- As of 2021 the region's population **increased by 8.0%** since 2016, growing by 3,888. Population is expected to **increase by 7.8%** between 2021 and 2026, adding 4,093.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs **increased by 2.9%** in Atascosa County, TX from 14,324 to **14,741**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 0.4% by 3.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 56.5% to 56.6% between 2016 and 2021**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.6% of Atascosa County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.8% below the national average), and **4.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Support Activities for Mining, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

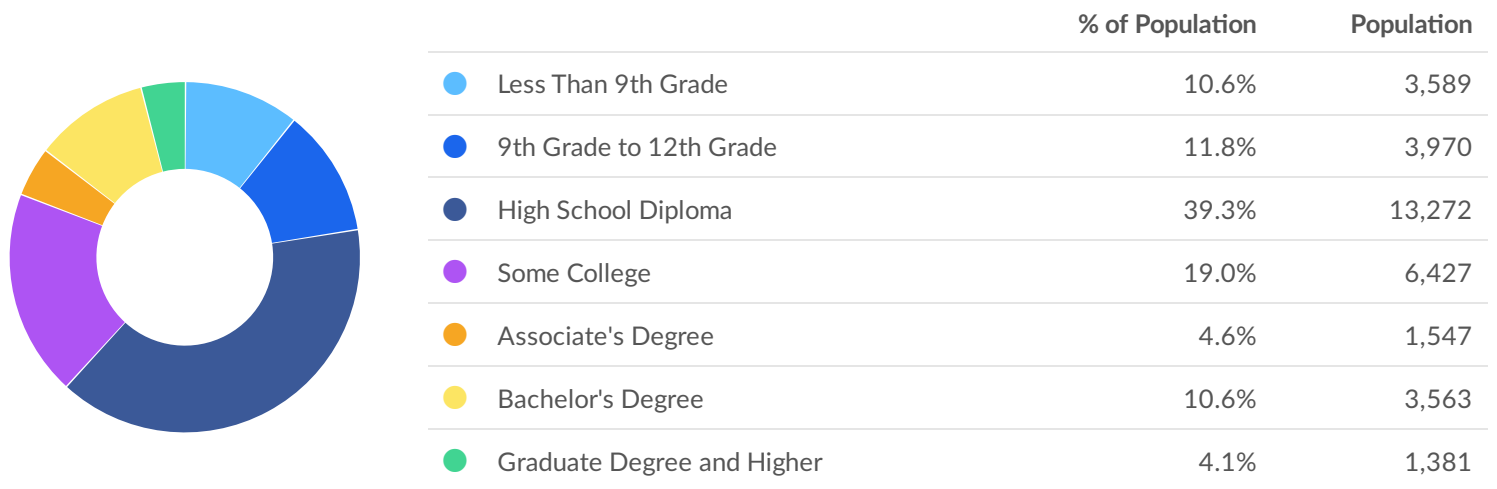

Dec 2021 Labor Force Breakdown



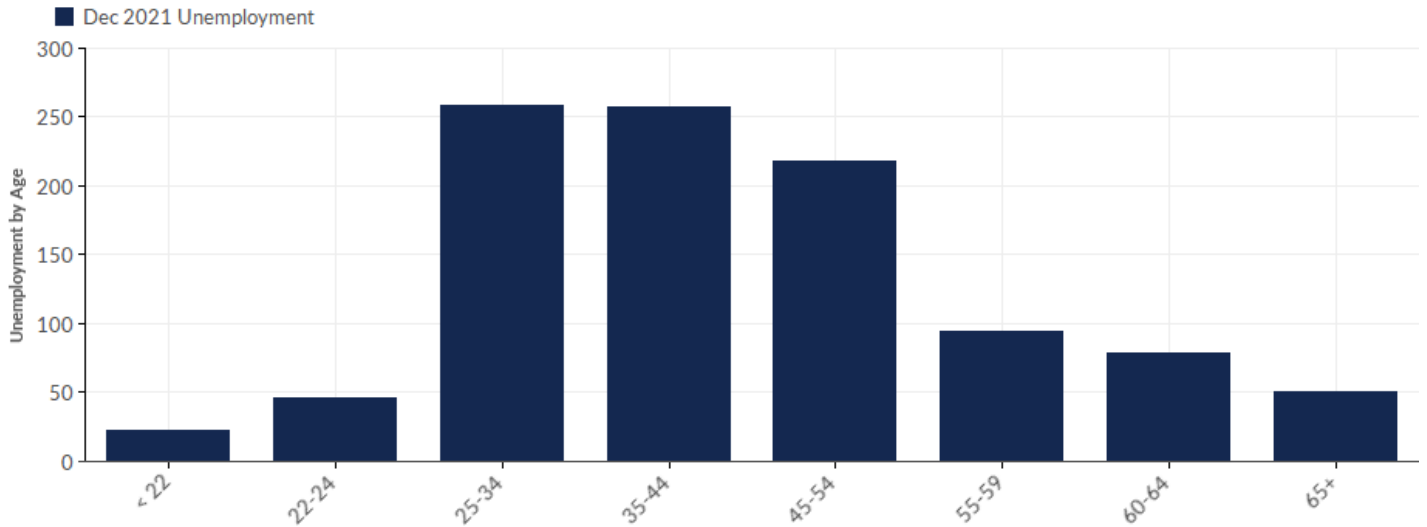
Educational Attainment

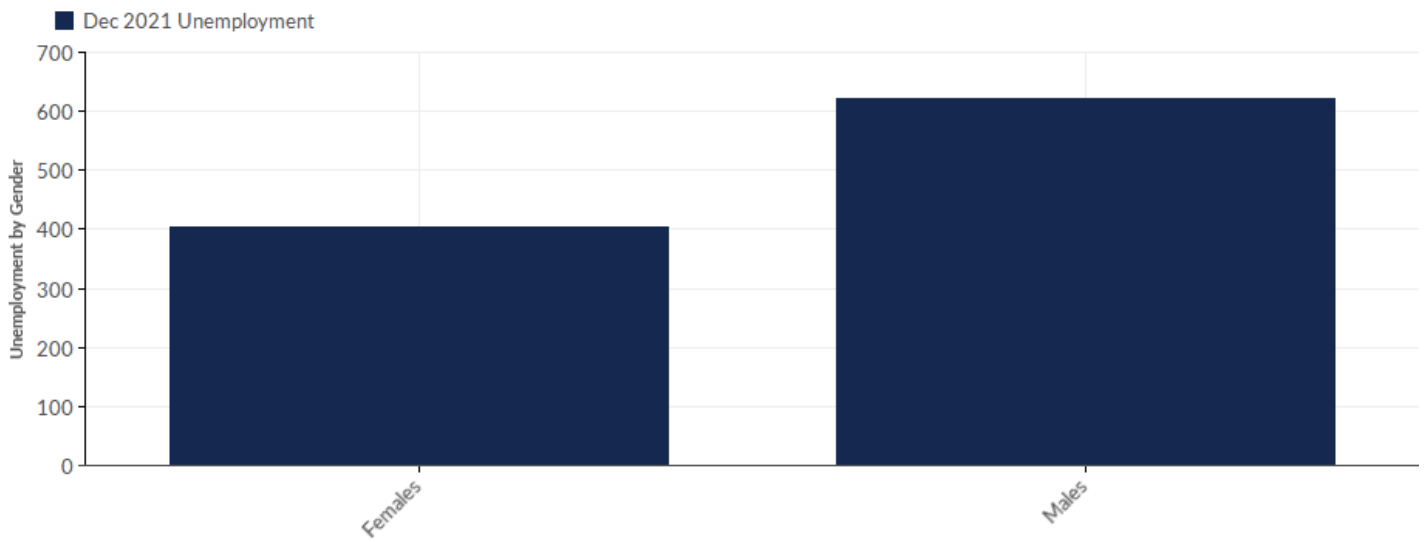

