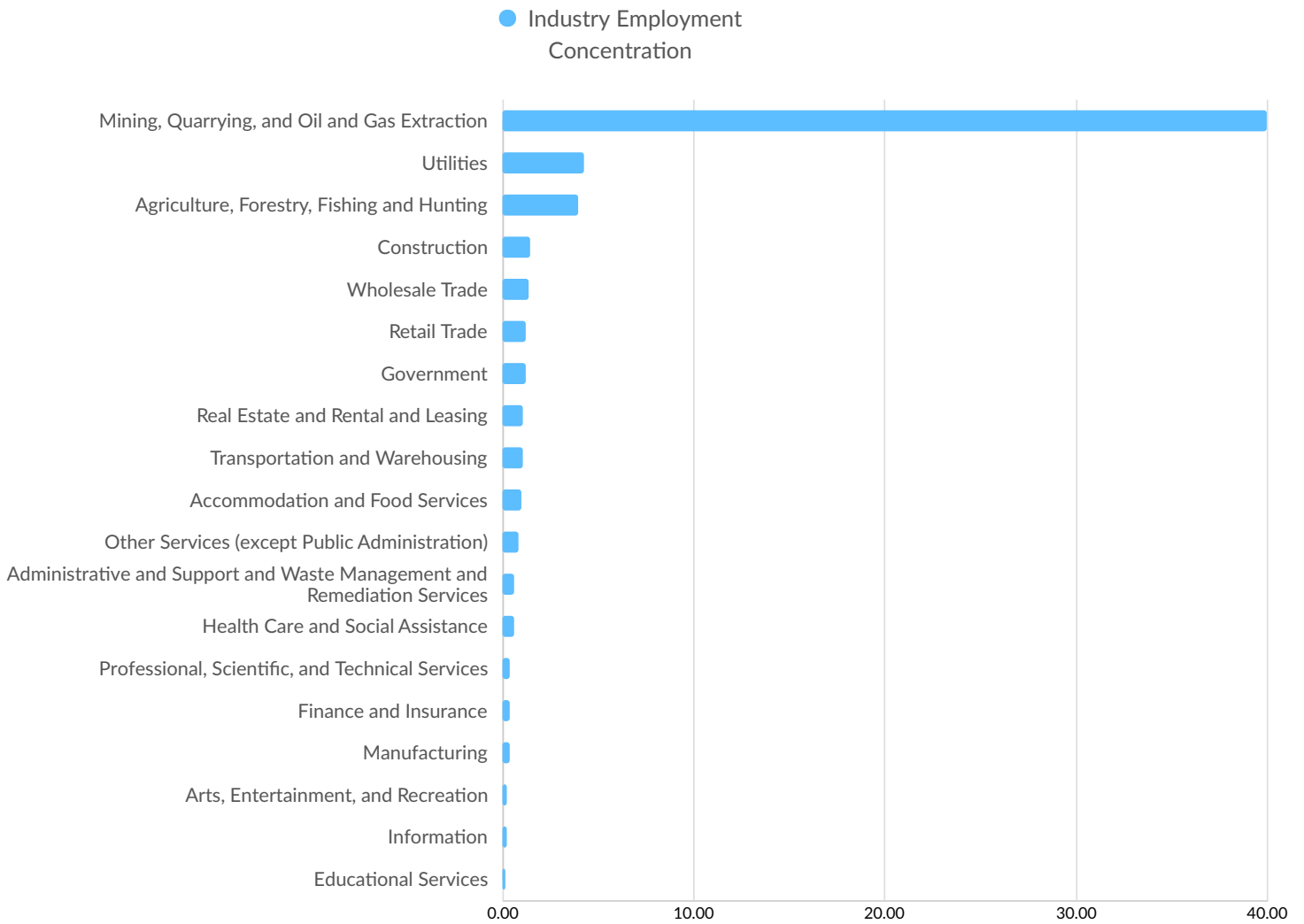

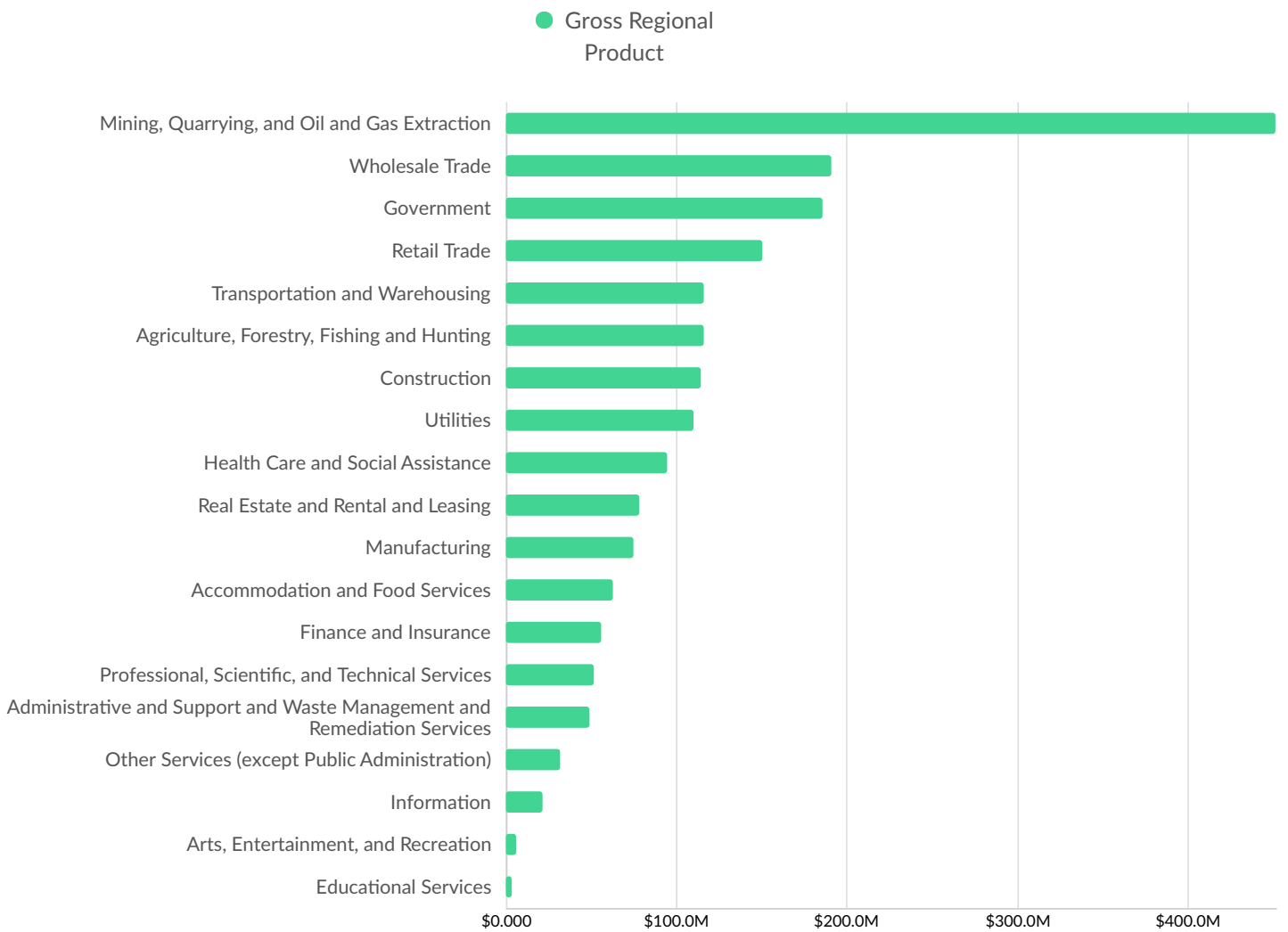

