- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.3% since 2017, growing by 659. Population is expected to decrease by 2.4% between 2022 and 2027, losing 1,176.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 8.6% in Atascosa County, TX from 14,867 to 16,144. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 56.2% to 59.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Atascosa County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **5.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Support Activities for Mining, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.




Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Atascosa County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.57%, decreasing from 3.80% 5 years before.




Millennials

Atascosa County, TX has 9,533 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,201.




Veterans

Atascosa County, TX has 3,508 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,623.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 14,844 people 55 or older, while there are 13,138 here.




Violent Crime

Atascosa County, TX has 1.89 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Racial Diversity

Property Crime


Atascosa County, TX has 19.17 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 17.8 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