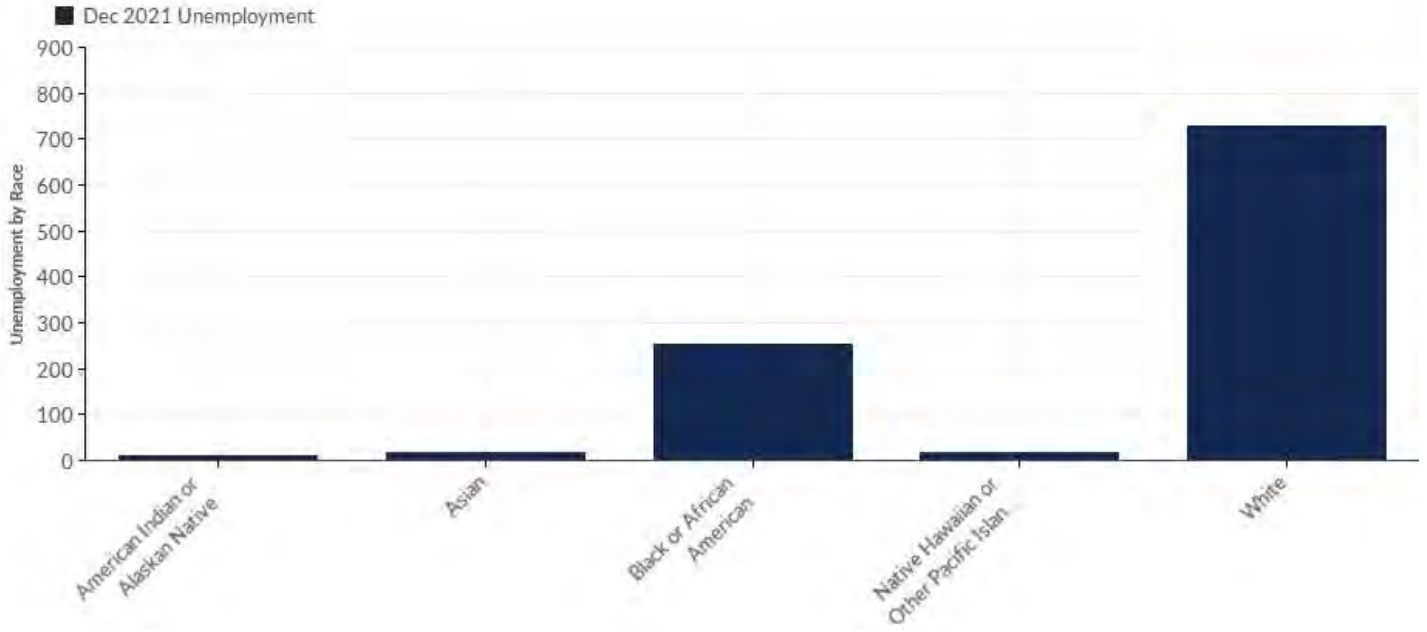

Unemployment by Gender



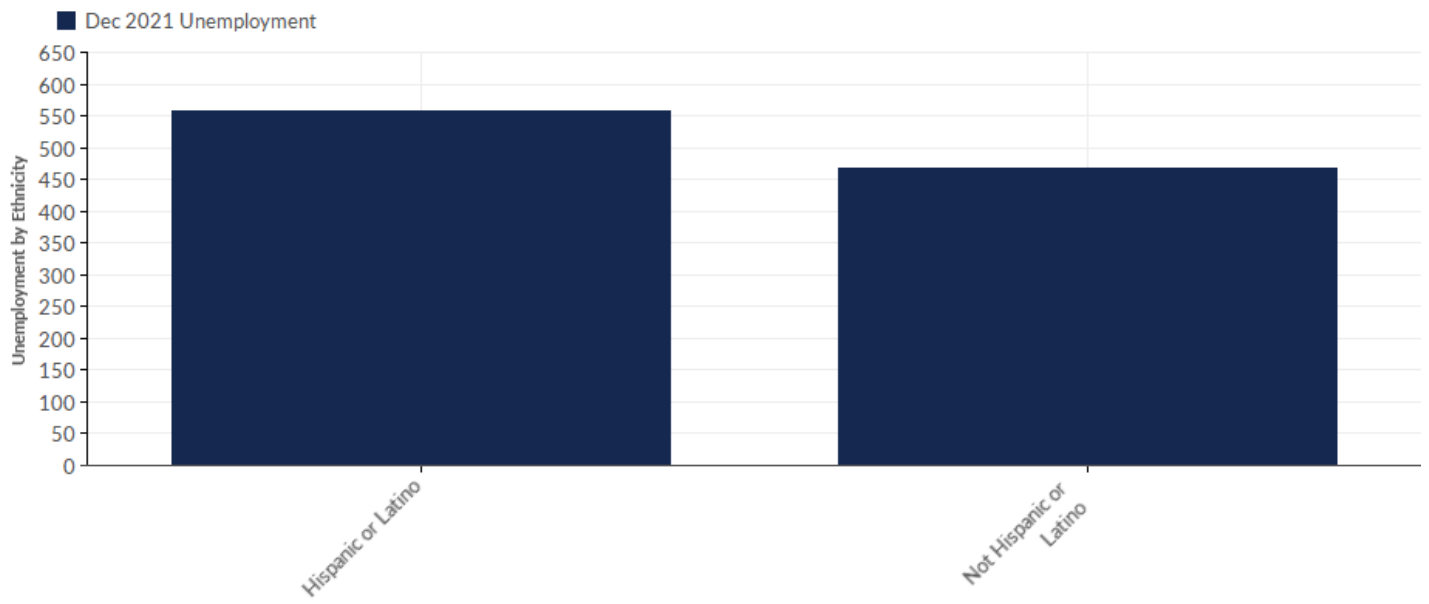

Unemployment by Ethnicity

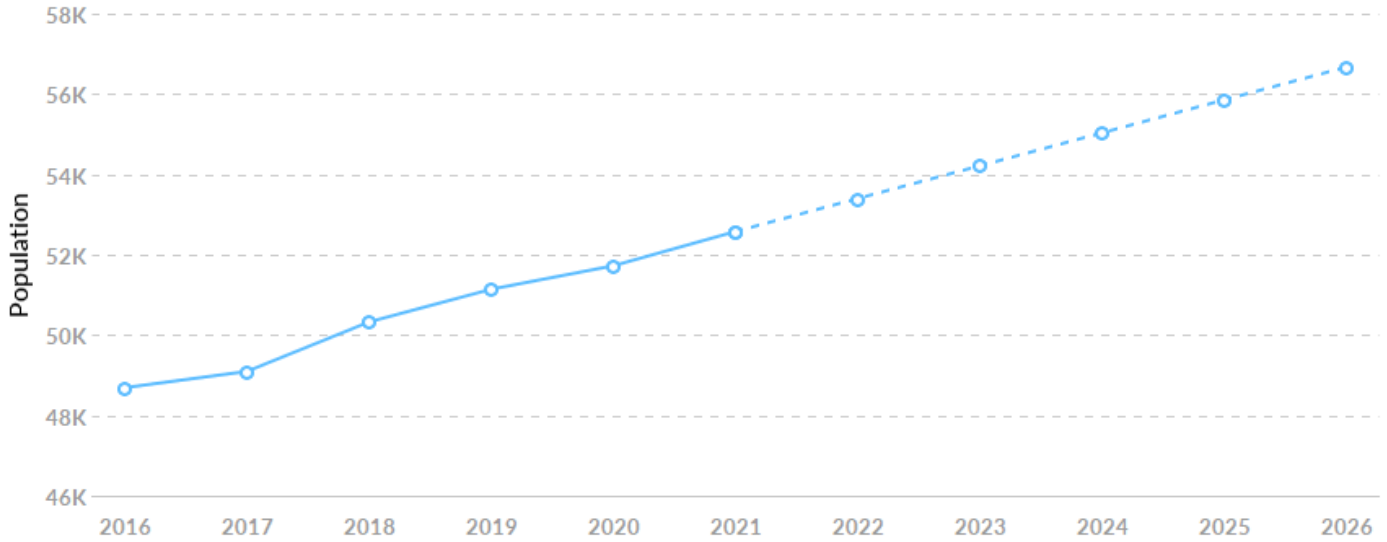

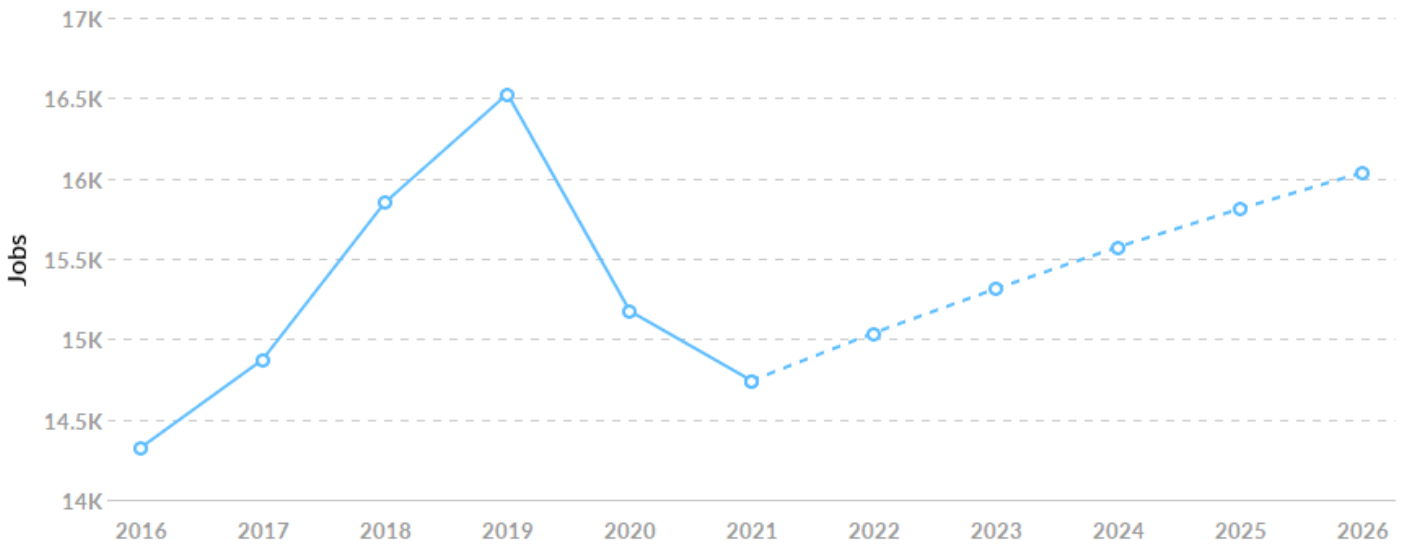

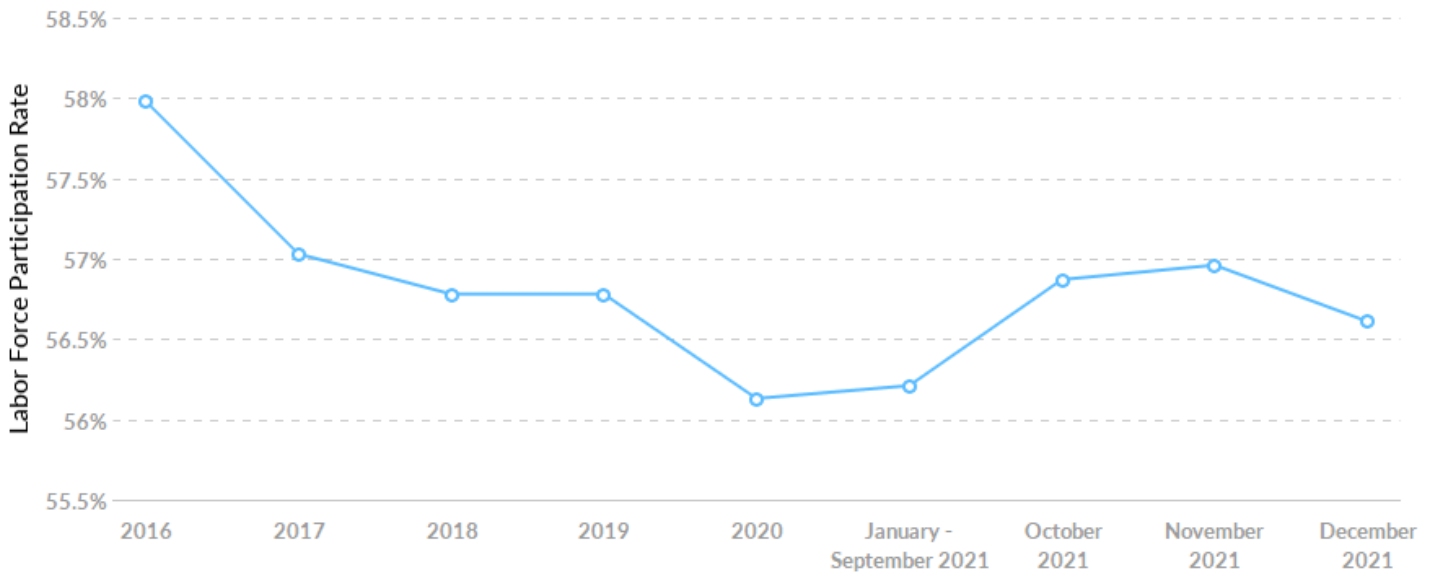
Job Trends

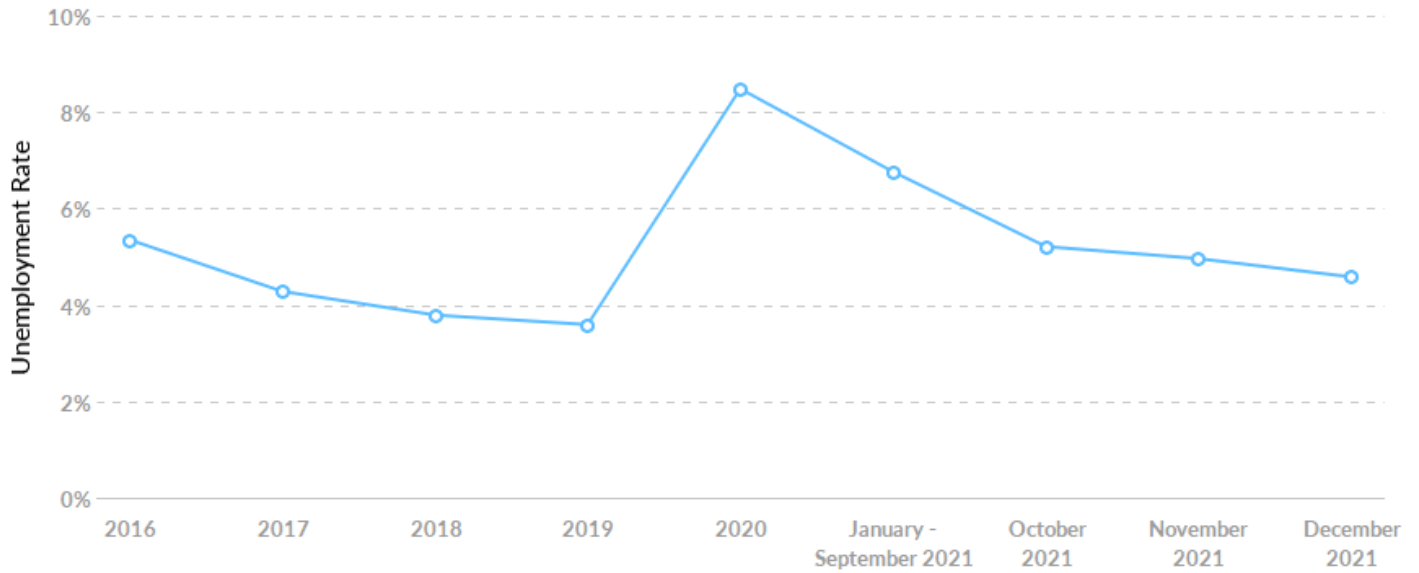

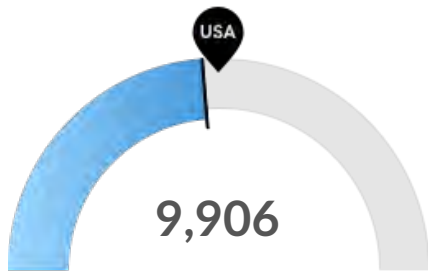
Unemployment Rate Trends

Atascosa County, TX had a December 2021 unemployment rate of 4.58%, **decreasing from 5.35%** 5 years before.