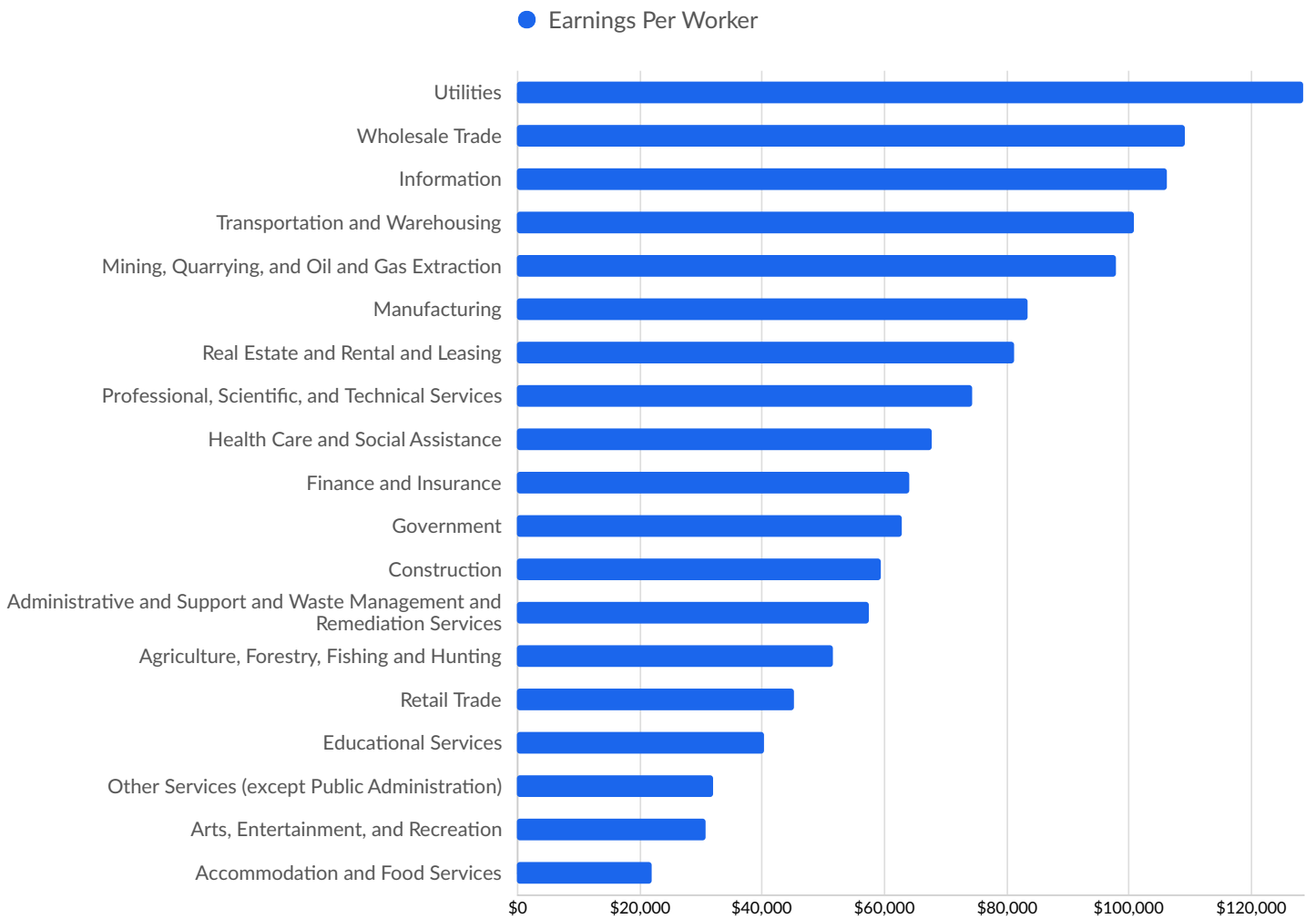
