- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 12.3% in Bandera County, TX from 4,637 to 5,206. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 8.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 50.8% to 59.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.3% of Bandera County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.5% below the national average), and **10.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown







Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Bandera County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.23%, decreasing from 3.43% 5 years before.


Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Bandera County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 6,410 people 55 or older, while there are 10,170 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Bandera County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 8,776 racially diverse people, while there are 5,457 here.




Veterans

Bandera County, TX has 0.62 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