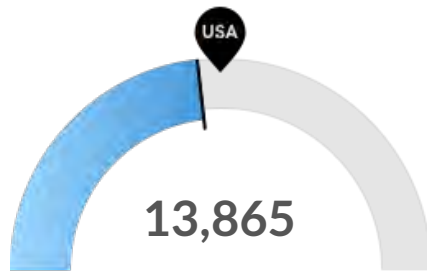

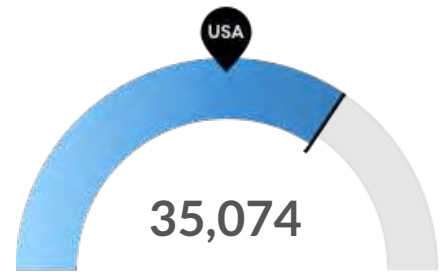
Millennials

Atascosa County, TX has 9,906 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,659.



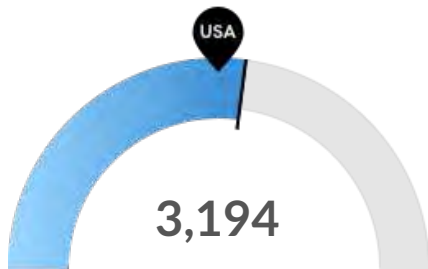
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 15,394 people 55 or older, while there are 13,865 here.



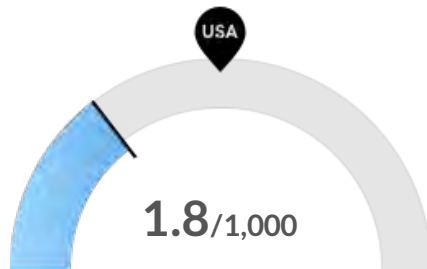
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Atascosa County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 20,834 racially diverse people, while there are 35,074 here.



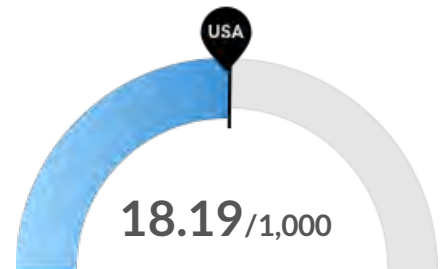
Veterans

Atascosa County, TX has 1.8 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.

