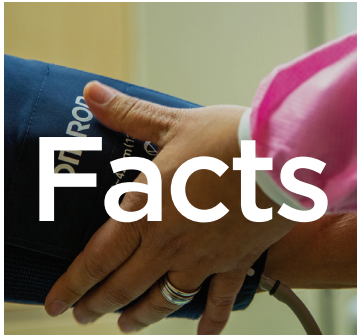


REGISTERED NURSE (RN)

Registered nurses (RNs) are critical in helping to improve the lives of millions of patients through effective, compassionate delivery of care, education, and one-on-one guidance. An RN's primary role is to ensure that patients receive the proper care needed, whether in hospital/acute care settings or primary care/clinic settings. RN duties differ across healthcare facility types, geography, team size, specialty, and the populations they serve. All registered nurses are licensed. Many begin their occupational journey through more entry-level patient care roles, like certified nursing assistants (CNAs) and medical assistants (MAs).



Demand for RNs will increase by 8% through 2025.



There is a strong demand for RNs with 1,588 unique job postings per month.



Typical education required: 2- to 4-year degree or training program, followed by clinical rotation and licensure exam.



RN jobs within the San Antonio region have a median annual salary of \$79,061.

In-Demand Knowledge and Skills

- Excellent communication, teamwork, critical thinking, problem-solving, and conflict resolution skills
- Knowledge of medical terminology, medications, medical record-keeping, and medical technologies
- Ability to measure and monitor vital signs and administer procedures
- Leadership and management skills

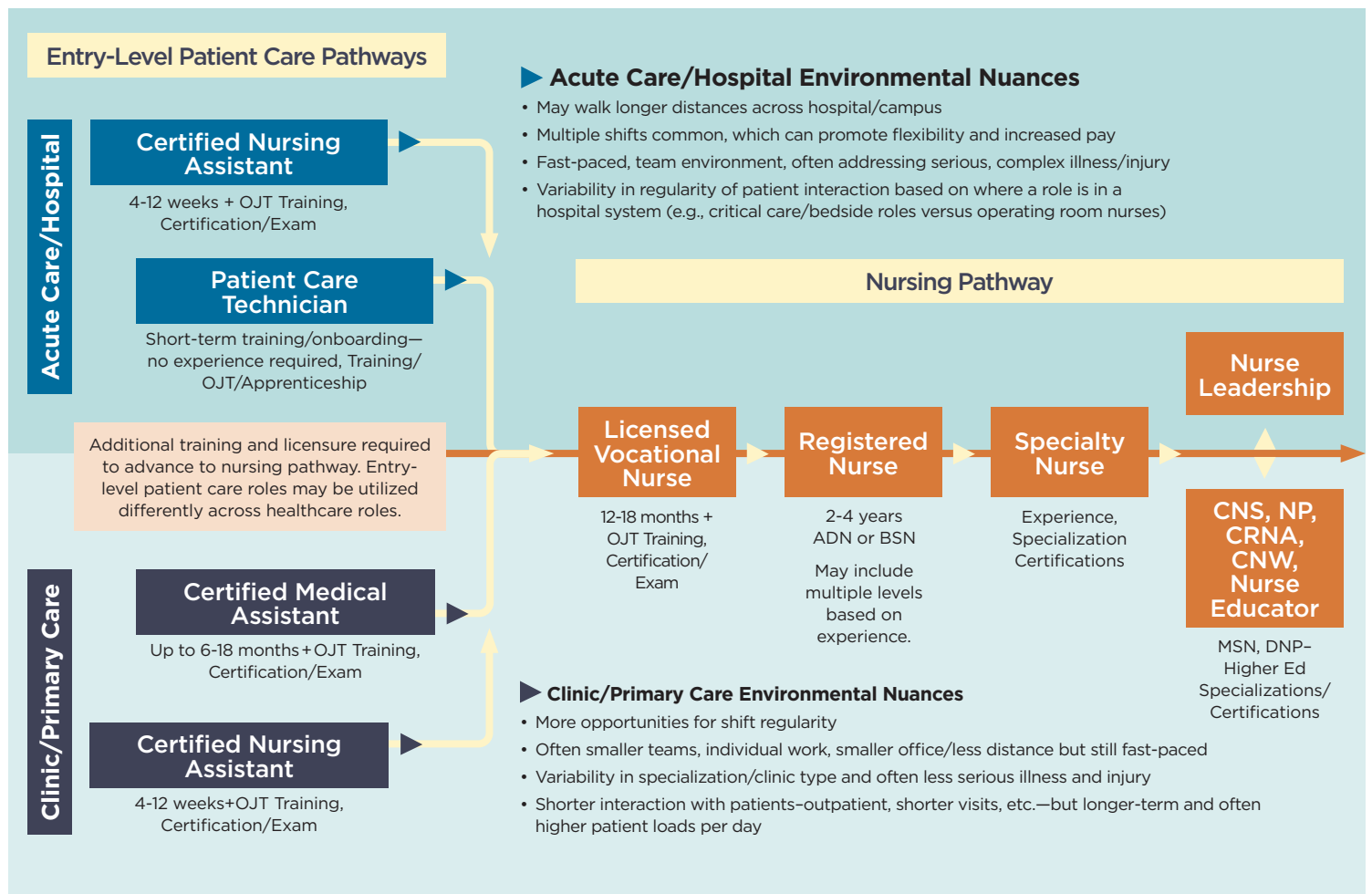
Typical On-the-Job Duties

- Assessing, observing, monitoring vital signs, and speaking to patients
- Recording details and symptoms of patients' medical histories and current health
- Preparing patients and/or administering exams and treatments
- Leading and supervising nursing and direct patient care teams (e.g., CNAs, MAs, PCTs, LVNs)
- Operating and monitoring medical equipment

What career options do I have?

Obtaining licensure as a registered nurse (RN) typically takes 2-4 years. Many RNs begin their career in other patient care roles like certified nursing assistants and medical assistants and are supported by their employers to obtain their RN license. RNs typically obtain specializations through on-the-job learning and/or certifications and work with a team of specialists and physicians based on location, medical function, and population served. RNs can also obtain additional education and licensure to become a clinical nurse specialist (CNS), nurse practitioner (NP), certified registered nurse anesthetist (CRNA), certified nurse midwife (CNW), or nurse educator.