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

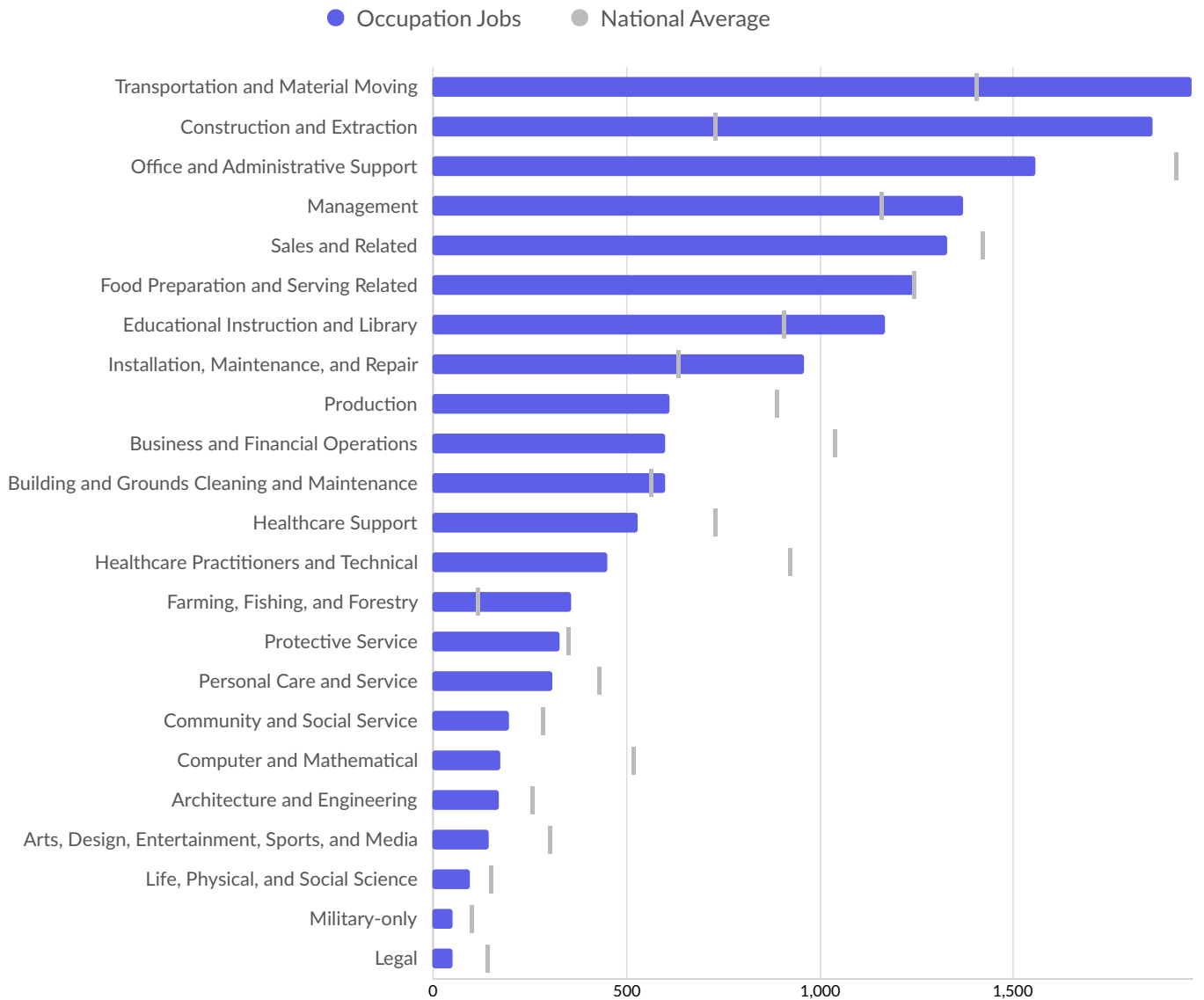

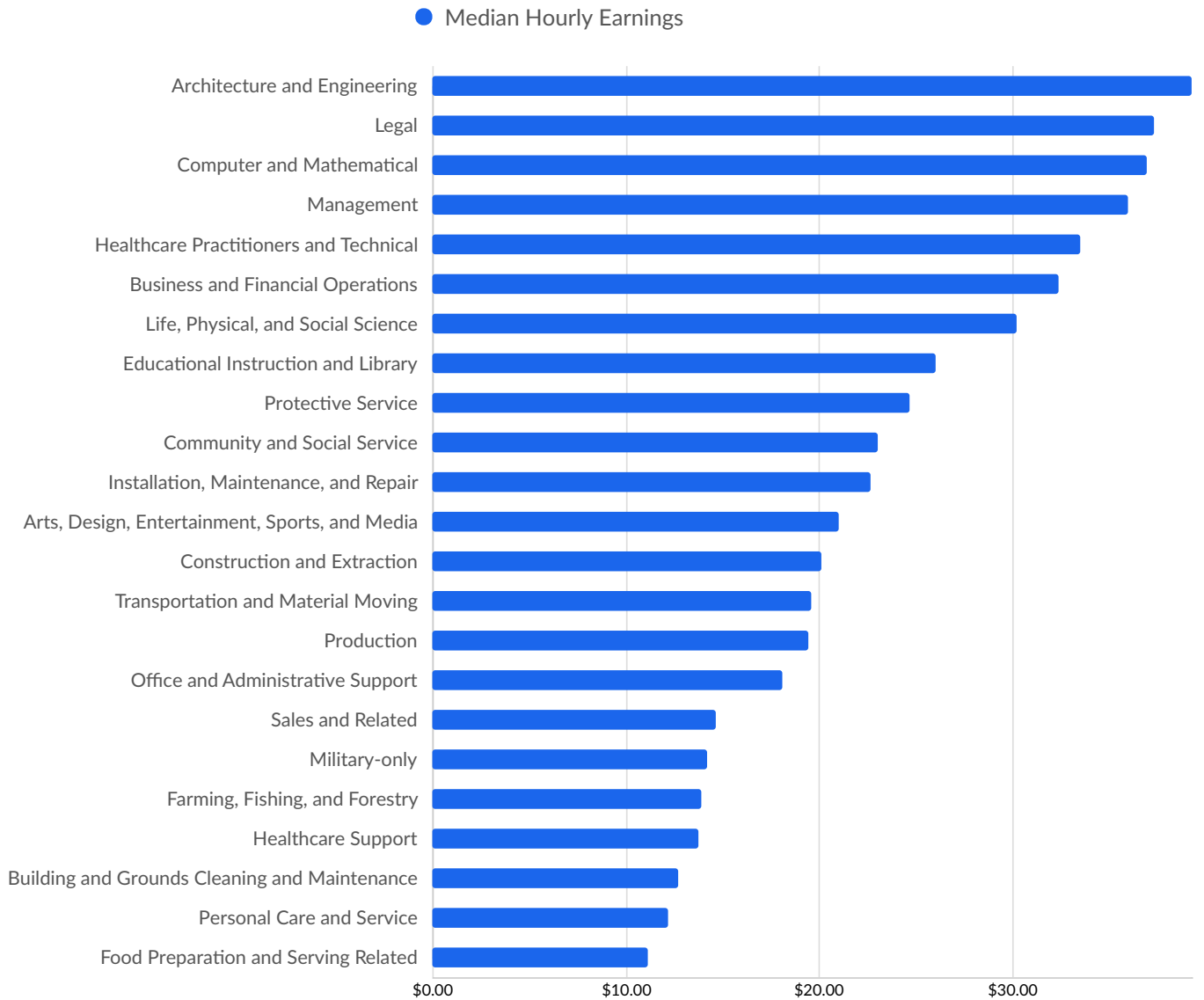