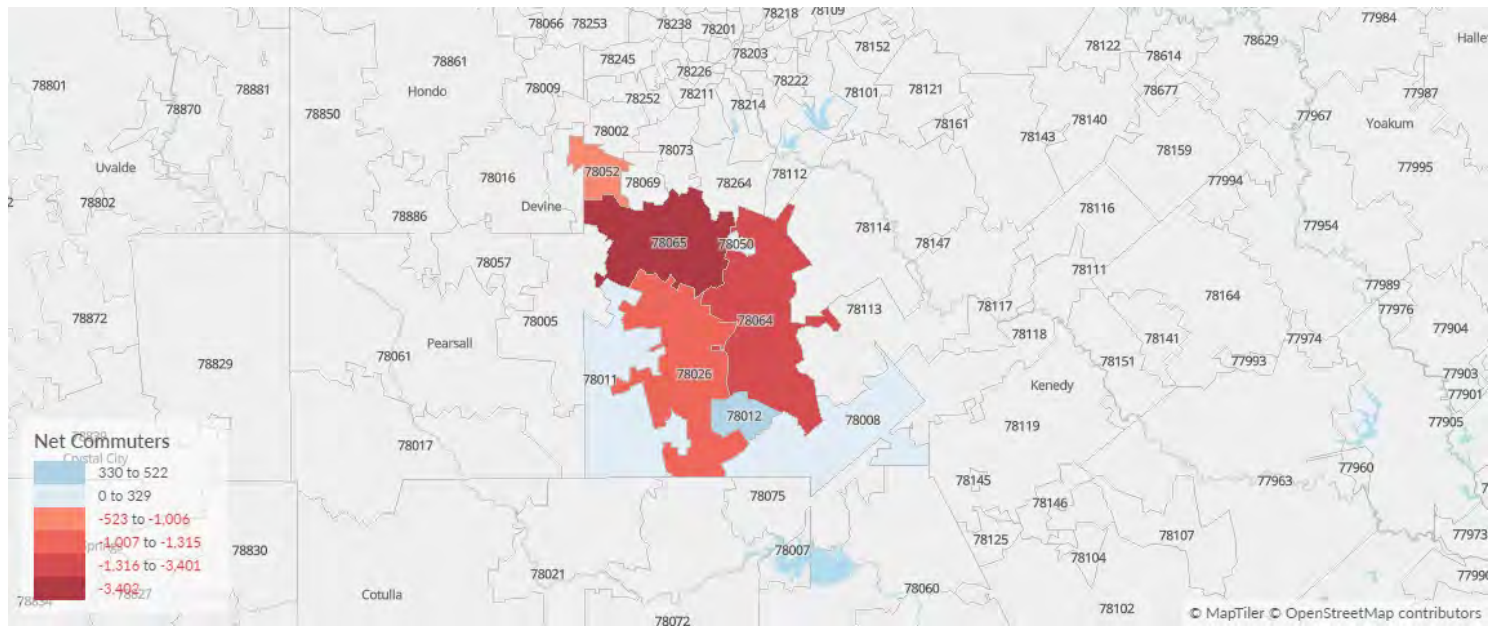


Property Crime

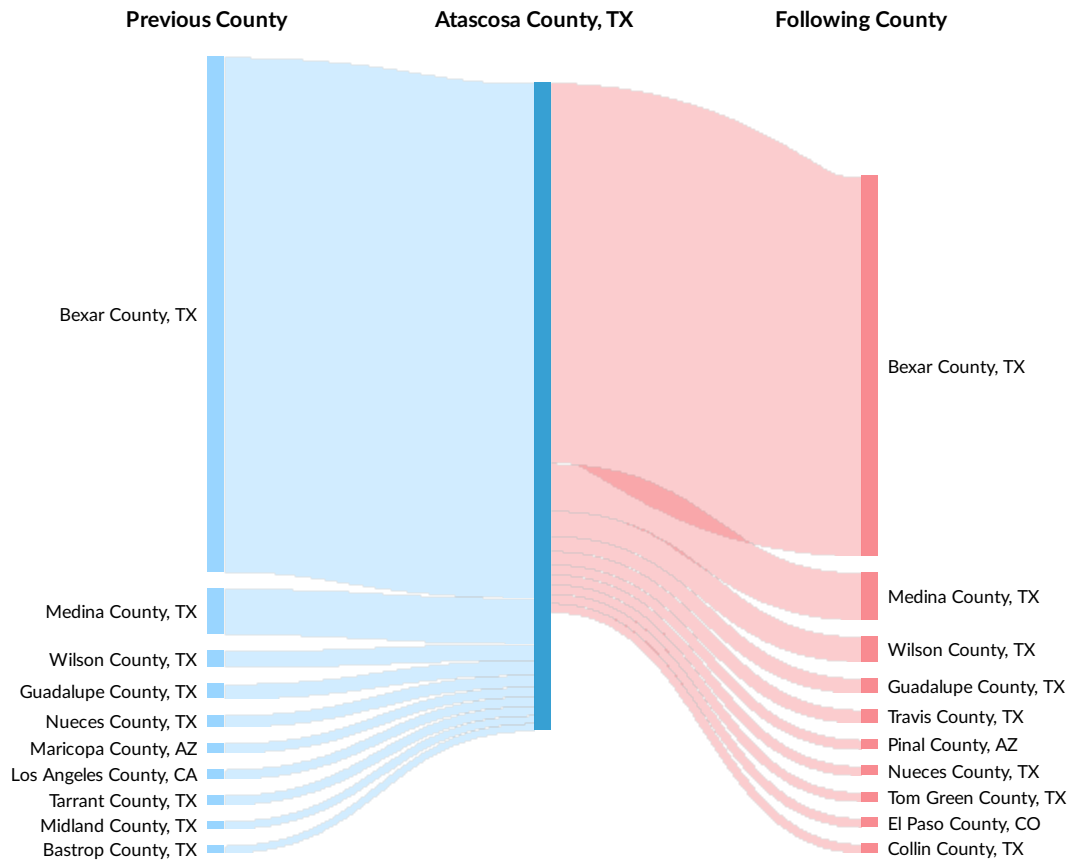

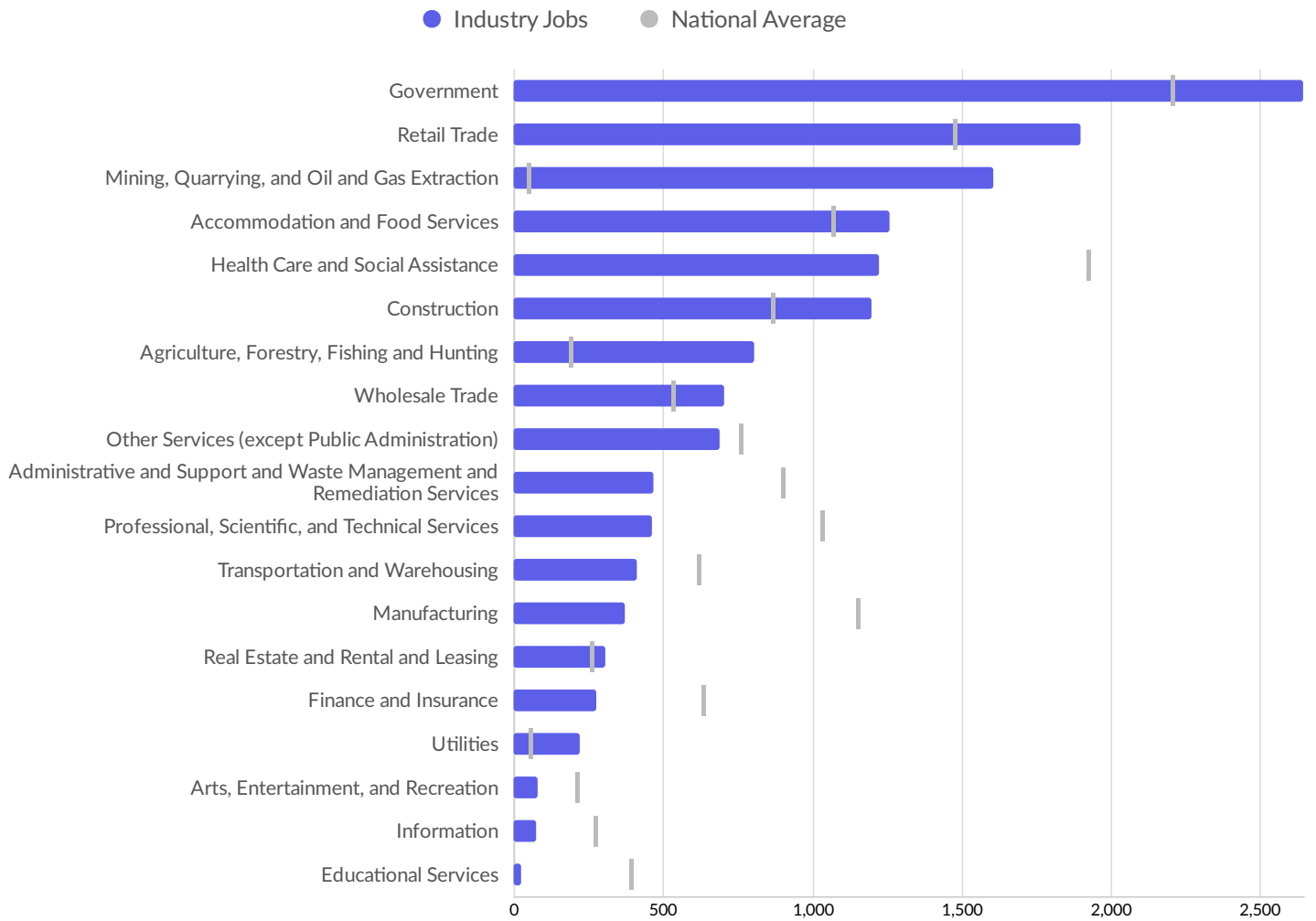

