- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Medina County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.48%, decreasing from 3.51% 5 years before.


Retirement risk is about average in Medina County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 15,451 people 55 or older, while there are 15,896 here.


Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Medina County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 21,153 racially diverse people, while there are 30,474 here.




Veterans

Medina County, TX has 2 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