## Top Occupation Employment Concentration

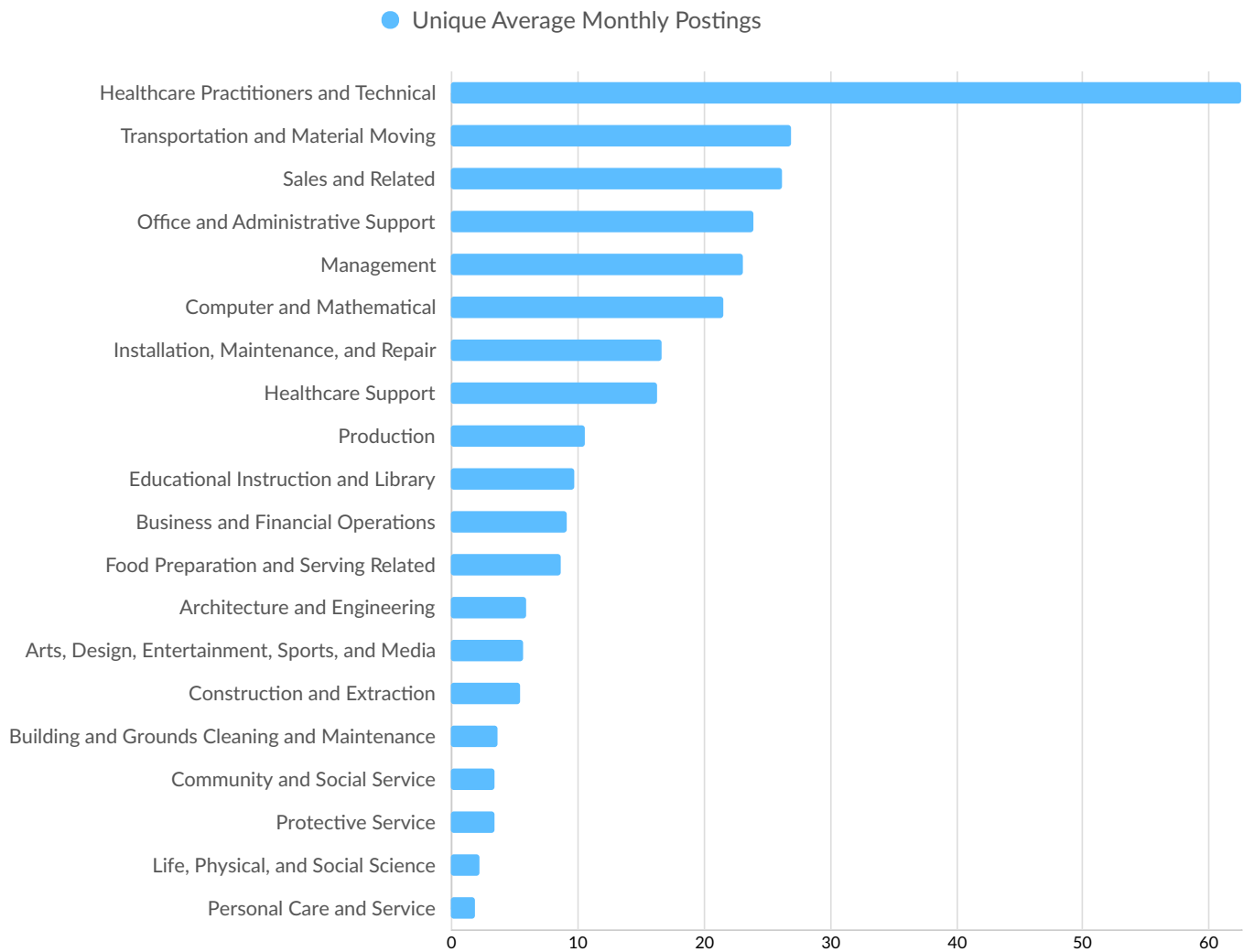

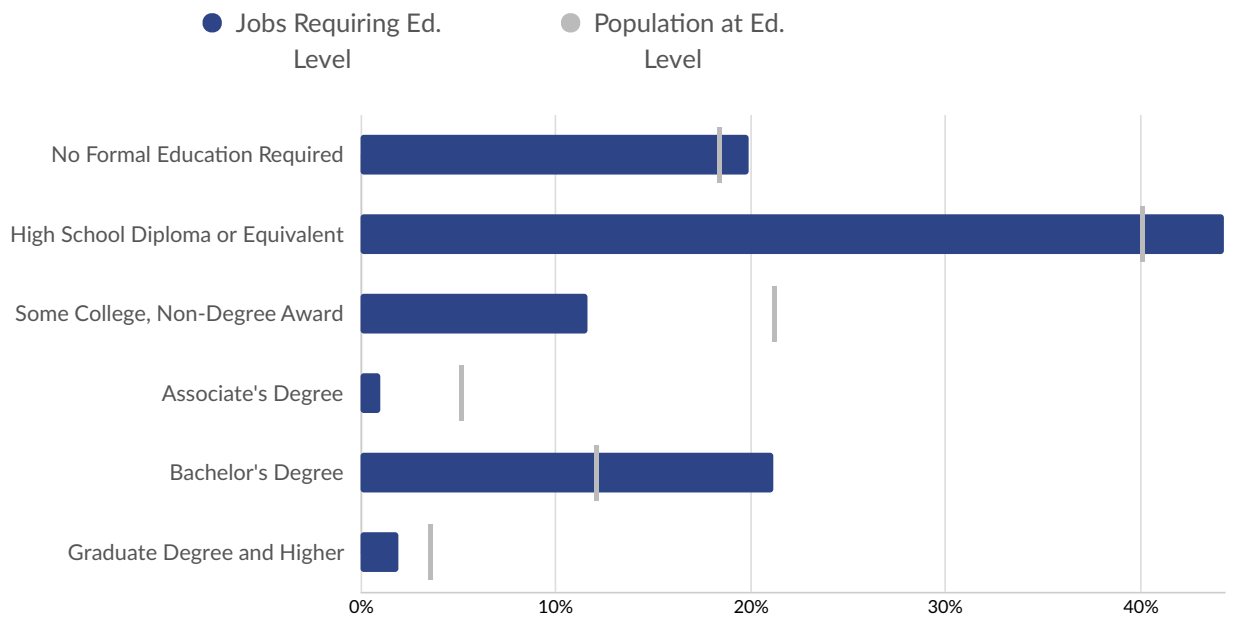