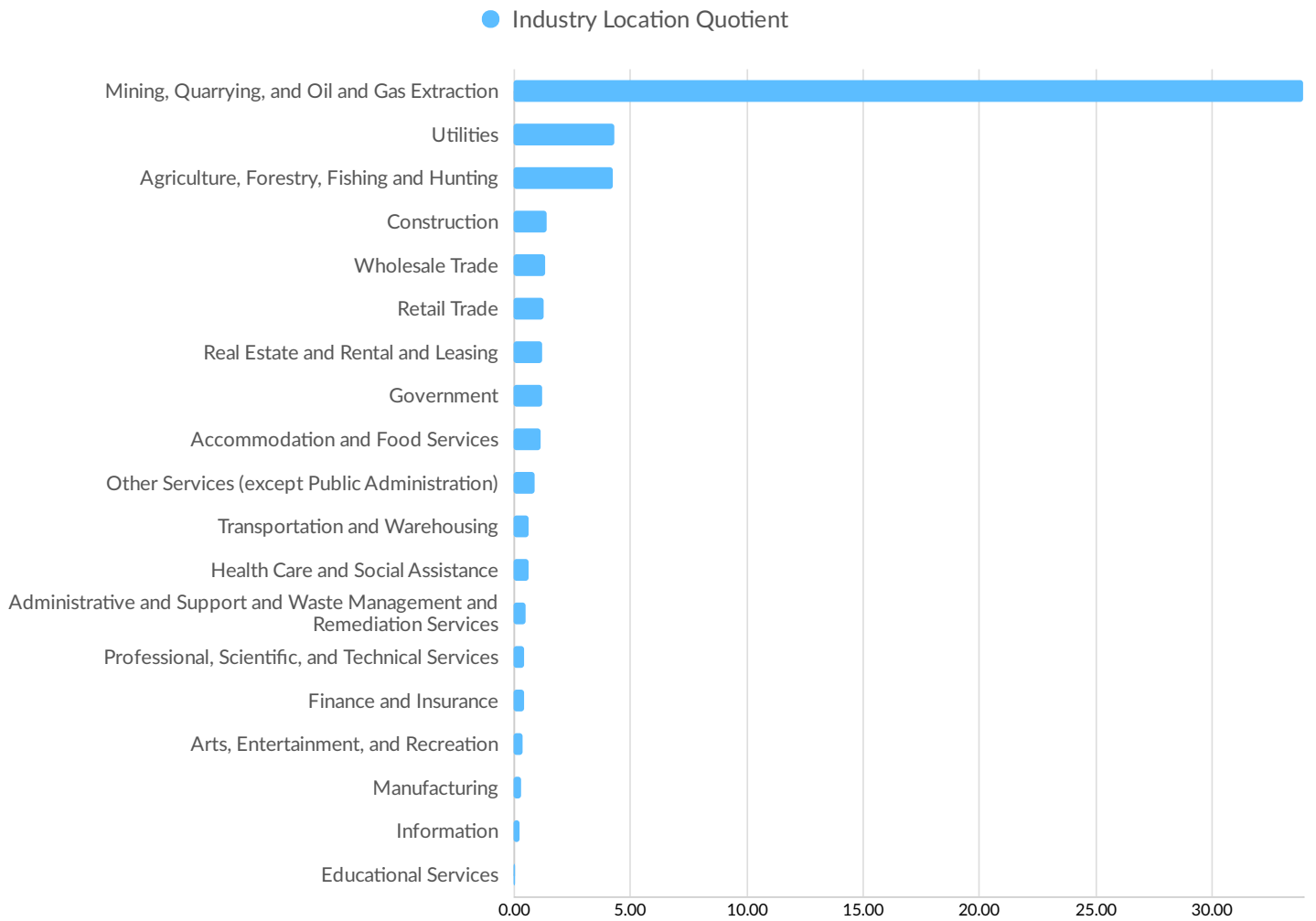

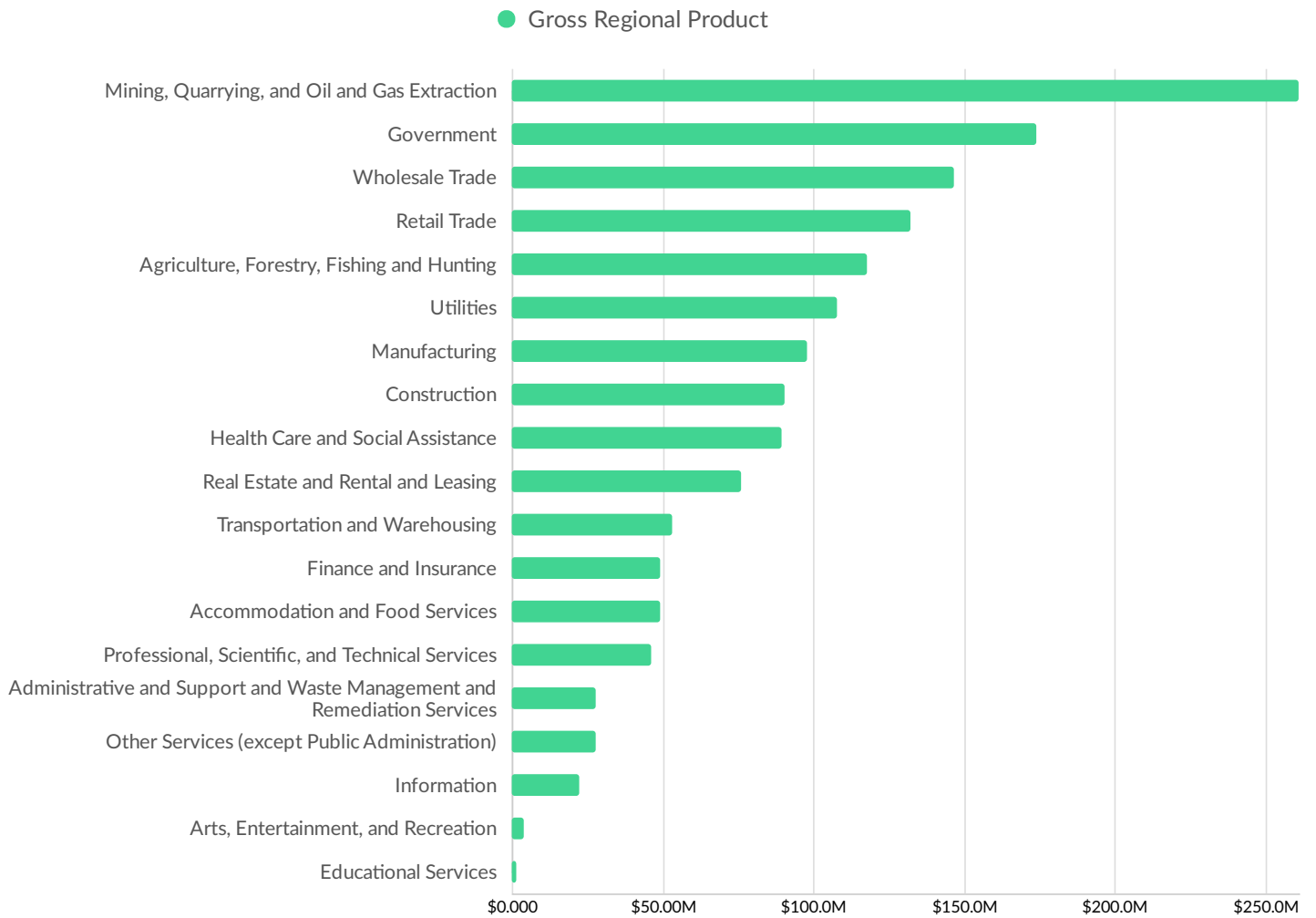
Top Growing Industries



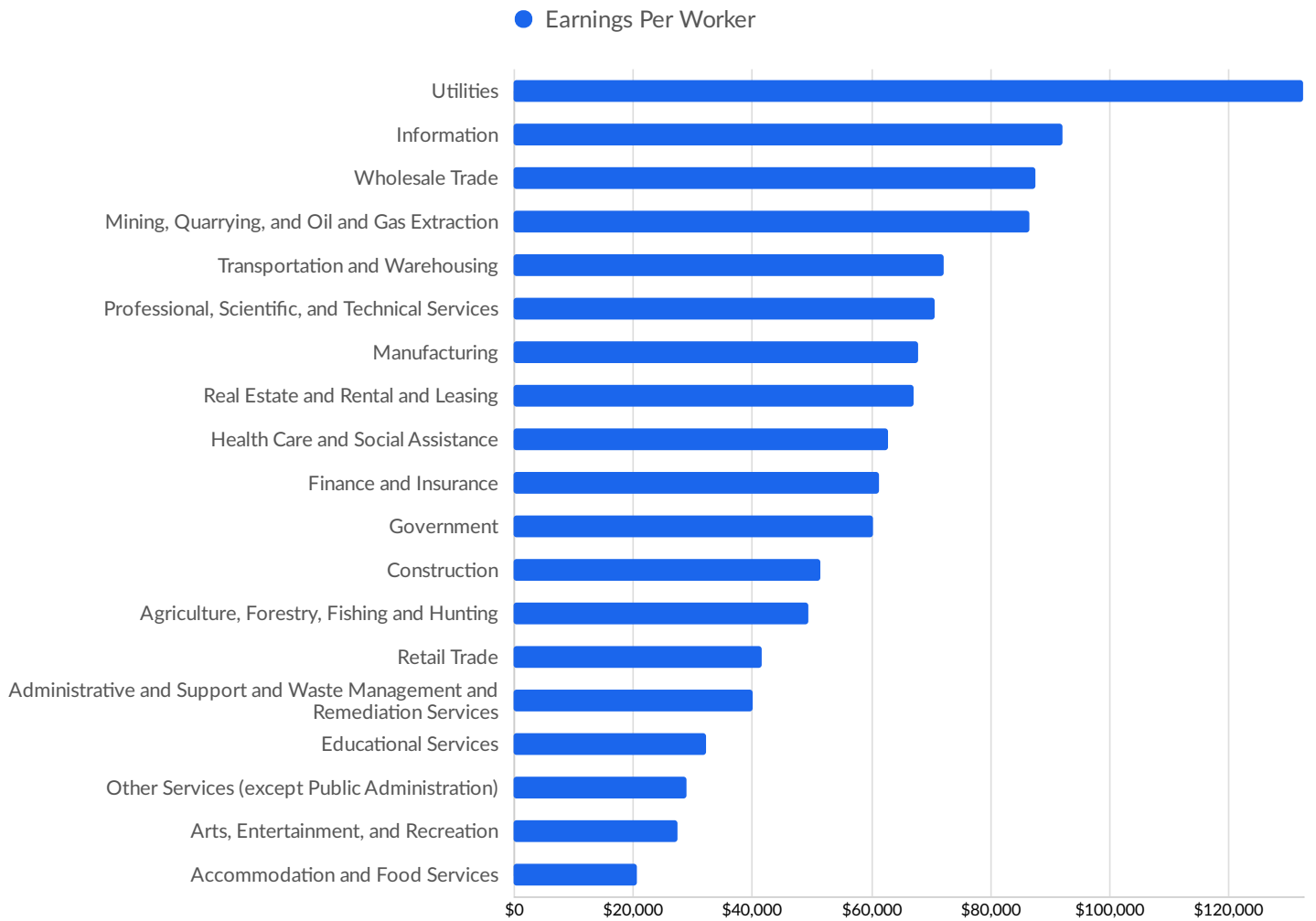
Top Industry Location Quotient

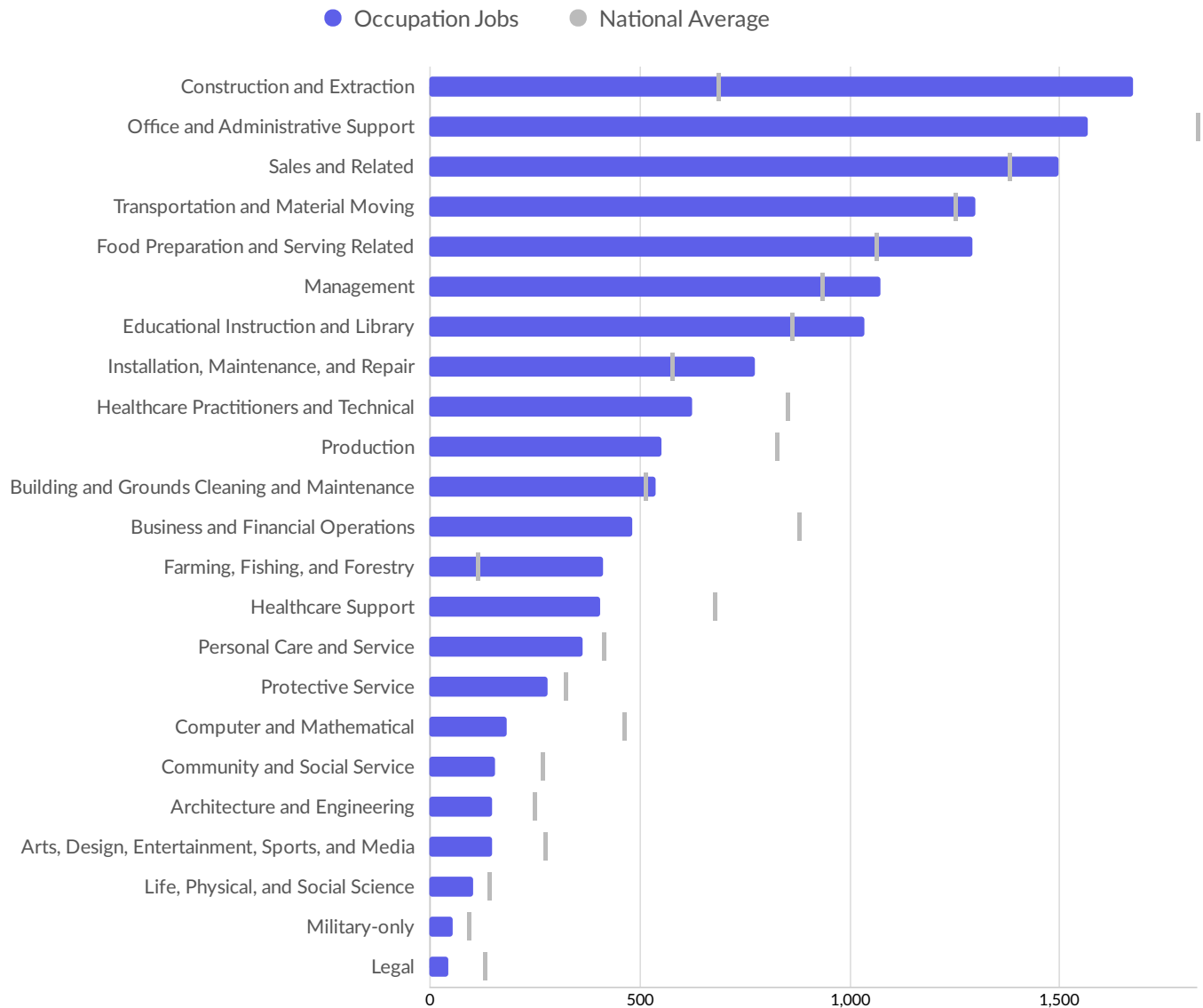

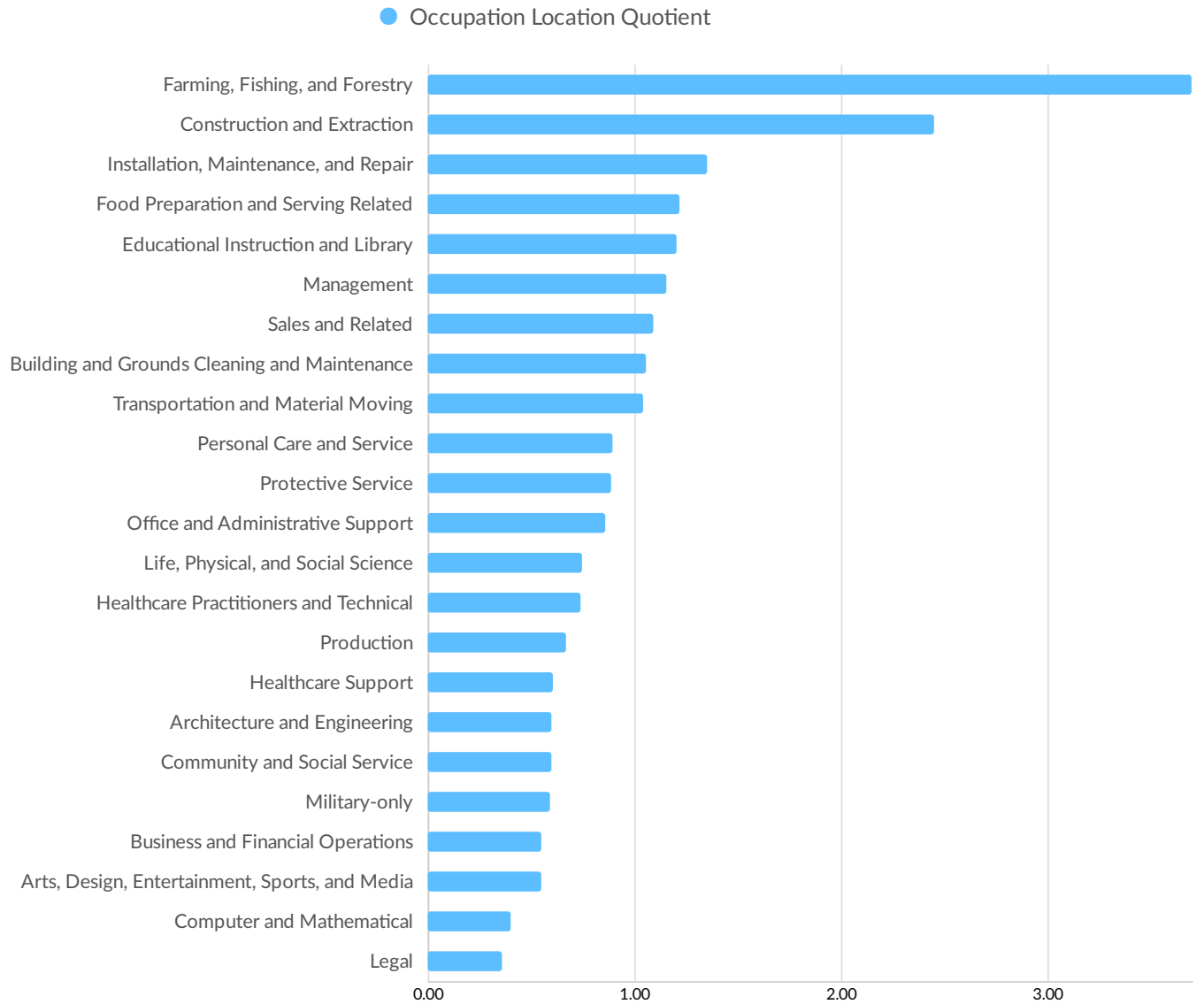
Largest Occupations



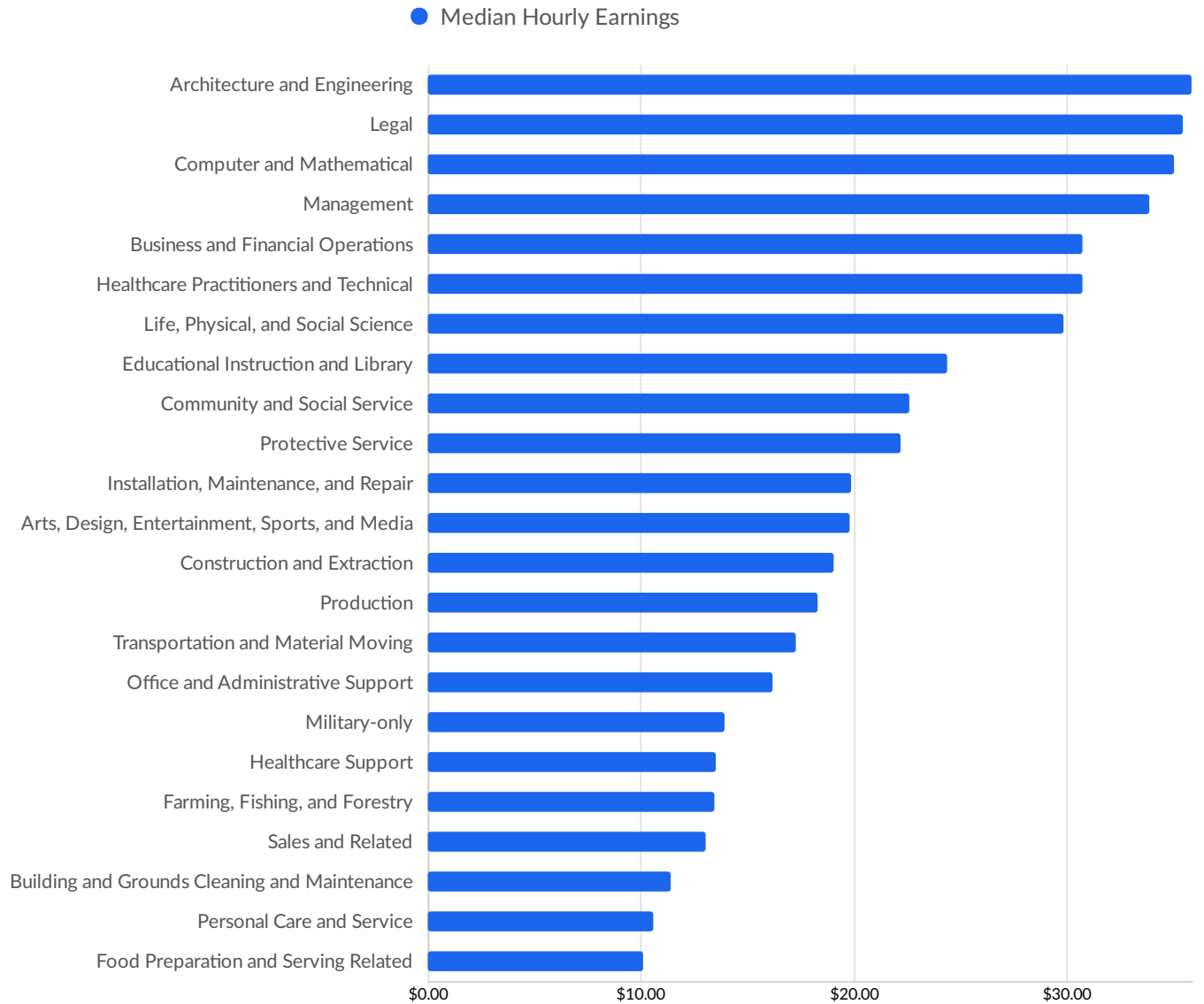
Top Growing Occupations



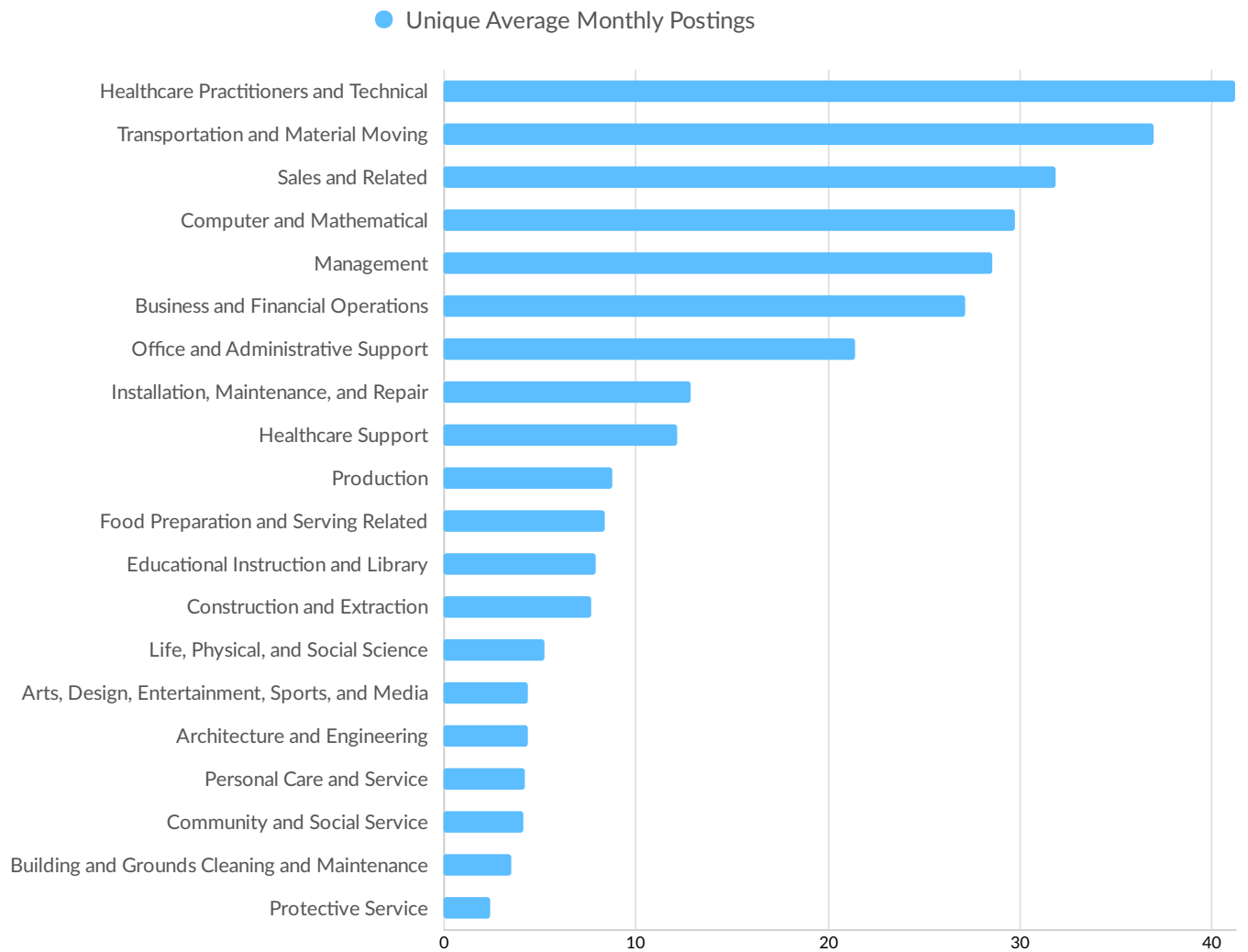
Top Occupation Location Quotient



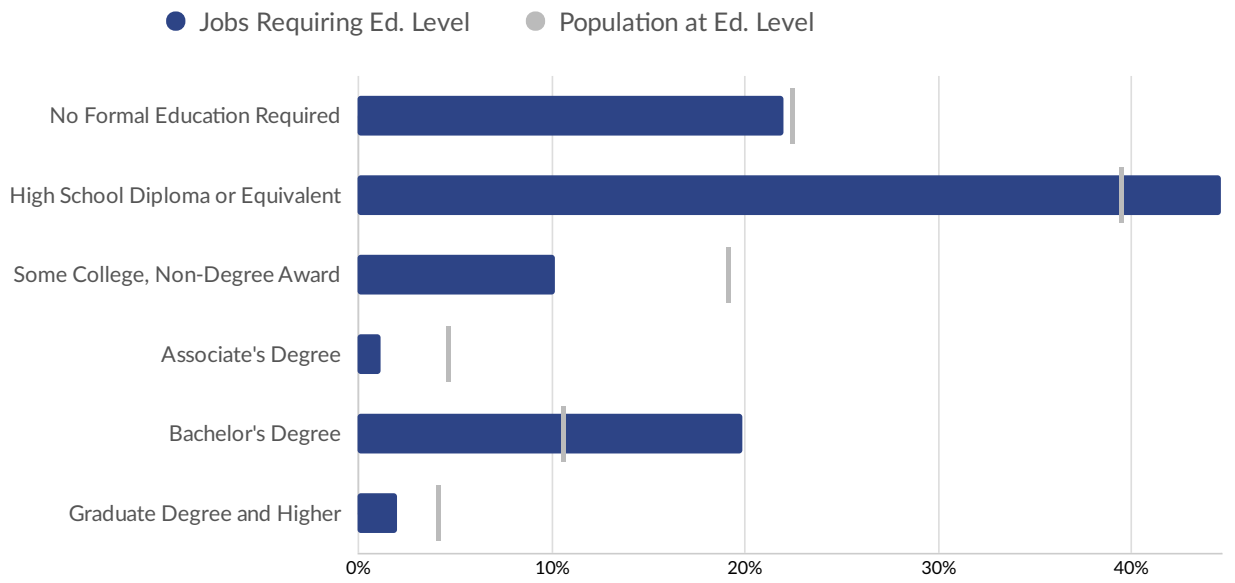
